#### Janice Denton, Keynote Speaker Project Mentor, Higher Learning Commission

anice Denton is Professor and Head of the Chemistry Department at the University of Cincinnati Blue Ash College. She is a member of the university's Academy of Fellows for Teaching and Learning and was awarded the Blue Ash College Distinguished Teaching Award in 2001.

She has presented workshops and papers at regional and national assessment and teaching conferences and has



worked with faculty on student learning and classroombased assessment at many colleges and universities across the country.

Since 2005, she has been mentoring institutions that participate in the assessment academy and workshops offered by Higher Learning Commission (HLC). Her most recent projects include developing a peer review of scholarly teaching protocol and mentoring colleges and universities that participate in the HLC's persistence and completion academy.
