Executive Director, Teaching, Learning and Professional Development, Texas Tech University and Co-editor, Transparent Design in Higher Education Teaching and Leadership: A Guide to Implementing the Transparency Framework Institution-wide to Improve Learning and Retention. Her research interests include organizational change, inclusive teaching practices, ePortfolio development, and digital storytelling.
