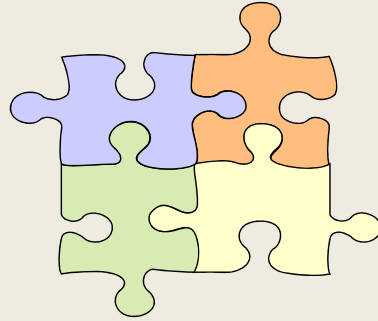


Kodiak Middle School serves approximately 360 seventh and eighth grade students. Our population is very diverse, and we recognize the contribution of our diverse cultures.
