All staff members have been involved in learning how to analyze, present, and use data to improve student achievement.

CRT/SEL Inquiry

Staff members are enrolled in two courses simultaneously. They focus on Social Emotional Learning that is Culturally Relevant. They are inquiry based which provides an insightful and self-aware approach to learning.

The Data team has spent 3 years learning how to analyze, interpret, and display results in a usable format to improve instruction and student performance. Our scores greatly improved from 2006 to 2007 and we are continuing to meet AYP. Our greatest challenge now is learning how to meet the needs of those students that are consistently below proficient.



CRT/SEL Focus

The CRT/SEL courses that all staff members have taken through UAA and ASD have focused on recognizing and understanding the importance of culturally relevant teaching and incorporating that knowledge in the selection of a SEL curriculum. The group is still in the selection process and learning how to develop protocols for analyzing curriculum and working with other staff members to meet the needs of students. The next step is to include the inquiry piece to examine personal attitude and practice.
