The above partners are joining together to provide two days of free dental care to individuals who are on a ***limited budget and have NO dental insurance.*** Patients will be treated on Friday, March 30, 2012 and Saturday, March 31, 2012 from 8:30-4:30. The services will be limited to exams, radiographs, cleanings, sealants, amalgam restorations and composite restorations. Extractions will be on a "simple extraction" basis per the dentist's discretion. All patients for this free clinic must go through the lottery process.

All lottery entries must be postmarked by March 1st. This clinic will not be operated on a first-come, first-serve basis. There is no guarantee that you will be seen, but there is a chance. If you are chosen, you will be given a day and time to arrive at the UAA Dental Programs' Clinic. If you are chosen, you may still have to wait for up to three hours for possible treatment. If you have uncontrolled high blood pressure, a complicated health history or dental conditions beyond the scope of the treatment of this clinic you may not receive treatment. There is no advantage to turning your lottery application in early; late lottery applications will not be accepted.

It will be impossible to see all the people who register for the lottery. The dental staff pulls out only as many names as they expect to be able to handle for each event. This is "the luck of the draw" and is the only way that is practical to manage high demand fairly.

Chosen lottery applicants will be notified by email (or phone; if no email is available) by March 15th as to the status of their application.
