



<b>Title</b>	<b>Princeton University's NATIONAL COMMUNITY-BASED RESEARCH NETWORKING PROJECT</b>
<b>Supported by</b>	<b>Corporation for National and Community Service Learn and Serve America</b>
<b>UAA's Role</b>	UAA is a participating campus in the larger national project being run by Princeton University. UAA's Center for Community Engagement and Learning (CCEL) has a three-year sub-award for \$7,500 per year beginning in September 2006. The work will be directed by CCEL Director and Professor of Sociology Dr. Nancy Andes.
<b>Purposes</b>	<p>The project's purposes are to promote participatory change through community building and public policy analysis. Faculty and students will work on community-identified issues using scholarly approaches to community engagement. Students' work will be supported and guided by community mentors. Their results will be discussed and critiqued in local and national networks.</p> <p>Other goals:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Promote community-based research at UAA</li> <li>• Develop thematic projects to address complex community-identified problems that require multiple disciplines &amp; several community partners.</li> <li>• Create student development models to unite disciplinary study with community-based research and public policy.</li> <li>• Strengthen local &amp; statewide infrastructures to support community-based research, policy analysis, and community partnership.</li> </ul>
<b>Scope of Work</b>	<p>The Statement of Work includes the following elements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provide training to faculty and community partners on community-based research</li> <li>• Support the development of a minimum of two community-based research projects into courses</li> <li>• Develop a new course, Introduction to Civic Engagement, to include community-based research</li> <li>• Form a CBR advisory group, comprised of faculty, staff, community partners, and students</li> <li>• Create and manage CBR web pages designed to make community information, local data, and research accessible</li> <li>• Collaborate with college, community and network partners to assess the impact of CBR on the campus community and the greater community</li> <li>• Provide support to students conducting community-based research for community-building and public policy outcomes</li> </ul>
