

UAA Non-Destructive Testing Boot Camp 2010

Application dates September 11, 2009 – November 20, 2009, however we expect this program to fill quickly. **Applicants are screened and accepted throughout this period. Once all seats are filled, we will begin a waiting list. You will be notified of your status as soon as possible.** Applicants must have earned a high school diploma, GED or at least 60 college-level semester credits. All prospective students must have or obtain a UAA Student ID number and be admitted for the Spring 2010 semester. Please follow these steps to obtain your UAA Student ID number and be admitted.

Step One: Go to UOnline.alaska.edu

Step Two: Please select 1 of 3 admission pathways below:

If not already admitted to UAA:

- A. Select Spring 2010 as application term
- B. Select University of Alaska Anchorage as your location
- C. Select Non-Degree Seeking as you application type

1. You have attended a University of Alaska (UA) Campus.

- * Go to [Current/Prior Student](#) to apply for admission in the secured area.
- + Enter your UA 'User ID' & 'PIN', then click 'Login'
- + Select 'Student Services'
- + Click on 'Admissions'
- + Follow directions and complete application

2. You are applying for the first time to a University of Alaska (UA) Campus.

- * Go to [New Student](#) to apply for admission.
- + Create 'Login ID' & 'PIN', then click 'Login'
- + Choose 'Campus' and 'Application Type'
- + Select 'Continue' and complete application

3. You are a new student returning to complete an application or review your admission progress.

- * Enter your original 'Login ID' and 'PIN', then click 'Login'
- + Select your 'Application in Progress' and finish application

Step Three: Take the Accuplacer Test for Math. The cost is \$15.

Step Four: Send your UAA Student ID Number and a letter of intention to enroll in the Non- Destructive Testing 2010 Boot Camp to AYCERCNDT@uaa.alaska.edu . **DEADLINE for UAA to receive your emailed completed application is Friday, November 20, 2009 at 5 PM.**

Include: Accuplacer, ACT or SAT scores which includes Math placement information and current welding certificates (if any).

***Students who place into MATH A107 through the UAA Accuplacer test do not have to take MATH A105.**

***Students who hold a current SMAW Welding Certification do not have to take Weld A112**

Step Five: You will be notified by email if you are selected for either the January 11-February 12, 5-week Welding and Math session or if you meet the prerequisites, the 10 week February 15 –April 30th, 2010-NDT session.
