## Blackboard

### What is Blackboard?

Blackboard is an Internet-based course management system. Through Blackboard, students and faculty interact within a distance class. Students use Blackboard to gain access to the course materials, assignments and other important items related to their distance class.

### Where is my Blackboard class located?

Blackboard has links from the UAA home page and the Distance Education site at [www.uaa.alaska.edu/distanceeducation](http://www.uaa.alaska.edu/distanceeducation). The direct link is [www.uaa.alaska.edu/classes](http://www.uaa.alaska.edu/classes). Once you are enrolled in a course you will visit this site often, so it's a good idea to bookmark it on your computer. Each distance class you're registered for will show up here on the first day of the semes-

ter. Not all courses you are enrolled in will show up on Blackboard, though all distance classes will be available here.

## Equipment Requirements

- Windows P, Vista, or Mac OS
- Modern web browser such as Firefox, Internet Explorer, Safari
- Java runtime
- 1 GHz, or faster CPU (e.g. Intel Pentium III, Core Duo, Core Duo, Core i / i , etc.)
- 1 GB of RAM, 1 GB of RAM recommended
- DVD-ROM drive
- 1024 x 768 screen resolution
- 56 kbps dial-up modem or faster cable/DSL modem recommended
- Word processing software (Microsoft Office)

Be sure to consult the syllabus of a specific class to learn more about the instructional format, policies, and hardware and software requirements.

### Illuminate Live (eLive)
