- Serve as a resource for mentee(s)
- Help to guide mentee(s) for preparation of their Honors thesis project
- Be receptive to all forms of correspondence from mentee(s)
- Take a special interest in sharing information with mentee(s) to inspire and help them approach their academic studies with more confidence
- Make frequent contact with mentee via e-mail, phone call, personal visit, or attend scheduled events
- Attend required training session and Honors College Orientation
- Attend scheduled mentor and mentee planned functions sponsored by the Honors College/UHSAB
- Report any concerns you have about mentee to the Honors College advisors
- Work with mentee(s) in small groups or on a one-on-one basis with academics, social and university activities, and other Honors College events
- Complete documentation of student assessments and recommendations, including semester reports
- Refer mentee(s) to appropriate student and academic support programs/services (including advising)
