

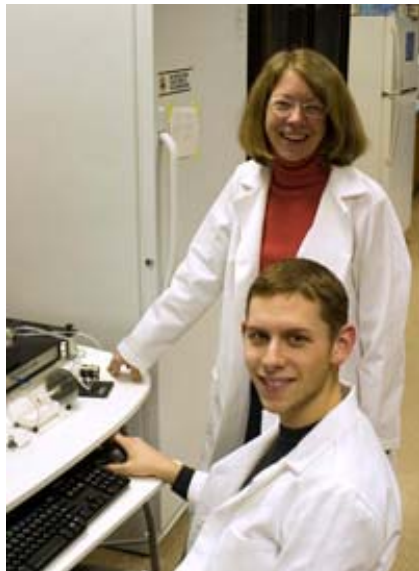

Alaska Heart Institute Fellowships fund significant undergraduate biomedical research projects under the guidance of a faculty mentor. Each grant supports up to \$5,000 in project costs, tuition for up to 6 credits of HNRS 497 (Individual Research) and a \$1,500 student stipend upon completion of the project.
