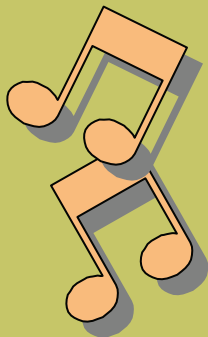

Join UAA instructor Craig Coray for an in-depth look at the songs of Alaska Native and northern indigenous peoples, Alaska's oldest musical traditions. Supported by years of research and an extensive collection of audio and rare film footage, Coray will explore the music of the indigenous groups of Alaska, Western Canada, and Eastern Siberia from the time of first contact to the present.

The course will have a primary emphasis on non-Western concepts of scale, form, the roles of language, lifestyle, and ceremony in shaping the music. This course is cross-listed with Alaska Native Studies and Music and students may register to receive credit through either department.
