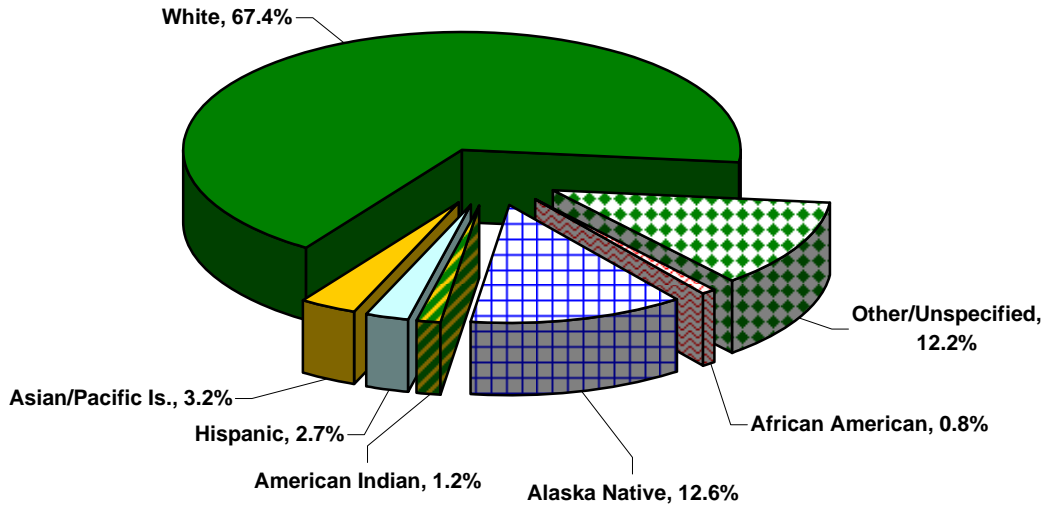

Credit Headcount by Gender**

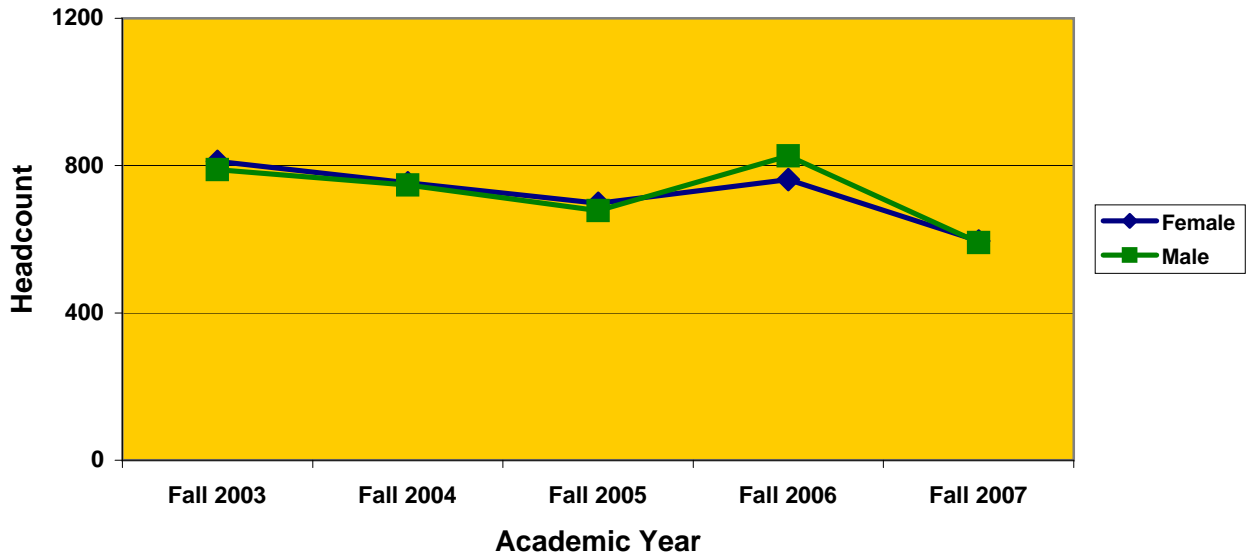
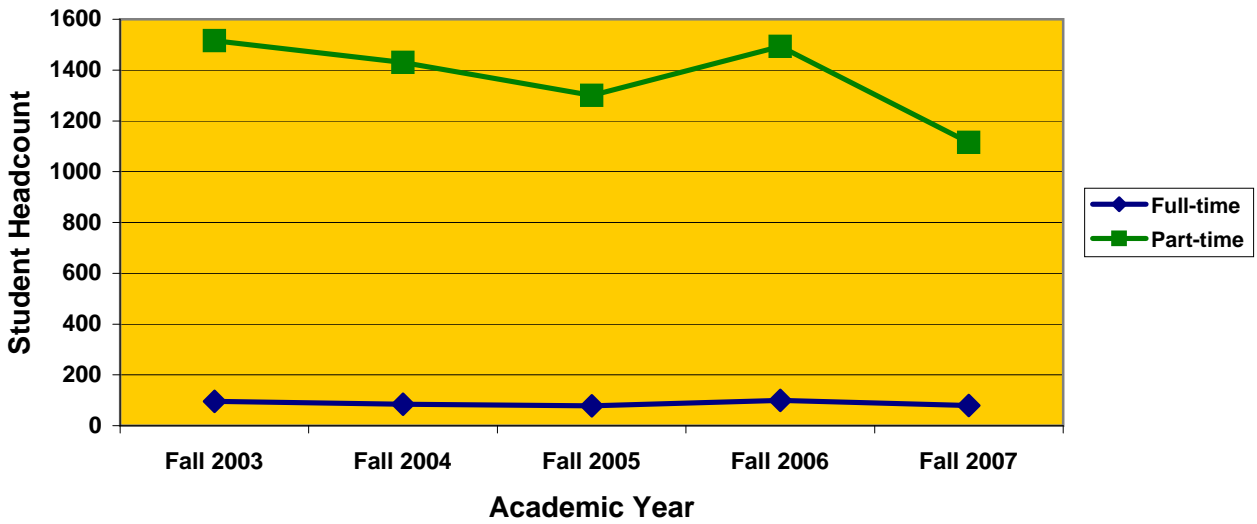
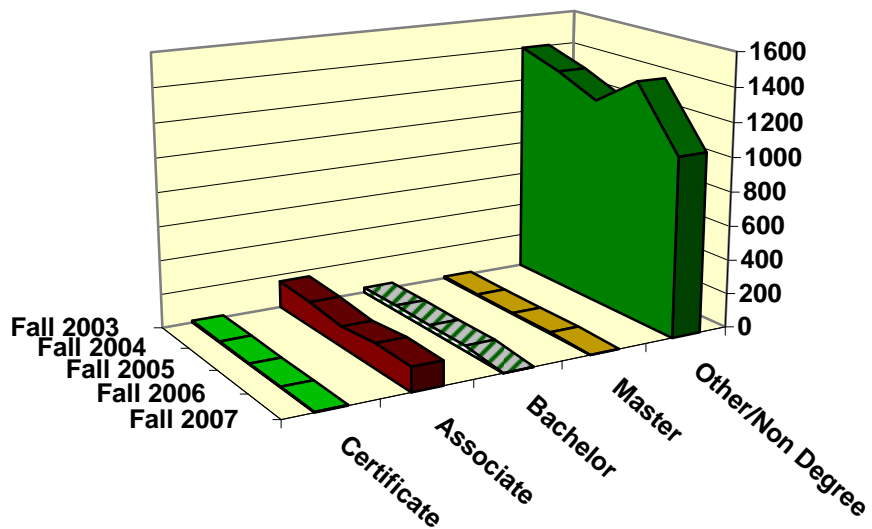

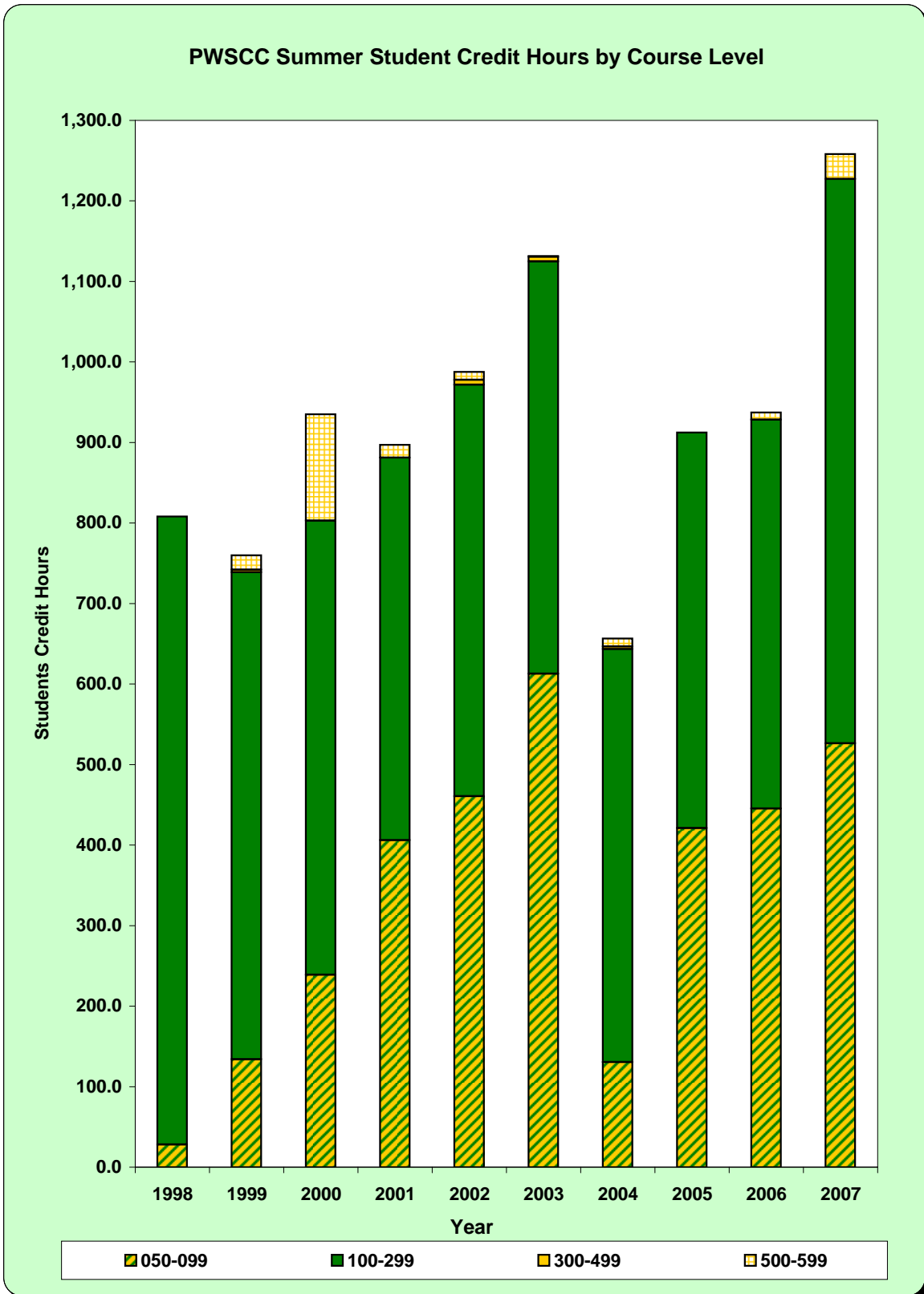

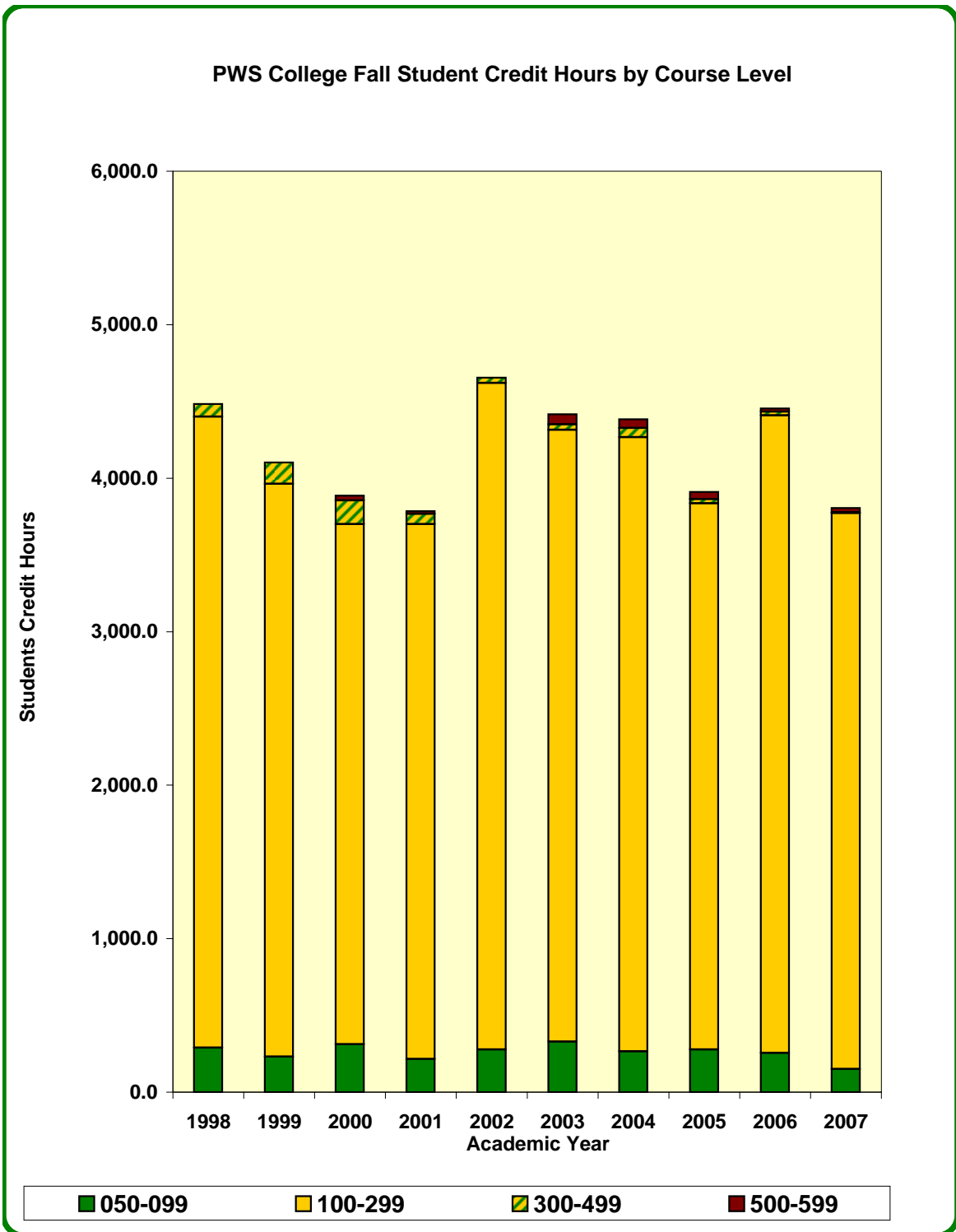
