Announces the

DR. ALEX HILLS UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH AWARD for ENGINEERING STUDENTS

This competitive grant will be awarded to support one undergraduate research project showing exceptional merit. The award will fund up to \$2000 for project expenses plus a \$500 stipend. *Students must be enrolled in a baccalaureate degree program in the School of Engineering to be eligible for this award.*

PURPOSE: Projects must be under the guidance of a University faculty member. All traditional research projects will be considered, as well as research projects involving community learning and engagement. Funds will be awarded to offset research costs such as analyses, supplies, equipment, software, surveys, and/or travel. An additional stipend will be awarded upon successful completion of the project.

ELIGIBILITY: Students must be accepted in a baccalaureate degree program in the School of Engineering at the University of Alaska Anchorage and must be enrolled for the current fall semester.

PROPOSAL SUBMISSION: Application cover sheets and proposal format guidelines can be found at <http://ours.uaa.alaska.edu> or picked up from the Undergraduate Research & Scholarship Office in RH 115. Cover sheet must be signed by both the student investigator and the mentoring faculty member.

CRITERIA FOR AWARD: Submissions will be judged on the clarity of the proposal, the intellectual and scholarly merit of the project, the significance of the project within its discipline or community, and the evidence that the student can carry out the project.

RESPONSIBILITIES: The recipient will (1) present their project in a public forum and (2) submit a final written project report to the Office of Undergraduate Research & Scholarship at the end of the following spring semester. Additionally, the project abstract will be published in the proceedings of the annual Undergraduate Research & Discovery Symposium.

SUBMISSION PROCEDURE: Submit cover sheet and proposal to the Office of Undergraduate Research & Scholarship in RH 115 by the posted deadline. The recipient will be notified by mid-November. Award is contingent on approval by the Institutional Review Board, the Animal Rights Committee, and/or other committees as appropriate.
