Parasca Science Research Award

This award funds the actual costs of a significant undergraduate research project in any area of science or social science up to \$4000 plus a \$1000 stipend.

PURPOSE: This award funds a significant undergraduate research project in any area of science or social science. Project must be under the guidance of a University faculty member. Funds will be awarded to offset research costs such as analyses, supplies, equipment, software, surveys, and/or travel.

ELIGIBILITY: Students must be accepted in an associate or baccalaureate degree program at the University of Alaska Anchorage (any campus) and must be enrolled in at least three credits each semester for the duration of the research (with the exception of the summer semester).

PROPOSAL SUBMISSION: Application cover sheets and proposal format guidelines can be found at www.uaa.alaska.edu/ours or picked up from the Undergraduate Research & Scholarship Office in RH 115. Application forms must have both the student's signature and the signature of the mentoring faculty member.

CRITERIA FOR AWARD: Submissions will be judged on the clarity of the proposal, the intellectual and scholarly merit of the project, the significance of the project within its discipline or community, and the evidence that the student can carry out the project.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Recipient will (1) present their project at the Undergraduate Research and Discovery Symposium and (2) submit a final written project report to the Office of Undergraduate Research at the end of the following spring semester. Additionally, the project abstract will be published in the proceedings of the annual Undergraduate Research and Discovery Symposium.

SUBMISSION PROCEDURE: Submit application cover sheet and proposal to the Office of Undergraduate Research & Scholarship in RH 115 by the posted deadline. The recipient will be notified by early March. Award is contingent on approval by the Institutional Review Board, the Animal Rights Committee, and/or other committees as appropriate.
