REGISTRATION ON UAONLINE

UAOnline Priority Registration will be open to admitted certificate- and degree-seeking UAA students at 12:01am on Monday, **February 22**.

UAOnline Open Registration begins at 12:01am on **March 1**.

UAOnline registration will remain open 24 hours per day, seven days per week until close of registration. See the calendar for session dates. Expect occasional outages for system maintenance. Telephone assistance is available during regular business hours at (907) 786-1480, option 3.

Everyone who wants to take classes at UAA must be admitted to the University as either a certificate-seeking, degree-seeking, or non-degree-seeking student.

ADD/DROP PERIOD

See calendar for session deadlines. During this period, a faculty signature is required to register for a closed course and for courses requiring department/instructor approval, unless the course has not yet started according to the published start date of the course.

MULTIPLE REGISTRATIONS FOR SAME COURSE

For any given semester, a student may not be simultaneously registered in two or more sections of the same course that have the same or overlapping starting and ending dates. Students attempting to register for courses that are approved for multiple registrations should contact their academic department to request an override.

PAYMENT INFORMATION

Payment is due by the published payment deadline even if a bill is not received. There will be no University-initiated drop for non-payment.

Payment plans are available through Tuition Management Systems (TMS) at www.afford.com/UAA.

ELECTRONIC BILLING

An electronic bill will be generated on the 15th of each month and made available via UAOnline. An email reminder will be sent to your **UA-assigned email address** each time the bill is generated; a paper bill will not be mailed. A link on the UAOnline Statement and Payment History page will take you to the page where you can pay with a credit card or electronic check. To view your electronic bill, go to UAOnline and choose Student from the main menu, then Student Account, then Statement and Payment History.

FAILURE TO MEET FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS

University policy requires a financial hold be placed on your record if you fail to meet your financial obligations. The hold will prevent any registration, transcript, or graduation activity.

Past due accounts will be sent to a collection agency. Interest, late fees, and/or collection costs will be added to your account. Past due debt may be reported to a local credit bureau. The University is authorized to garnish the State of Alaska PFDs for payment of past due accounts.

PREREQUISITES

Students are expected to check and meet all prerequisites before registering for classes. Students who do not meet the prerequisites will be administratively dropped from the class. Any fees resulting from this, or any late registration procedure, will be the responsibility of the students.

REGISTRATION BY PROXY

Students unable to register in person may have a proxy (someone else) register for them. Spouses, parents, and friends are required to have a signed authorization to register for another person, including secondary school students.

The student must provide the proxy with a signed Proxy for Registration Form or other signed authorization to do so. The proxy must submit the signed authorization and picture ID at the time of registration. An updated proxy form must be submitted each semester. The **Proxy for Registration** form is available at www.uaa.alaska.edu/admissions/forms.cfm

RESPONSIBILITY

The University holds students academically and financially responsible for their registration. Students who change their plans or become unable to attend must officially drop or withdraw from their courses within published deadlines in order to avoid a final grade of "F" for nonattendance. Courses must be dropped within the 100% refund period to avoid tuition assessment.

Deadlines will be prorated for trimester courses or courses with dates other than the traditional full semester length. Calculate course prorate dates at www.curric.uaa.alaska.edu/registration/prorate

SECONDARY SCHOOL STUDENT APPLICANTS

Secondary school applicants may be admitted on a semester-by-semester basis to non-degree-seeking status. Students may register on a space-available basis, as priority is given to certificate- and degree-seeking students. WITHDRAWAL ONLINE

Please check the following before you start the new semester.

- It is the student's responsibility to be aware of dates and deadlines.
- Apply for admission. Admission to the University in a certificate, associate, or bachelor's degree program does not necessarily indicate you are ready for college-level coursework.
- Meet with your major advisor or an advisor in the Advising and Testing Center for assistance in selecting your courses.
- Review any registration restrictions, prerequisites, and special notes that may be associated with the courses you select (for example, completion of math or English placement test).
- Attend new student orientation if this is your first semester. www.uaa.alaska.edu/orientation
- Verify financial aid and check disbursement information at uaonline.alaska.edu
- Check uaonline.alaska.edu and select the Class Schedule link for course offering updates. Be sure to check the start dates and locations of each course for which you register.
- Register for classes through uaonline.alaska.edu
- Pay tuition and fees before published deadlines to avoid being assessed late payment fees. You are responsible academically and financially for your registration activity. Unpaid accounts will be sent to a collection agency and/or collected via garnishment of State of Alaska Permanent Fund Dividends.
- Purchase books and supplies at the bookstore. www.uaa.alaska.edu/bookstore
- Remember to officially drop or withdraw by the published deadlines if you decide at any time that you are unable to complete a course. Failure to do so will result in a grade of "F" for non-attendance and may affect your financial aid and grade-point average (GPA).
- Be aware of class locations. The UAA campus is over a mile long and the University Center facility is 1.2 miles from the main campus. Seawolf Shuttles provide an easy way to move between buildings on the campus, including the University Center location. However, it takes time to ride the shuttle and walk to your classroom. When registering for classes, plan for extra time needed to reach widely separated buildings. You will be required to produce proof of test scores on the first day of class. If you do not have the appropriate AP, SAT or ACT scores, or the appropriate prerequisites, you will be required to take a UAA-approved placement test.

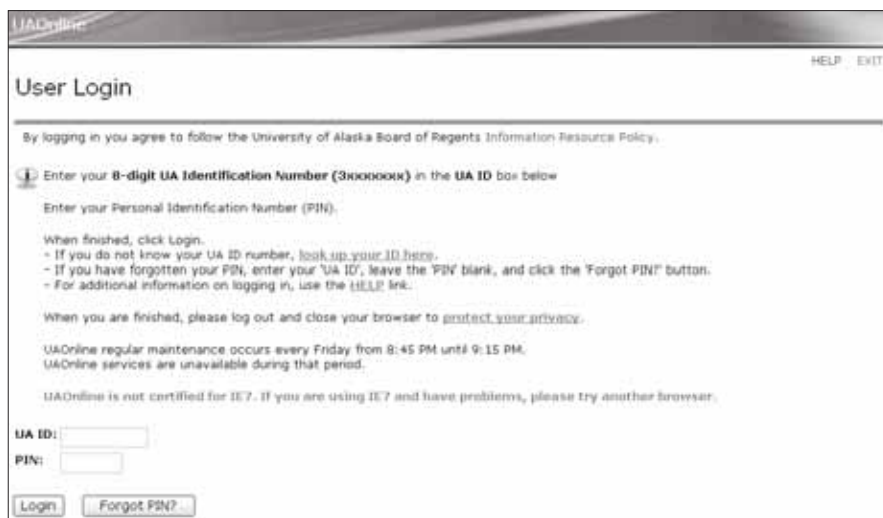


2 Enter your eight-digit **UA identification number** and **PIN** and click the "Login" button.

Alaska Residency

A person eligible for resident tuition is a person who, at the end of the add/drop period for regular semester-length courses, is a United States citizen or eligible non-citizen that has been physically present in Alaska for 2 years and who declares the intention to remain in Alaska indefinitely. The University of Alaska policy on resident and non-resident tuition may be referenced in the current University of Alaska Board of Regents Policy and Regulations, Chapter 05.10 Tuition and Student Fees, at www.alaska.edu/bor/policy-regulations. The Residency form and Application for Non-Resident Surcharge Waiver may be found online at www.uaa.alaska.edu/admissions/forms.cfm. The deadline for requesting residency and submitting all required documentation is prior to the published last day of the add/drop period for regular semester-length classes of the first semester in which residency is sought.

- Non-resident students who restrict their registration to no more than 4 credits each semester will be charged resident tuition. Non-resident students taking 5 credits or more are assessed non-resident fees on all academic credits.

Senior Citizens

Board of Regents' Policy 05.10.08.B: "Regular tuition shall be waived for Alaska residents who are otherwise age eligible to receive full Social Security retirement benefits, who register on a space available basis; that is, when courses can accommodate such students in addition to other enrolled students." Transitional provision: "Individuals who were eligible for senior citizen tuition waivers on September 21, 2005 under the previous policy shall continue to be eligible for the waiver."

- Senior citizens must pay all additional course fees. To waive tuition, senior citizens must register and present a completed tuition waiver with proof of age.
- Registration using a senior citizen tuition waiver for payment is permitted only after instruction begins and must be completed by the add deadline.
- Senior citizens may elect to register before instruction begins; however, they must pay full tuition and fees (use of senior citizen tuition waiver will not be accepted). Senior citizens electing to register and pay tuition are subject to all payment deadlines. Refunds will NOT be available to senior citizens who drop courses and then re-register in the same courses using a tuition waiver.

Tuition waivers for eligible senior citizens are available from Accounting Services, or online:

www.uaa.alaska.edu/admissions/forms.cfm.

Note: The Student Government Fee and Student Media Fee are waived for senior citizens. The Student Life Fees and Transportation Fee are mandatory for all students taking 3 or more credits on the Anchorage campus. The Student Health and Counseling Fee is mandatory for all students taking 6 or more credits, with 3 credits on the Anchorage campus.

Calculate expenses

Fees are charges students must pay either in addition to or in place of tuition.

Description of Fees

2% Network Charge

The Network Charge is to cover rapidly rising costs, especially in the maintenance and enhancement of our university-wide technology infrastructure. The 2% network charge will be applied on a course-by-course basis to tuition, non-resident surcharges if applicable, and fees in lieu of tuition, for credit and noncredit courses. Courses with applicable fees charged in lieu of tuition less than the lower division credit hour tuition rate (\$134 for academic year 2008-2009) will be exempt from the charge. All calculated fees will be rounded to the nearest dollar. The minimum network charge per course will be \$3.

Administrative Fee

An administrative fee may be charged instead of tuition. This fee amount is listed in the course description section of this schedule.

Continuous Registration Fee (Graduate Students)

The Continuous Registration Fee is \$301 per semester.

Distance Fee

A \$38 distance fee is charged for each distance education course (offered through Educational Media Services). Call (907) 786-6177 for additional information about distance education courses.

Lab and Materials Fees

Lab and materials fees are additional charges to cover the costs of lab supplies. Refer to the specific course listing on UAOnline for more information on lab and material fees. These fees are not refundable unless you drop during the 100% refund period.

Late Payment Fees

A \$125 fee will be assessed on all accounts which are not paid by the payment deadline. A \$175 fee will be assessed on all accounts which are not paid by the withdrawal deadline. Students who pay for or drop their courses prior to the published payment deadline will NOT be required to pay the fee.

Parking Fee

Fee paid to use parking lots on campus during fall and spring semesters. Students may buy parking decals at www.thepermitsstore.com. For more information, call the Parking Office at (907) 786-1119.

Special Fees

Special fees are assessed to pay for travel, equipment, or facilities out of the ordinary.

Student Fees

Mandatory fees charged to all students (including secondary school students) registering in 3 credits or more for courses held on the Anchorage campus*. This assessment will be based on the total registration once the 3-credit on-campus criteria is met. The Student Fees are not

refundable unless the student totally withdraws during the 100% refund period. Students may elect to pay certain student fees if they are registered in 1-5 academic credits or 200 or more contact hours in one semester. Student Life Fees for students registered in fewer than 6 credits are set at a fixed rate. Contact the Issue Cage in the Wells Fargo Sports Complex for information about the Athletics/Sports Complex Fee, and contact Student Activities in the Student Union Building regarding the Student Activity Fee. Student Health and Counseling Center services are not available to students registered in fewer than 6 academic credits.

*The Aviation Technology Center, King Career Center, University Center, and Wendler Middle School are considered on-campus facilities for purposes of fee assessment.

Student Transportation Fee

\$10 for students registered in 3 or more credits to support Campus Shuttle Service, U-Pass People Mover Program (citywide bus pass), bicycle racks, trail/sidewalk maintenance, and Call Team walking escorts.

Technology Fee

Mandatory fee to provide up-to-date equipment, software, maintenance, training, and support for student use. The fee is \$5 per credit hour to a maximum of \$60.

A 2% Network Charge will be assessed on total tuition cost in addition to the above Student Fees.

Access to these services is available with a valid Wolfcard (UAA student ID card).

To receive your initial student ID, register for classes and then bring a photo ID to the Wolfcard Office in the University Center. Existing Wolfcards are automatically updated, so there is no need to visit the Wolfcard Office.

Student Government Fee: \$1 per credit hour for students registered in 3 or more credits. Maximum charge \$12. Student Government Fee allocation: student advocacy for academic, student and legislative affairs, Union of Students University of Alaska Anchorage (USUAA).

Student Media Fee: \$11. KRUA 88.1 FM student radio station (\$5.25); *The Northern Light* newspaper (\$5.75).

Student Transportation Fee: \$10 for students registered in 3 or more credits.

Summer Student Life Fees:

- Sports Complex: \$22 for students enrolled in 3 or more credits. Free use of Wells Fargo Sports Complex facilities, pool, ice rink, weight room, gymnasium, etc.
- Student Activities: \$12 for students enrolled in 3 or more credits. Free or reduced admission to musical events, Juneteenth Celebration, ice cream socials, Student Union Gallery, and other special summer programs.
- Student Health and Counseling Center: \$39 flat fee for students enrolled in 6 or more credits. Students enrolled in spring and fall semesters, but not enrolled in summer courses can contact SHCC and pay a \$78 bridge fee to access services. No charge for routine physical exams and mental health counseling. Laboratory and pharmacy services are available at a reduced cost.

Technology Fee: \$5 per credit hour for students registered in 1 or more credits. Maximum charge \$60.



UAA is Changing Loan Programs

This summer we are in a transition to a new student loan program. In the past, we have participated in the Federal Family Education Loan Program in which student loans are made by banks and other financial institutions. Starting with Spring 2010, we began the transition from the Federal Family Education Loan Program (FFELP) to the **Federal Direct Student Loan Program (DL)**.

Why is the University changing its loan process?

Volatility in the credit markets and reductions in lender subsidies have caused many lenders to stop offering borrower benefits and reduce their level of customer service. Several major lenders have made changes to their program that caused a delay in students receiving funds or other inconveniences. Some have dropped out of the FFELP program altogether, sometimes without notice. The Direct Loan program is not impacted by changes in the economy. We believe that this program will offer students and parents a more streamlined, stable, and predictable borrowing experience.

The Congress of the United States has also indicated they plan to complete legislation that will end the FFELP. With this decision pending, the University decided to begin an immediate transition to allow a smooth and timely switch.

Is there a difference between the programs?

In both programs students borrow Federal Stafford Loans and PLUS loans under the same terms. The loan limits are the same and the interest rates are the same. The only difference is that borrowers no longer need to choose a lender. Under the DL there is only one lender, the US Department of Education.

I am a student loan borrower, what do I need to do?

All borrowers will need to complete a Master Promissory Note (MPN) for the Federal Direct Loan program at www.dlenote.ed.gov. You will also need to complete new entrance counseling at www.dl.ed.gov.

Of course a critical step in the process is to complete your **2010-11 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** at www.fafsa.gov.

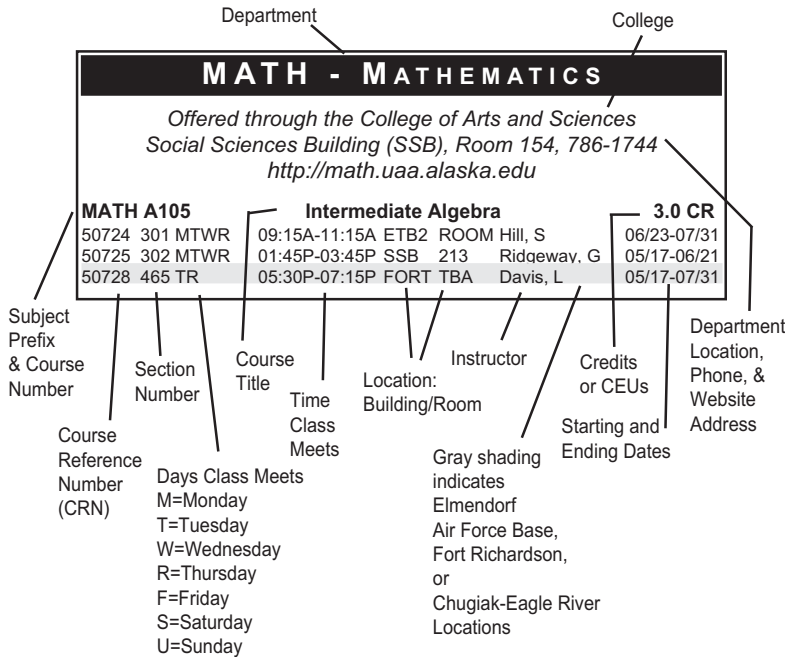

Blackboard

What is Blackboard?

Blackboard is an Internet-based course management system. Through Blackboard, students and faculty interact within a distance class. Students use Blackboard to gain access to the course materials, assignments and other important items related to their distance class.

Where do I get my Blackboard user name and password?

Go to technology.uaa.alaska.edu/blackboard and find the Username Lookup link in the bottom left of the page, or go directly to me.uaa.alaska.edu. Choose Option 3, enter the requested information and follow the prompts.

Where is my Blackboard class located?
