

RESIDENTIAL FACILITIES

The Anchorage campus provides on-campus housing for 950 students. Traditional residence halls are secured 24 hours a day and accessible only by swiping an authorized key card. Apartment facilities are individually keyed for student safety. Access to residential community living spaces is restricted to residents of a specific residence hall or apartment and their escorted guests. A resident must escort their guests at all times.

In all areas, resident advisors are on duty from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. weekdays and 24-hours a day on weekends and University holidays.

The University of Alaska Anchorage or any of its extended campuses has no Greek or other student club or organization housing.

BUILDING ACCESS

Most campus educational buildings and facilities are accessible to members of the community, guest, and visitors. During the academic year, normal business hours are maintained Monday through Friday, while limited hours are maintained on Saturday and Sunday. During semester breaks, hours of access may be greatly reduced. Most buildings are closed to all but employees for University observed holidays. Contact specific building managers or departments for more information on operational hours.

BUILDING MAINTENANCE

The University maintenance staff responds to all requests for repairs. If you need to have University property repaired please call Facilities Maintenance at 786-6980. In UAA's residential facilities, call in a work order to University Housing, Dining, and Conference Services at 751-7202. **You should submit a work order to the Housing Office immediately for services such as smoke detector battery changes, carbon monoxide detector maintenance.**
