



## ***ALASKA ASSOCIATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROFESSIONALS (AAEP) SCHOLARSHIP***

### **Purpose**

To provide scholarships for full-time undergraduate or graduate students currently enrolled in a degree-seeking program in the area of environmental (or natural) sciences, environmental technology, or environmental policy. **One scholarship of \$1,000 will be awarded for the 2009/2010 school year.**

### **Qualifications**

1. Applicant should demonstrate motivation, academic achievement, and leadership potential.
2. Applicant must be in good academic standing with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0.
3. Applicant must be a full-time student in the Fall 2009 and Spring 2010 semesters (12 credits for undergraduates, 9 credits for graduates)
4. Applicant must be formally admitted into a degree-seeking program with an emphasis in environmental (or natural) sciences, environmental technology, or environmental policy.

### **Forfeiture of Award**

Recipient will forfeit the scholarship if he/she:

1. Does not enroll full-time in the spring 2010 semester.
2. Is placed on academic probation.
3. No longer meets the scholarship qualifications.

### **Application Procedure**

Submit the following:

1. The Alaska Association of Environmental Professionals Scholarship application, available at: <http://www.uaa.alaska.edu/scholarships/private.cfm>.
2. Submit a one page personal essay that describes your general education and career goals. You may also emphasize your leadership skills, extracurricular involvement, and any other information you feel is relevant.
3. An updated resume.
4. A minimum of two letters of recommendation.
5. A copy of your unofficial UAA transcript (available from UA Online)

Applications **must be received (not postmarked) by October 30, 2009** to be considered.
