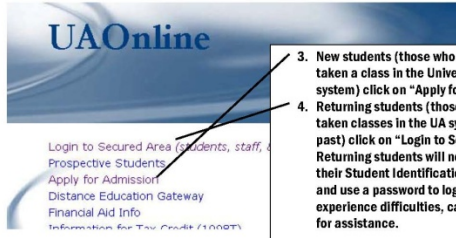
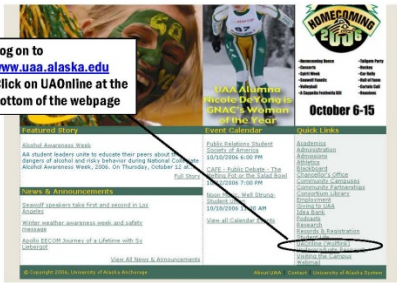
Once you have **completed** the UAOnline application – you will want to do the following:

Admission Application

1. Log on to www.uaa.alaska.edu
2. Click on UAOnline at the bottom of the webpage



3. New students (those who have never taken a class in the University of Alaska system) click on "Apply for Admission"
4. Returning students (those who have taken classes in the UA system in the past) click on "Login to Secured Area." Returning students will need to locate their Student Identification Number and use a password to log in. If you experience difficulties, call 786-1480 for assistance.

1. Submit official high school, GED, or college transcripts to UAA Enrollment Services, PO Box 141629, Anchorage, AK 99514.
 2. Take the ACCUPLACER test in Advising & Testing Center (located in UC: 786-4500).
 3. Meet with your Academic Adviser. Remember that you may register for classes even if you haven't received your certificate of admission letter yet.
