The deans discussed assessment in their units and alignment with specialized accreditation.

UAA's assessment accommodates external requirements for learning outcomes and assessment processes. Programs do not have to assess every learning outcome annually; a rotating cycle can be more manageable.

Possible ways to make assessment more meaningful for faculty: giving permission to experiment and learn from those experiences; identifying and removing barriers; facilitating conversations; providing mentors; and reflecting assessment responsibilities in workloads.

The AAC could organize workshops to facilitate interdisciplinary conversations, and connect experienced faculty with those newer to assessment. The Deans expressed interest in a meeting with the Assessment Seminar speaker.

Reviewing the process and timeline for deans' feedback on assessment.

In planning for the Retreat, the group discussed specialized accreditation as an additional topic to those covered in 2018.
