 - a) The committee was thanked for attending the Core Competency Kick Off and reminded to contribute to the feedback survey and register for the October and November forums.

The AAC will be more involved with Core Competencies and assessment. UAA's focus this year is on mapping student attainment of the Personal, Professional, and Community Responsibility competency.

b) The upcoming Mid-cycle review/report is due in August, with a site visit in Fall 2021. It involves refining student learning and student achievement data to demonstrate UAA is making progress toward the Fall 2024 reaffirmation.

The report will include two strong examples of program assessment, and the committee should send examples to Susan with a rubric and why they are exemplary by December. During initial discussion, the committee suggested Anthropology, Justice, and Occupational Safety and Health.

c) Susan highlighted Rachel Graham and Jennie Brock's NWCCU Mission Fulfillment Fellowship employer survey project, which is almost complete and being prepared for presentation.
