- 4. Core competencies assessment Kristen Ogilvie, Core Competencies Working Group Kristen discussed the qualitative assessment of core competencies, and this year's focus on Intercultural Fluency. A synthetic qualitative report summarizing the findings on the two previous core competencies is in progress.
- 5. General Education assessment Rachel Graham, Gen Ed Assessment Chair Faculty Senate approved the creation of the General Education Council. The committee is using course artifacts for assessment. This year's focus is oral communication.

The Gen Ed committee is in the artifact-collection phase, and graduate submissions are welcome. The AAC was asked for artifacts, and informed that email reminders to faculty would be coming soon. A form will help the committee choose from among submissions to select a variety of artifacts for comparison.
