**Action Items from Last Meeting (March 6, 2026):**

*The following Assessment Plans were reviewed and approved.*

- **BS Civil Engineering:** Last Assessment Plan update was for ABET accreditation in 2022. ABET approved plan, and working well for them. Next update to plan will be for the 2028 ABET accreditation.
- **MS Civil Engineering:** Minor changes to the updated plan presented were suggested. The AAC expects to see another plan update this semester, although changes aren't critical. Their assessment process is working well.
- **OEC Real Estate Management and Investment:** Assessment for this program is included in the CBPP Academic Assessment Plan under Management. The CBPP has a rigorous Assurance of Learning process which includes all representation from all programs.

- Plan a discussion on AI in assessment for a future AAC meeting
- Research AI in assessment for experts who could potentially present at an Assessment seminar in the future
