

Resolution 110317-1

Concerning the Performance of the Single-Instance of Blackboard

WHEREAS, the effective functioning of the university's learning management system is essential to both on-campus and online courses; and

WHEREAS, the faculty have reported a number of significant and time-consuming problems with Blackboard and the Blackboard servers, including not being able to make changes to courses; and

WHEREAS, students have reported a number of problems with blackboard to faculty including an inability to complete assignments because the system is unresponsive; and

WHEREAS, these issues are a significant barrier to student success and retention; and

WHEREAS, the learning management system issues are a significant barrier to faculty providing exemplary teaching; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the University of Alaska Anchorage Faculty Senate supports the following recommendations and requests that

- OIT provide greater, more timely transparency and communication; including the timely reporting of outages and performance degradations directly to faculty and students; and
- OIT implement the governance structure as described by UA Learn implementation plan/team; and
- the Chief Information Technology Officer meet with ACDLITE and faculty to directly discuss these issues and hear faculty concerns; and
- the Chief Information Technology Officer meet with the UAA Faculty Senate to discuss the status of actions taken to address the concerns.
