⁵Students are required to finish three credits of Alaska Native-Themed GER and three credits of Diversity & Inclusion GER coursework. A single course will not satisfy both requirements. If a course overlaps with another Tier II GER requirement category, students can fulfill the three credits with an elective to meet 120 credit requirement.

⁶Any 100-400 level course of any subject that is not already applied towards the degree.

⁷Students must complete an Upper Division Business Statistics Course: BAA375, ECON A312, or ECON A329.

⁸Students must complete an Upper Division ACCT Tax Course: ACCT A409 or ACCT A410, the course not used to satisfy the requirement may be used for U/D ACCT Elective Credit. Both requirements cannot be satisfied with one course.
