



UAA College of Engineering Fall 2017 Mandatory Advising FAQ

1. How do I know if I need to get advising?

If your major is Civil Engineering, Computer Science, Computer Systems Engineering, Electrical Engineering, or Geomatics, you are required to receive advising prior to registering for Fall 2017 classes.

2. How do I know who my advisor is?

You will need to meet with either an Academic Advisor in the CoEng Advising Center or with a faculty advisor within your major. Faculty advisors and their contact information can be found on the CoEng Advising website (www.uaa.alaska.edu/academics/college-of-engineering/advising).

General guidelines as to which advisor you need to see are as follows:

- **Civil Engineering:** if you have completed PHYS A211 and MATH A252 (Calc II) with a C or better, see a faculty advisor. If you have not, or are currently taking them, see the Advising Center.
- **Computer Science & Computer Systems Engineering:** if you have completed CSCE A211, see a faculty advisor. If you have not, or are currently taking it, see the Advising Center.
- **Electrical Engineering:** if you are currently taking or have completed EE A203, see a faculty advisor. If you have not, see the Advising Center.
- **Geomatics:** if you have completed or are currently taking GEO A156, see a faculty advisor. If you have not, see the Advising Center.

3. When should I get advising?

You should receive advising prior to your registration date. UAA's Dates and Deadlines page outlines when students can register based on their class standing. www.uaa.alaska.edu/students/registrar/calendar/

4. When will the advising hold be placed on my student account?

All CoEng mandatory advising holds will be put on March 20, 2017.

5. What happens if I don't get advising done before registration opens?

The academic advising hold will be on your account until you complete your advising. This means you will not be able to register for Fall 2017 classes until the hold is removed, and the hold may affect additional functions such as viewing your transcript, etc.

6. How do I get in contact with my advisor to schedule an appointment?
