Abstract: The presentation will provide an overview of the Alaska LNG project and the three main components: the gas treatment plant on the North Slope, the 800-mile pipeline, and the LNG plant in Nikiski. In particular, the presentation will provide a vision of the pathway forward now that the Alaska Gasline Development Corporation (AGDC) is the sole FERC applicant for the project. The Alaska LNG project is in the "pre-file" phase. The full FERC application will be submitted on or before June 30, 2017

Biography: Mr. Krusen is responsible for AGDC oversight and technical aspects of the Alaska LNG Project. Previously, he had a 36-year career with ConocoPhillips that included engineering, technical management, and project management positions; most recently serving as Chief Facilities Engineer. He brings 25 years of worldwide LNG experience to the position; including design, startup, and operations.
