## Northern Lights Boulevard Chester Creek Crossing Emergency Repair

A sink hole was discovered in Northern Lights Boulevard in December of 2019. By early September 2020, the roadway and culvert below it was completely repaired! Learn how this fast-paced project fixed a failing culvert in less than nine months from start to construction completion.
