ACI 318-08 Section D.2.2 – “This appendix applies to both cast-in anchor and post-installed anchors... adhesive or grouted anchors... are **not** included.” (emphasis mine)

Adhesive anchors are used under 2009 IBC Section 104.11.1 "Research reports. Supporting data, where necessary to assist in the approval of materials or assemblies not specifically provided for in this code, shall consist of valid research reports from approved sources" (or similar sections in earlier versions of the building code).

In June 2013, [ICC-ES adopted changes to AC308](#) with a mandatory compliance date of January 15, 2014. Now every single ICC-ES or IAPMO-ES adhesive anchor research report **requires** certified installers for horizontal or vertically inclined anchors in sustained tension. In addition, the 2012 and 2015 IBC (via ACI 318-11 and 318-14) requires certified installers. Even if you don't use the 2012 (or 2015) IBC yet, Adhesive Anchor Installer Certification is required.
