RRANN Scholarship Requirements

1. Have a complete RRANN enrollment form on file. Your enrollment form is valid from the time you sign it until you graduate.
2. Have a 2.0 or higher GPA.
3. Attend at least one RRANN Gathering per Fall and Spring terms.
4. Be a nursing major currently enrolled in at least 6 nursing (NS or NURS) credits.
5. Give a gift to RRANN: Digital gifts should be emailed to rmkittoe@alaska.edu with "RRANN Student Gift" in the subject line.
 - Provide good-quality digital photos featuring class, clinicals, or participation in cultural/traditional activities. Please provide a short description of any photo submitted including the names of people in the photo. NOTE: Be sure that you get permission to submit a photo from each person in the photo.
 - A paragraph or two on why you want to be a nurse, unique contributions you can offer the nursing profession, ways RRANN has helped you, an important moment in class or clinicals, or a discussion of a cultural/traditional activity you do with your community, friends or family.
 - Serve as a guest speaker on behalf of RRANN at a University of Alaska/RRANN fundraiser or event.
 - Donate a nursing-related or cultural/traditional door prize to be given away at a RRANN Gathering (\$15-\$20 value).
 - Donate new or gently used green School of Nursing lab coats, green School of Nursing scrubs, or green School of Nursing polo shirts. RRANN is no longer accepting textbook donations.
 - If you have a different idea for your student gift, please talk to or email RRANN staff. RRANN staff is always interested in your ideas!
