At CHA, our sole purpose is to be available to help youth in crisis 24 hours a day, seven days a week, 365 days a year. Through our continuum of care of services we meet the basic needs of youth in crisis, while providing them with the support to become healthy, self-sufficient, contributing members of our community. Our continuum of care includes: street outreach, 24 hour emergency shelter, day drop-in services, housing services, health care services, youth engagement, pastoral ministry, employment /education assistance, counseling, life skill development, and transitional living programs.

Youth Engagement Specialist I-IV – Part-Time

Covenant House Alaska is recruiting for part-time Youth Engagement Specialists (YES) to join our day or evening shelter services team. This position reports to the Shelter Program Coordinator and provides and ensures a high quality trauma informed service delivery in case work and all aspects of youth care at the Youth Engagement Center through direct supervision, management, and program development. The YES I/II will build intentional relationships with youth, engage them in a variety of programming and work through their stages of change in order to drive toward long term positive outcomes. The YES I/II provides crisis intervention, advocacy, intakes, discharges, case management support, engagement opportunities and supervision of youth ages 13-21. This position will work 16-20 hours a week, not to exceed more than two shifts weekly. A High School Diploma is required; Associates or Bachelor's Degree in Human Services, Social Work, Psychology or a related field is preferred with one (1) to two (2) years of experience working in a residential setting or in a program serving adolescents including case work preparation; life, volunteer, internship will be considered.

Back On Track - Youth Engagement Specialist

Covenant House Alaska is recruiting for a Back on Track - Youth Engagement Specialists (YES) to join our team. The Back on Track - Youth Engagement Specialist is a new and exciting collaboration between Covenant House Alaska, United Way of Anchorage, and the Anchorage School District. The Back on Track - Youth Engagement Specialist will provide a broad range of case management support to homeless and at-risk youth who are behind in school credits or at risk of dropping out. The goal of Back on Track is to keep youth engaged and through wrap around case management provide youth resources and supports to help them stay in school. The Back On Track - Youth Engagement Specialist (YES) provides and ensures high quality trauma informed service delivery in case work and all aspects of youth care. The Back On Track YES will provide case management support for youth attending the AVAIL's Child In Transition Day and Evening Classroom at Covenant House Alaska, afterschool and summer school. The Back on Track YES will build intentional relationships with youth; engage them in a variety of programming with the goal of helping youth complete their high school diploma. A Bachelor's degree in Human Services, Social Work, Psychology or a related field is required. Minimum of two (2) to three (3) years of experience working with adolescent population, preferably in a residential setting including case work preparation; life, volunteer, internship will be considered. One (1) year experience in a supervisory capacity is required.

Youth Engagement Specialist III/IV – Evening

Covenant House Alaska is recruiting for a Youth Engagement Specialist (YES) to join our shelter services evening team. This position reports to the Shelter Program Coordinator and provides and ensures a high quality trauma informed service delivery in case work and all aspects of youth care at the Youth Engagement Center through direct supervision, management, and program development on the evening shift. The YES III/IV will build intentional relationships with youth, engage them in a variety of programming and work through their stages of change in order to drive toward long term positive outcomes. The YES III/IV may serve as the on-site supervisor and therefore must exercise independent and sound judgment at all times particularly in regards to youth, staff and facility safety. The YES III/IV will supervise the evening shift's primary functions; provide crisis intervention, advocacy, intakes, discharges, case management support, engagement opportunities and supervision of youth ages 13-21. A Bachelor's degree in Human Services, Social Work, Psychology or a related field is required. Minimum of two (2) to three (3) years of experience working with adolescent population, preferably in a residential setting including case work preparation; life, volunteer, internship will be considered. One (1) to Two (2) years of experience in supervisory capacity is required.
