- **Three Reminders:**
 - Please ask your admin's to run a report of your program's *provisional* admits. Review if the student has met their provisions; if so, please update their GARF and return to the Office of Admissions for full acceptance. If not, advisor and student should update their GSP and complete an annual report. We want no provisional admits going into graduation; optimally, all students should be fully accepted by their third semester of study.
 - The **deadline** for submitting institutional nominations for the **WAGS Outstanding Thesis Award** is **September 23**. Please canvas your faculty advisors for their recommendations.
 - A **Report of Graduate Student Progress** for students who started their degree in summer or fall is due on May 15th every year. Please complete one of two reporting modalities as soon as possible if you missed the deadline. For INDS and students awarded an assistantship or fellowship, or students NOT making satisfactory progress, an Annual Report form must be submitted. For all other students, a predefined note ("Student is making satisfactory academic progress") in DegreeWorks is sufficient. Please remind and forward this request to all assigned faculty advisors.
- I have begun a conversation with Educational Testing Services (ETS) on breaking out the **Writing Analysis** portion of the GRE as a stand-alone writing assessment tool for admissions and/or remediation. ETS wants faculty input as to items for which they would be looking in a writing assessment tool and how they could foresee using it. Do you think such a tool would have value? Please share this request with your faculty advisors and/or admissions committee. Please email your comments to me by October 6, 2019.
