

## Overview

UAA significantly reduced the number of sections offered in Fall 19. The decline in the number of sections (-14.5%) exceeded the decline in credit hours (-13.5%) and in headcount (-12.8%), producing a slightly higher average course size on the majority of campus sites and colleges. Exceptions included the Kenai Peninsula College's Kenai River Campus and the College of Engineering.

### NOTES:

1) Sections/courses coded as independent study, individual research, thesis, and private music lessons were not included.

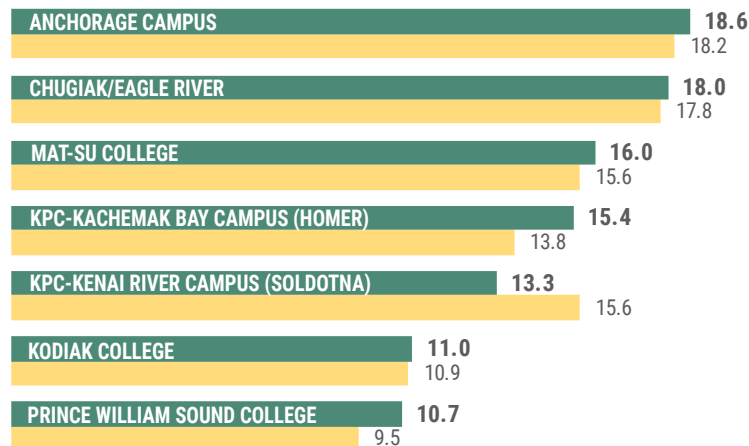
2) Only active sections/courses were included. These are defined as those that were not cancelled and have students registered.

3) Average course size is the total student seat count for a given fall divided by the total course (section) count.

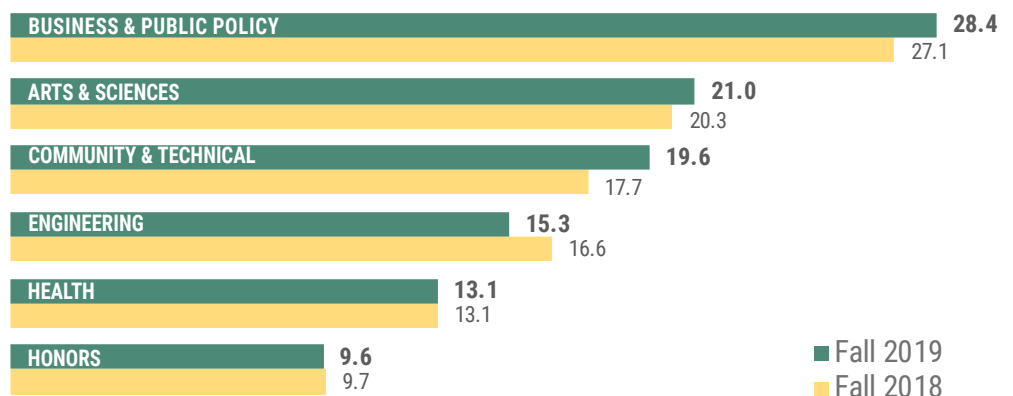
