

# Student Credit Hours in GER Courses

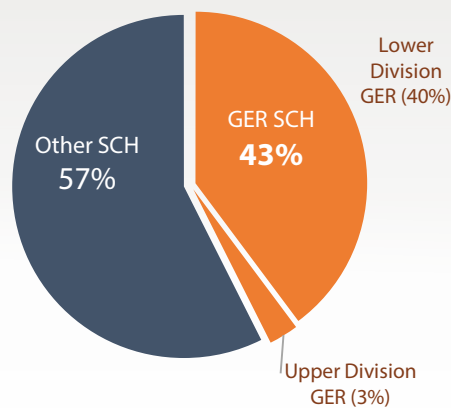
## General Education Requirement (GER) Description

Students earning a 4-year baccalaureate degree are required to complete 37 credits in general education courses.

General Education Requirements (GER) provide students with a common educational experience to provide a foundation for further study, and broaden the educational experience of every degree-seeking student.

These courses promote an elevation of the student's level in basic, college-level skills (Tier 1/12 credits); a breadth of exposure to traditional academic disciplines (Tier 2/22 credits); and experience in applying an education to understanding and responding to the evolving state of knowledge and the world in the 21st century (Tier 3/3credits).

**43%** of all student credit hours at UAA is generated by GER courses.

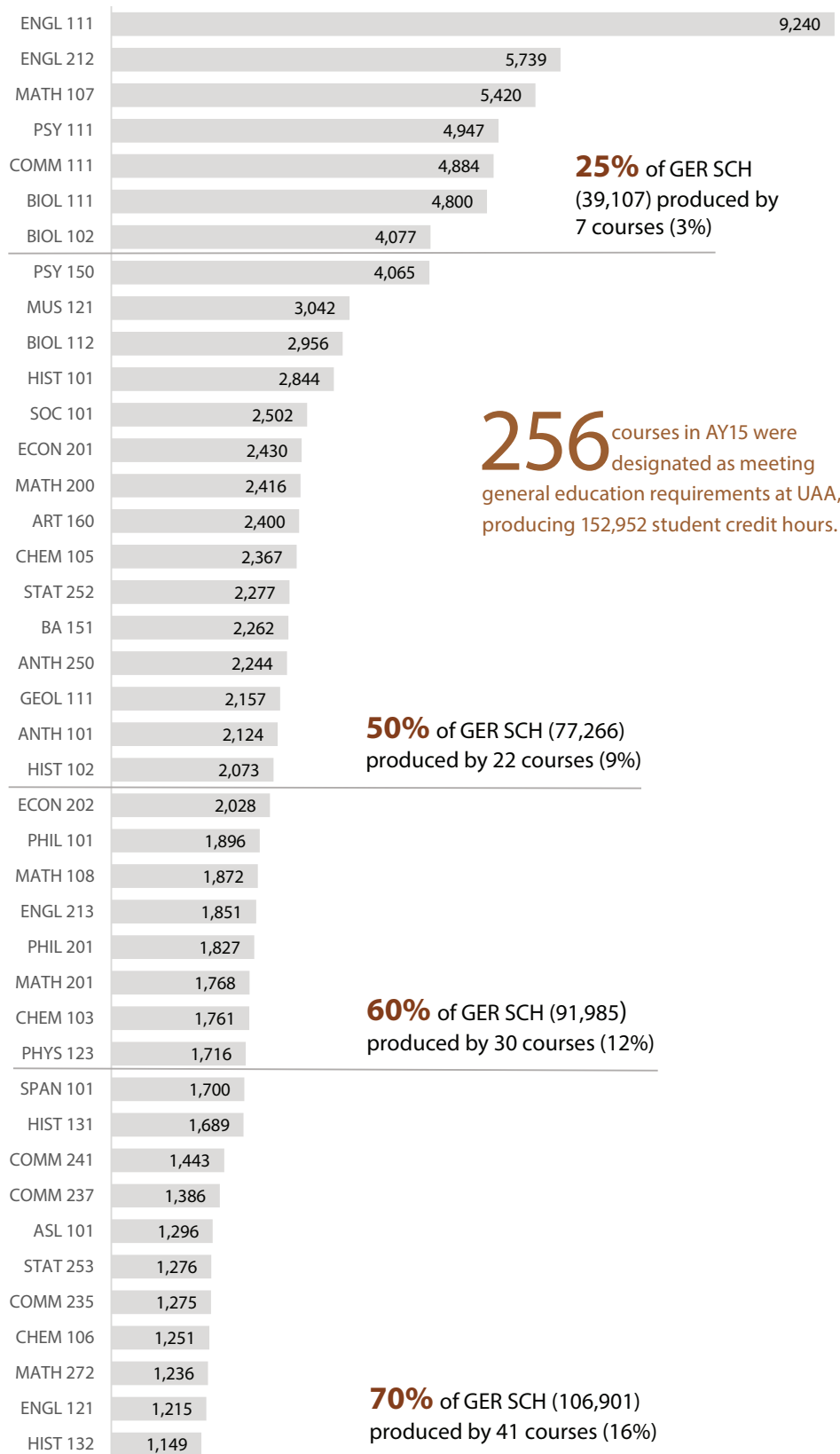

## GER courses producing the most credit hours in AY15



**25%** of GER SCH (39,107) produced by 7 courses (3%)

**256** courses in AY15 were designated as meeting general education requirements at UAA, producing 152,952 student credit hours.

**50%** of GER SCH (77,266) produced by 22 courses (9%)

**60%** of GER SCH (91,985) produced by 30 courses (12%)

**70%** of GER SCH (106,901) produced by 41 courses (16%)

**30%** of GER SCH (46,051) produced by the remaining 215 GER courses (84%)
