
Peer List Development and Benchmarking

Prepared for the University of Alaska Anchorage

In the following pages, Hanover Research outlines the methodology used to develop a set of 20 peers for the University of Alaska Anchorage (UAA) and then provides detailed profiles for each institution. The peers were identified based on four main criteria, which include undergraduate certificates and associate degrees conferred in 2010, undergraduate and graduate student enrollment, part-time attendance rates, and the percentage of American Indian and Alaska Native students. This updated report includes an analysis of UAA's performance compared to these Hanover-identified peer institutions.

Introduction

In the following pages, Hanover Research outlines the methodology used to develop a set of 20 peers for the University of Alaska Anchorage (UAA) and then provides detailed profiles of each institution. The peers were identified based on four main criteria, which include undergraduate certificates and associate degrees conferred in 2010, undergraduate and graduate student enrollment, part-time attendance rates, and the percentage of American Indian and Alaska Native students. For each peer institution, we provide a detailed profile that includes information on graduation rates, retention rates, part-time enrollment, degree-seeking status, student demographics, and degree conferrals. With the exception of state demographic data,¹ all information provided in the profiles is from the National Center for Education Statistics' (NCES) Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS).

¹ Information on state demographics was obtained from the Census Bureau's American Community Survey 3-year estimates, Table B03002.

Methodology

In the following paragraphs, Hanover details the methodology used to develop the set of UAA's peer institutions. All data used in our analyses were obtained from the National Center for Education Statistics' (NCES) Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS). We used 2010 data in order to reflect the current status of each institution.

We first selected a set of basic criteria to generate a list of potential peer institutions. For this initial list, institutions had to meet the following criteria:

- ❖ *Carnegie Classification 2010: Basic*: Master's Colleges and Universities (medium and larger programs)
- ❖ *Sector of Institution*: public, 4-year or above

Using the data available from IPEDS, we created several new variables. First, we calculated the percentages of undergraduate and graduate students attending part-time. We also combined degree conferral data for "Certificates of less than 1-year" and "Certificates of 1 but less than 2-years" to create a variable for the total number of certificates awarded below the baccalaureate level.

The next step was to determine how closely each of the potential peer institutions matched UAA for each characteristic. We selected variables that accurately represent the university's unique qualities, and then used the following calculations to gauge similarity:

$$\frac{\text{Peer Value} - \text{UAA's Value}}{\text{UAA's Value}}$$

The absolute value of the result for each variable then represents the percentage difference away from the target institution's value. Variables for which this percentage was calculated included:

- ❖ Number of certificates awarded below the baccalaureate level (2010)
- ❖ Associate degree conferrals (2010)
- ❖ Total undergraduate enrollment
- ❖ Total graduate enrollment
- ❖ Percentage enrolled part-time (undergraduate):
- ❖ Percentage enrolled part-time (graduate)
- ❖ Percent American Indian/Alaska Native (total enrollment)

We then applied different weights to each of the above percentages using the following formula:

$$(\text{Value A} * \text{X}\%) + (\text{Value B} * \text{Y}\%) + (\text{Value C} * \text{Z}\%) \dots = \text{Weighted Similarity Score}$$

The following weights were used in this formula:

- ❖ Number of certificates awarded below the baccalaureate level: **20%**
- ❖ Associate degree conferrals: **20%**
- ❖ Total undergraduate enrollment: **5%**
- ❖ Total graduate enrollment: **5%**
- ❖ Percentage enrolled part-time (undergraduate): **20%**
- ❖ Percentage enrolled part-time (graduate): **10%**
- ❖ Percent American Indian/Alaska Native (total enrollment): **20%**

As shown above, the weighted similarity score was based on four general criteria: **number of certificates and degrees conferred** (40 percent), **student population** (10 percent), **part-time attendance** (30 percent), and **concentration of American Indian/Alaska Native (AIAN) students** (20 percent). The values for undergraduate certificates awarded and associate degrees conferred were assigned relatively high weights (20 percent each) because we primarily intended to identify institutions that do confer large numbers of these levels of awards. Part-time attendance variables also received high weights (20 percent for undergraduate, 10 percent for graduate) in an effort to identify peer institutions with large percentages of students attending part-time at both the undergraduate and graduate levels. The high weight assigned to the percentage of AIAN students allowed institutions with a large AIAN enrollment to be included in the peer list even if they might not have been included as a result of other variables. Finally, student population was only assigned a total weight of 10 percent (5 percent each for undergraduate and graduate enrollment) because we determined that it was more important to identify institutions with similar qualitative characteristics rather than a similarly-sized student population.

The 20 institutions with the lowest weighted similarity score, indicating that they were most similar to UAA, were selected for the peer list. The table on the following pages lists each of the 20 peer institutions, in order of similarity to UAA, along with the value and similarity score for each of the weighted variables. A low similarity score (the italicized percentage underneath each value) indicates that the institution is similar to UAA for that quality.

Analysis of Findings

In the next several pages, we present tables and figures summarizing overall trends among the 20 peer institutions. Selected analyses are provided below. For a full analysis of findings, see the Comparator Peer Benchmarking report, which compares UAA's performance to both the comparator peer list and the Hanover-generated peer list.

Health and STEM Degrees Conferred in 2010

Two of UAA's peer institutions awarded a larger percentage of degrees in STEM disciplines (Purdue University-Calumet Campus and Ferris State University). Five peer institutions awarded a larger percentage of degrees and certificates in health sciences (Armstrong Atlantic State University, Indiana University-Northwest, New Mexico Highlands University, Northwestern State University of Louisiana, and Washburn University).

Comparison of Student and Graduate Demographics

We compared the demographic breakdowns of enrolled students to 2010 graduates in order to determine if specific race groups are over- or under-represented in graduation figures compared to enrollment figures, starting with AIAN students and graduates. Figure 1 illustrates the results: 13 of the Hanover-identified peer institutions have an AIAN student concentration that is higher than the corresponding AIAN graduate concentration, while just six have a higher concentration of AIAN graduates than enrolled students.

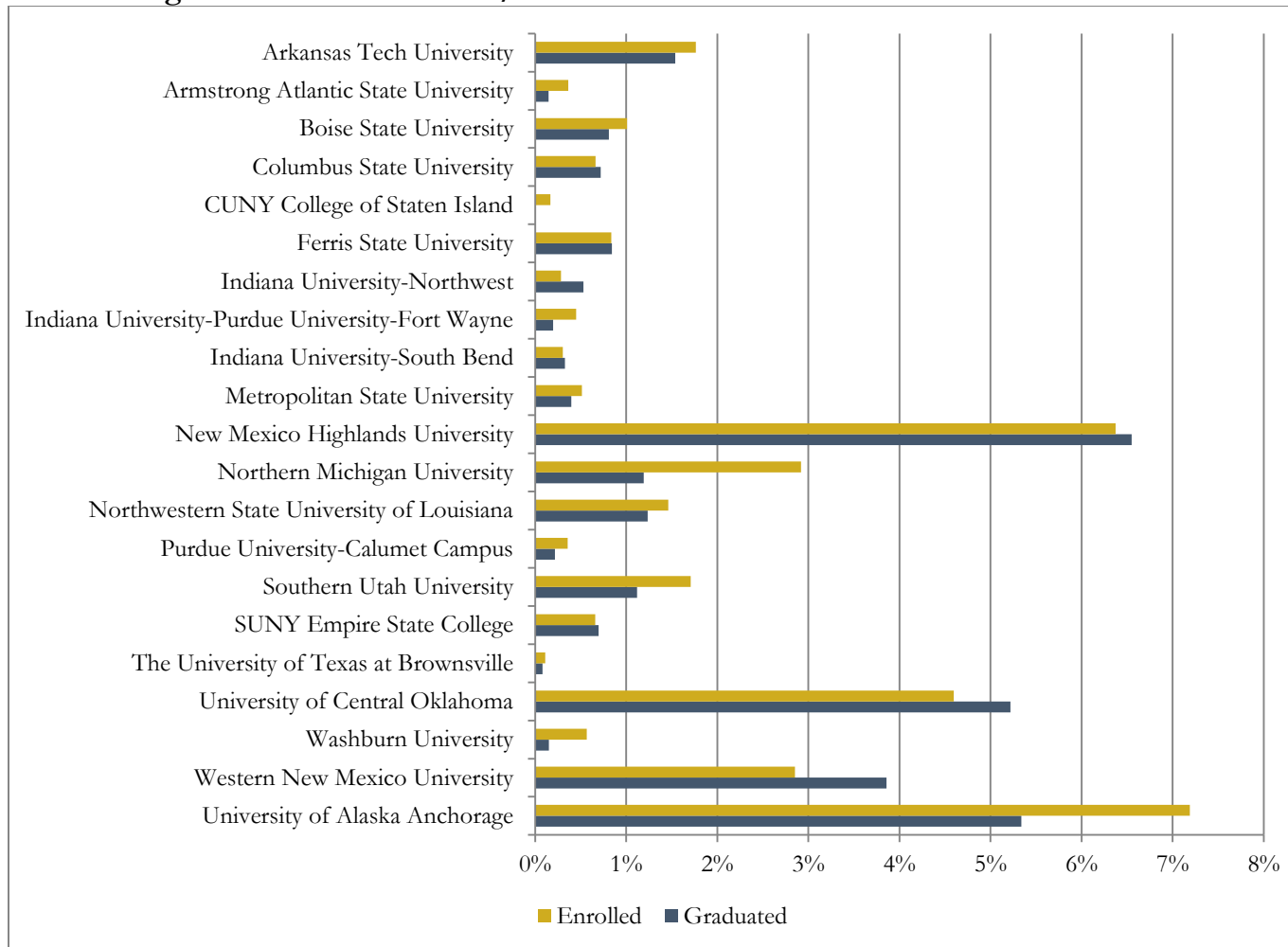


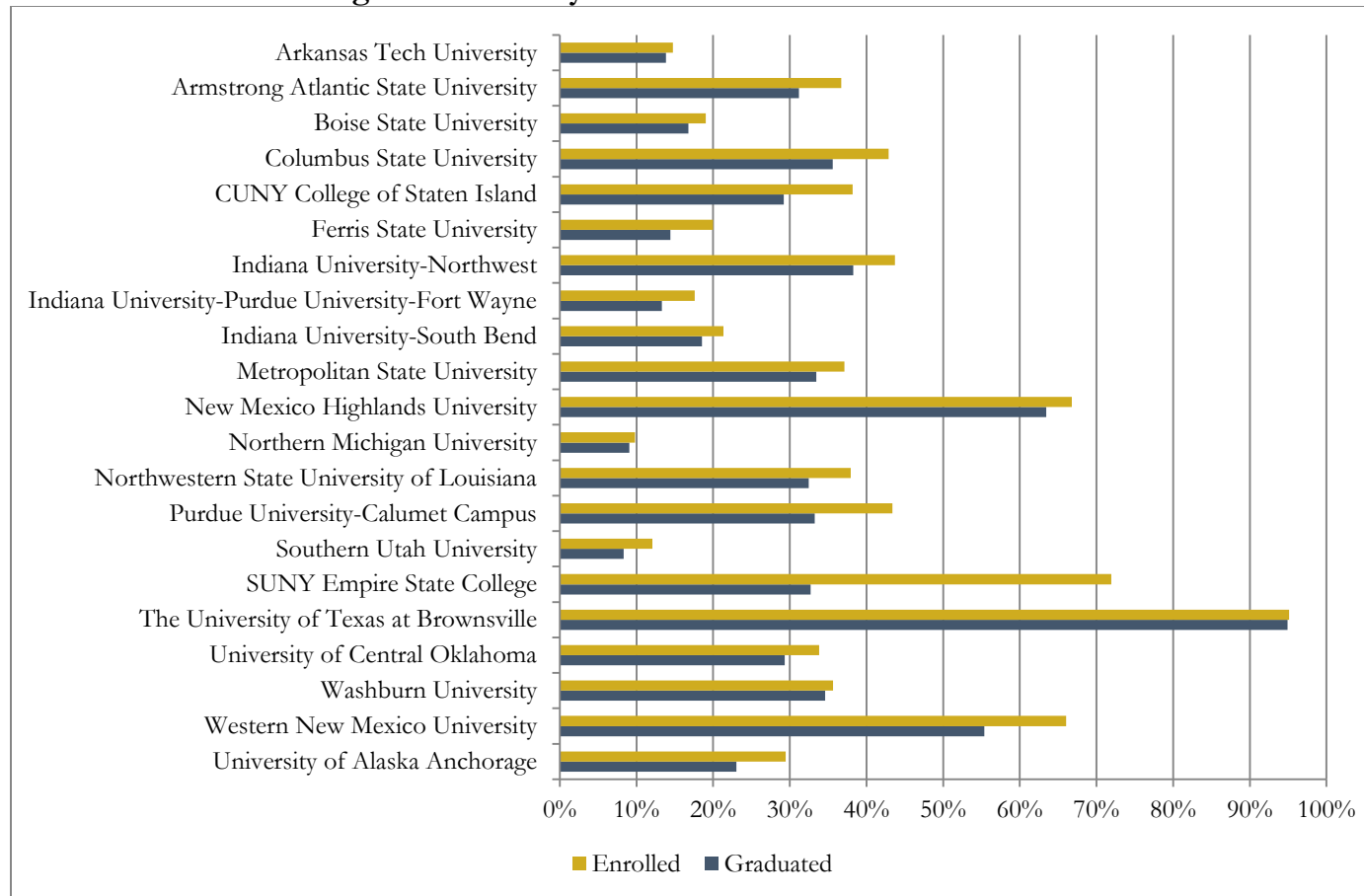
Figure 2: Minority Students Enrolled and Graduated

We then compared the same statistics for all other minority groups, which included black or African American, Asian, Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander, Hispanic or Latino, two or more races, unknown race, and nonresident alien students and graduates. Figure 2 illustrates these results. Surprisingly, all of the Hanover-identified peer institutions had a higher concentration of these minority groups among students than among 2010 graduates.

Retention Rates

Overall, retention rates (the percentage of students from the 2009 cohort that enrolled in fall 2010) were much higher among full time students than part-time students; Table 8 demonstrates these results. Full time students at the Hanover-identified peer institutions have an average retention rate of 65.8 percent and a median rate of 69.0 percent. Part-time retention rates are even lower, with a group average of 43.2 percent and median of 46.0 percent). With full time and part-time retention rates of 71 percent and 51 percent, respectively, it appears that UAA is

performing noticeably better than institutions with similar qualities in the areas of full time and part-time student retention.

Graduation Rates

For graduation rates, we provide five sets of statistics available from IPEDS in order to more accurately portray each institution's graduation trends: total cohort, bachelor's degree in four years, bachelor's degree in five years, bachelor's degree in six years, and total for white students.² As shown in Table 8, UAA's total cohort graduation rate (28 percent) is only slightly lower than the group average for the Hanover-identified peer group (30.9 percent), and UAA's graduation rate among white students is actually higher than the group average (33 percent compared to 32.4 percent). Therefore, these findings suggest that UAA is underperforming by a small margin compared to Hanover's set of peer institutions.

Figure 1: American Indian/Alaska Native Students Enrolled and Graduated
