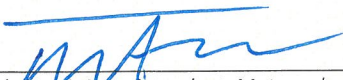
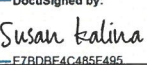
Accordingly, UAA maintains articulation agreements with the Matanuska Susitna Borough School District (MSBSD) for CTE courses that have been reviewed and approved by UAA faculty for equivalency to UAA courses. Previously approved articulations remain in effect. In spring 2026, UAA faculty completed additional course reviews, and several new MSBSD CTE courses were added to the articulation. The following UAA course equivalencies are approved for the 2026-2027 academic year. This agreement is updated annually.
