Re: **AY20 Expedited Program Review Findings – Justice BA**

I have reviewed the dean's findings and the completed Expedited Program Review Template for the Justice BA. The Provost's Office did not receive an Optional Program Response Form from the program.

Recommendations

My recommendation is to change the recommendation to continued review and accepting the other recommendations of the dean with the additional commentary that the program offers too many sections per year of several core courses and too many noncore electives. The program will need to reduce the number of faculty or increase AY faculty salary support from external grant activity. The institution does not have the resources to sustain the program as currently configured. An interim progress report on all recommendations is due to the dean by March 1, 2021. The dean will submit a review along with the program's interim progress report to the provost by April 1, 2021. A follow-up Program Review will be conducted in AY22.
