


Annual Academic Assessment Survey Report

University of Alaska Anchorage - Overall Report



The results of the Annual Academic Assessment Survey allow UAA to highlight student achievement of program student learning outcomes and to recognize faculty efforts toward improving their programs. This data includes all survey results as of June 2013.

59% of reporting UAA programs indicated over 50% faculty participation in assessment activities this year.



By June 2013, 61% of reporting UAA programs had at least compiled or aggregated their assessment data, and 18% of reporting programs indicated already making recommendations for improvements based on assessment data.



For the purposes of this report, “program” may refer to a group of programs which are assessed together and submit only one report.

Total # of UAA programs which indicated making improvements to their assessment plan this academic year:

Percentage of measured Program Student Learning Outcomes (PSLOs) for which students met or exceeded faculty expectations:

95%

The ultimate goal of academic program assessment at UAA is to serve as a resource for improving teaching and learning. Over the course of this academic year, at least 54% of reported UAA program improvements have impacted curriculum and teaching.
