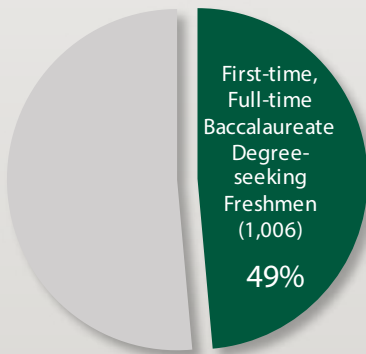


6-Year Baccalaureate Graduation Rate AY18

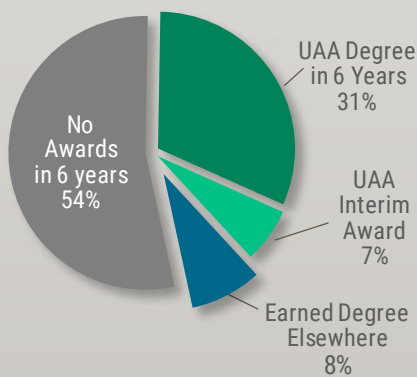
DEFINITION

The percentage of first-time, full-time, baccalaureate degree-seeking students enrolled in a given fall semester who earn a degree within six years (150% of the time to complete a four-year degree). The 2018 rate measures the cohort who entered UAA in fall 2012 and completed their baccalaureate degree by August 2018.

45% EARNED AN AWARD WITHIN 6 YEARS AT UAA OR ANOTHER INSTITUTION

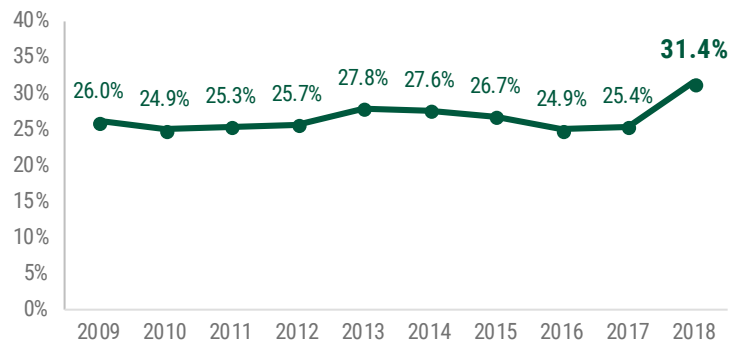

OVERVIEW

In fall 2012, 1,006 individuals entered UAA as first-time, full-time, baccalaureate degree-seeking students. Six years later 316 (31.4%) had earned their degree. This 6-year completion rate is the highest achieved at UAA since the institution began tracking this measure in 1999. While UAA's rate has improved, it remains below the average among its peers which was 38% for the fall 2012 cohort.

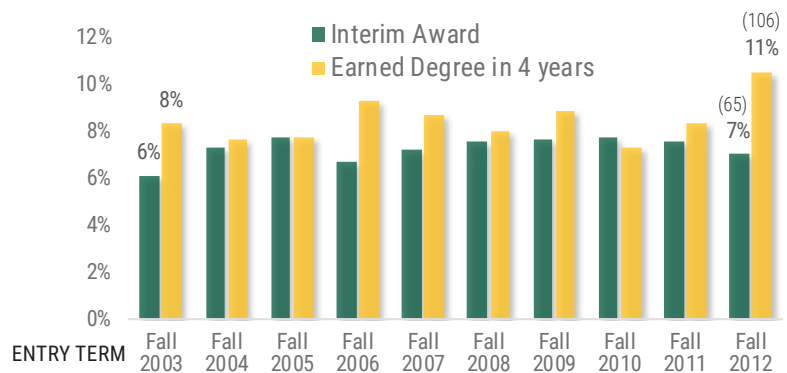

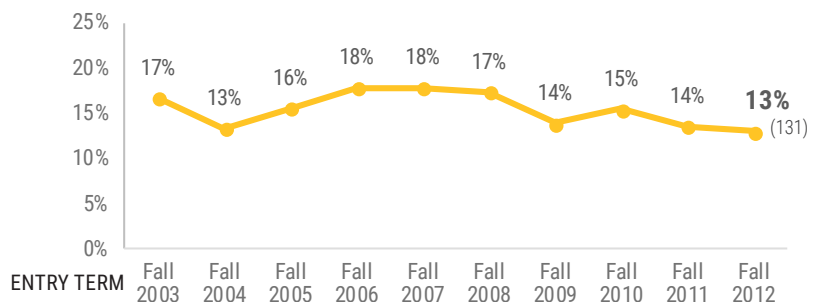

GOAL

NOTE: Of the students from the fall 2000-2009 cohorts still enrolled at UAA in year six, an average of 45% earned their baccalaureate degree by year 10.

UAA BACCALAUREATE DEGREE SIX-YEAR COMPLETION RATE

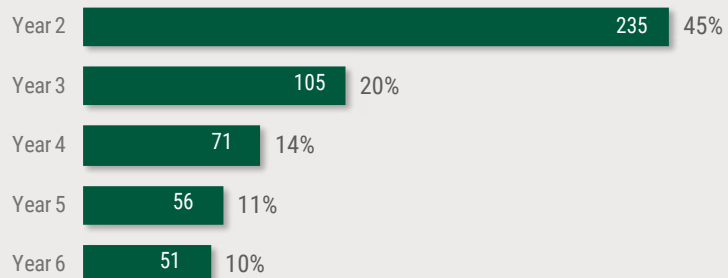
