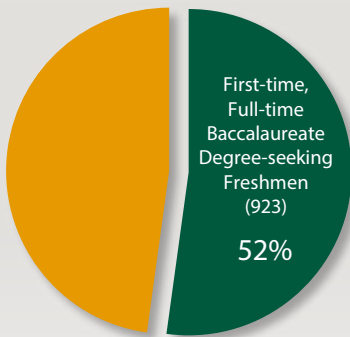


# 6-Year Baccalaureate Graduation Rate

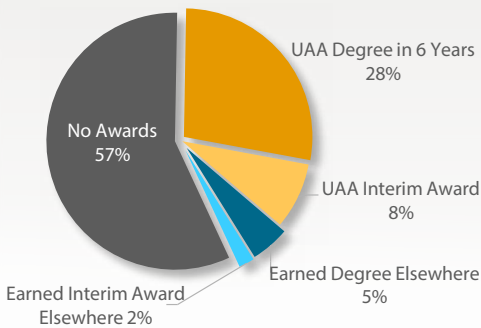
## DEFINITION

The percentage of first-time, full-time, baccalaureate degree-seeking students enrolled in a given fall semester who earn a degree within six years (150% of the time to complete a four-year degree). The 2014 rate measures the cohort who entered UAA in Fall 2008 and completed their baccalaureate degree by August 2014.

### 43% EARNED AN AWARD WITHIN SIX YEARS AT UAA OR ANOTHER INSTITUTION



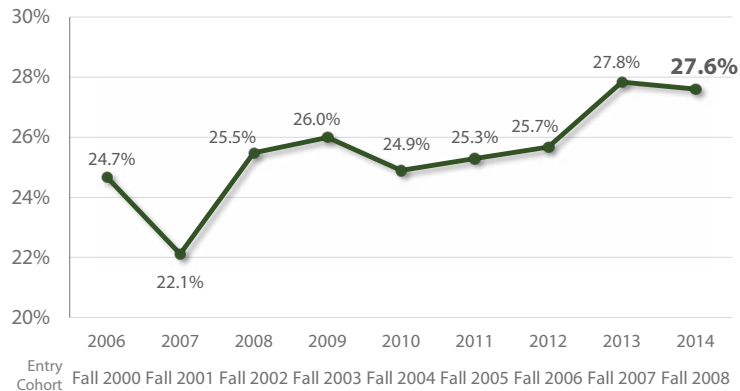
### AN ADDITIONAL 8% EARNED THEIR INTENDED AWARD BY THE END OF 10 YEARS AT UAA

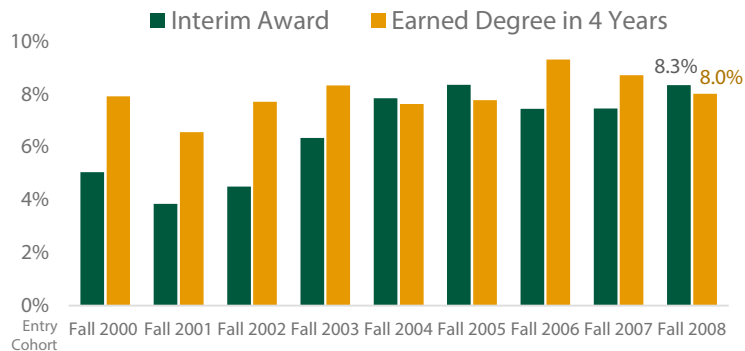
## OVERVIEW

In 2008, 923 individuals entered UAA as first-time, full-time, baccalaureate degree-seeking students. Six years later 255 (27.6%) had earned the degree they originally sought. This 6-year completion rate was within 0.2 percentage points of FY13's record-high. While UAA's rate has improved, it remains below the average among its peers which has ranged from 34-36 percent over the last decade.

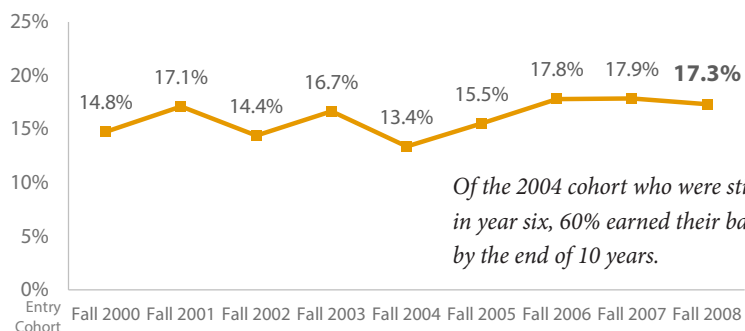
## 27.6% earned their baccalaureate degree in six years (255)

## 17.3% who have not earned any award from UAA are still enrolled here after 6 years (160)

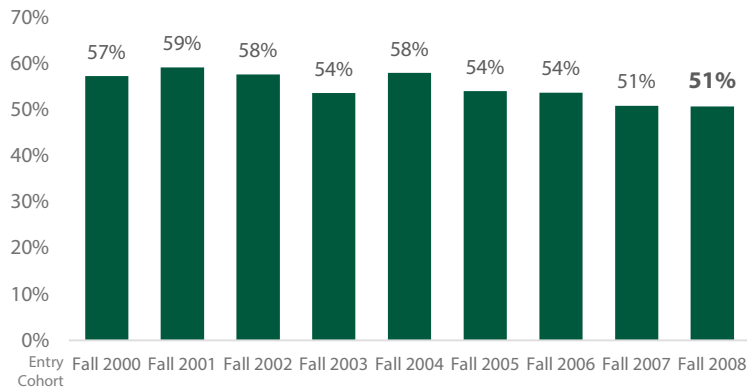


*Of the 2004 cohort who were still enrolled at UAA in year six, 60% earned their baccalaureate degree by the end of 10 years.*

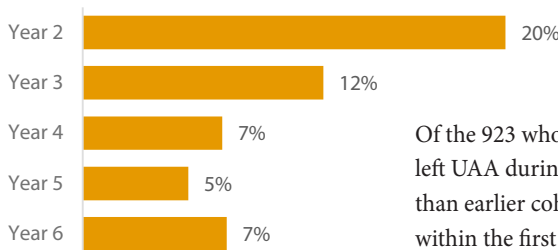

## 51% left UAA without an award and did not return (468)



## 32% left UAA within three years (295)



Of the 923 who entered UAA in Fall 2008, 468 (51%) left UAA during the six years, a somewhat lower rate than earlier cohorts. Of those who left, most did so within the first three years.

## 16% of the cohort enrolled in another college (152)

Sixteen percent of the total entering cohort enrolled in another college. These 152 students represented nearly one third of the 468 students who left UAA and did not return over the six years they were tracked.

## 7% earned a 4-year degree or an interim award at another institution (63)

Of those who enrolled in another institution, 30% (45) earned their four-year degree in six years, slightly higher than the 27.6% rate for students who graduated from UAA. An additional 18 students earned an interim award elsewhere during the six years.
