

# UAA Student Profiles

## FALL 2019

University of Alaska Anchorage students attend class at the large urban campus in Anchorage or one of four community campuses. Campus locations include:

- **Anchorage Campus** - Includes extension sites in Chugiak/Eagle River and Military Education Centers at Joint Base Elmendorf-Richardson
- **Kenai Peninsula College** - Main campuses in Soldotna and Homer with an extension site in Seward
- **Kodiak College** - Kodiak Island
- **Mat-Su College** - Palmer
- **Prince William Sound College** - Main campus in Valdez with extension sites in Cordova and Copper Basin

### DISTINGUISHING CHARACTERISTICS

**91%** of all students are Alaskan residents

**68%** of students at community campuses attend part-time

**57%** of Anchorage Campus students attend part-time

**58%** of all students are “non-traditional” age (25+)

**29%** of first-time freshmen entering in fall 2019 were eligible to enroll in college level Math and Writing based on their placement test scores

Placement scores include SAT/ACT, Accuplacer, and ALEKS tests.

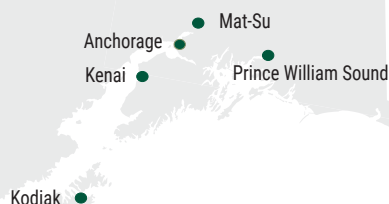

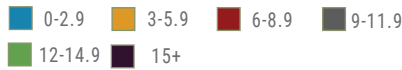

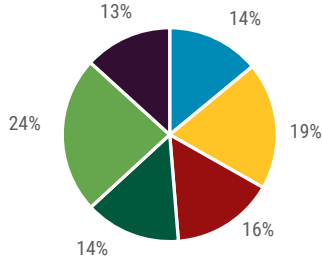

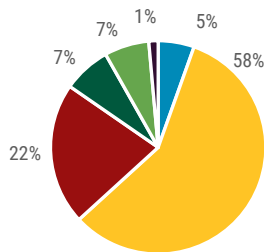
CREDIT HOUR DISTRIBUTION BY STUDENT HEADCOUNT



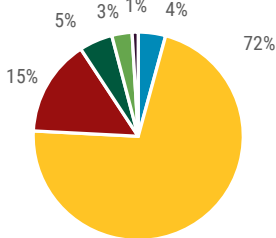

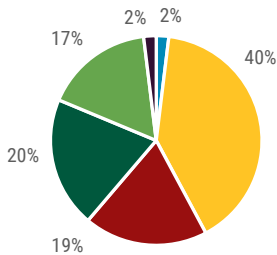

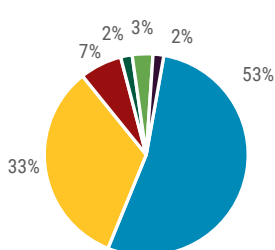

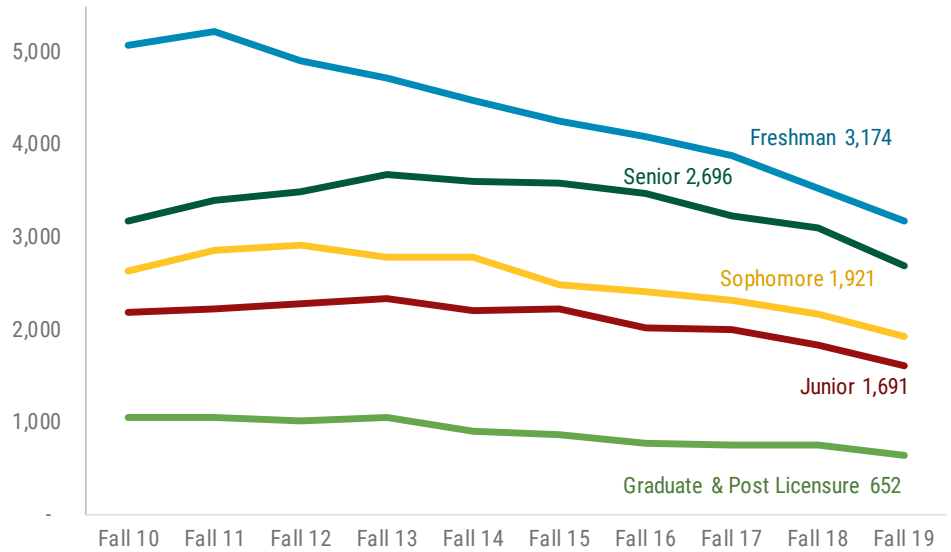

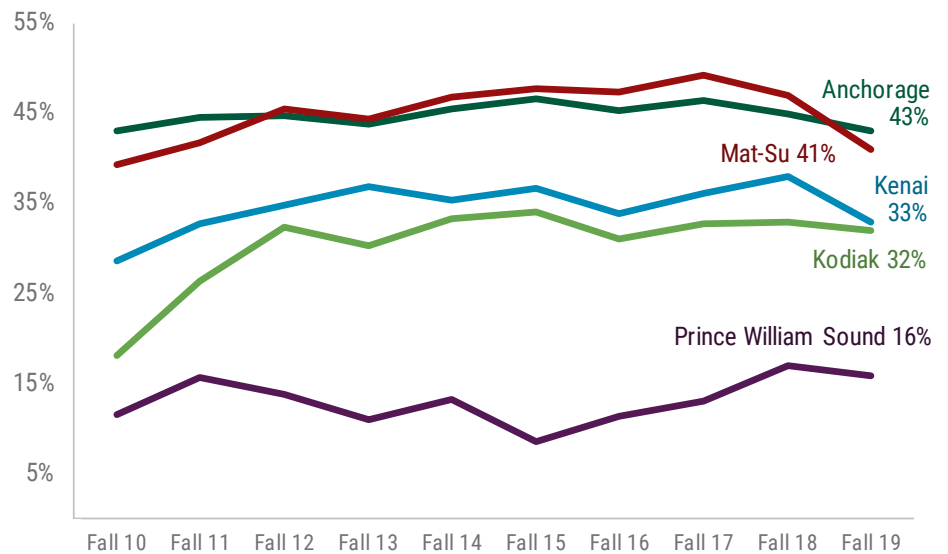
