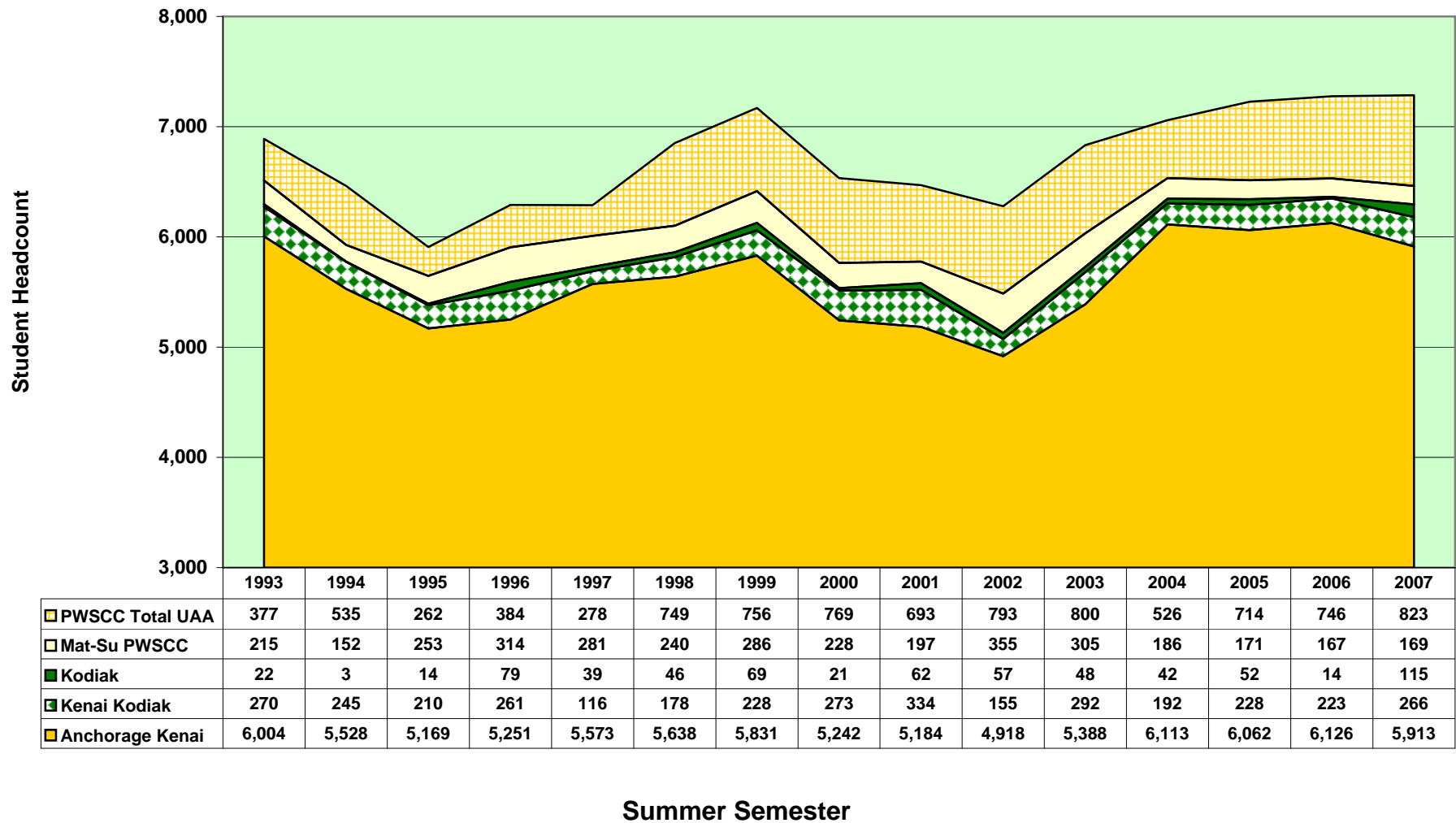

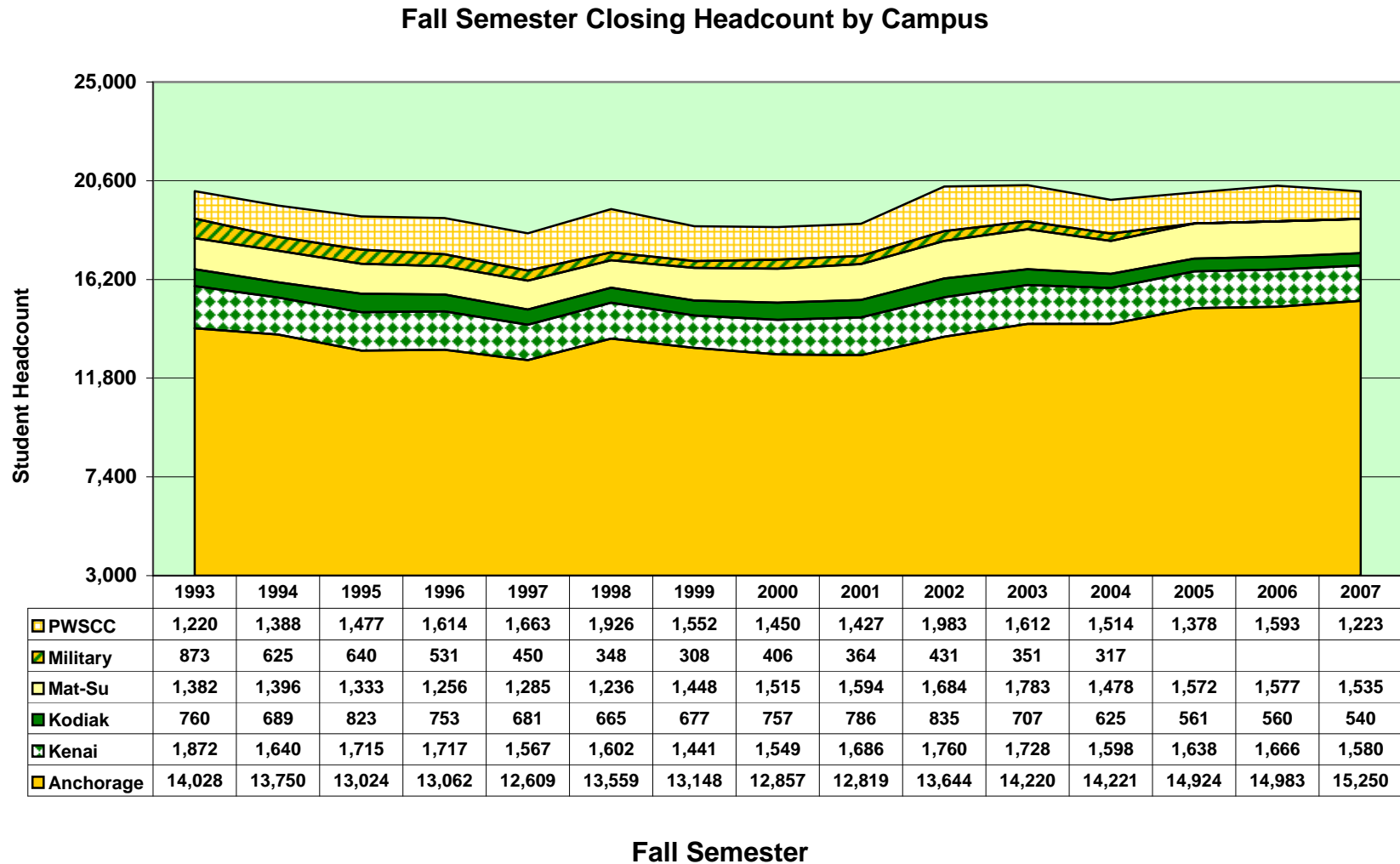

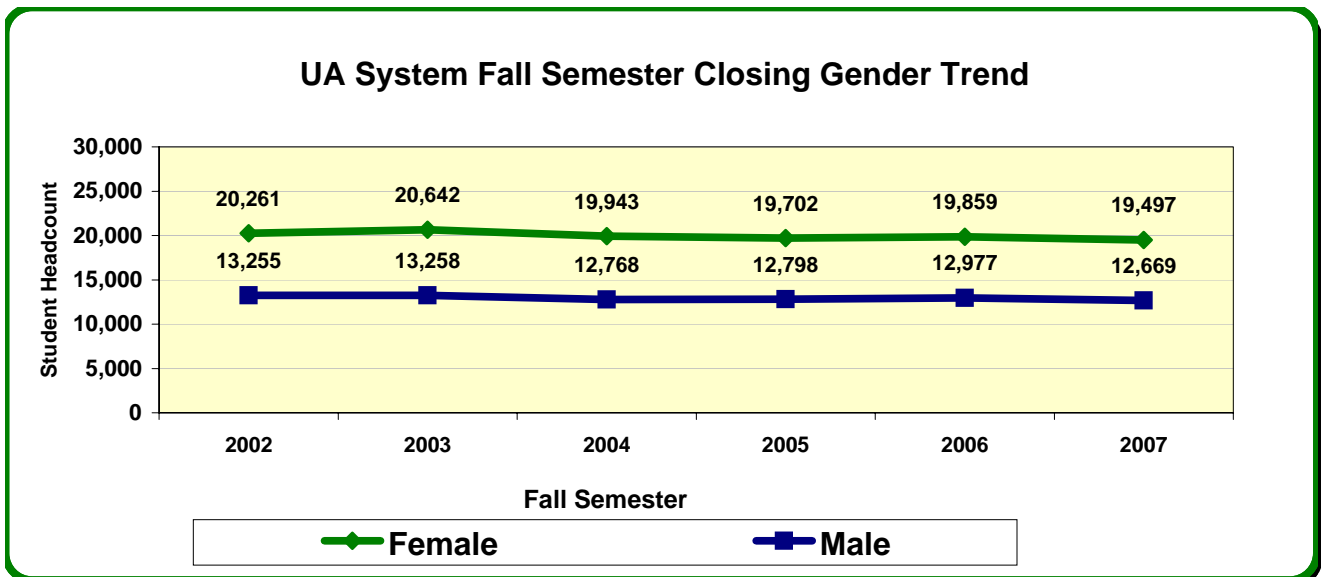

**University of Alaska Anchorage**



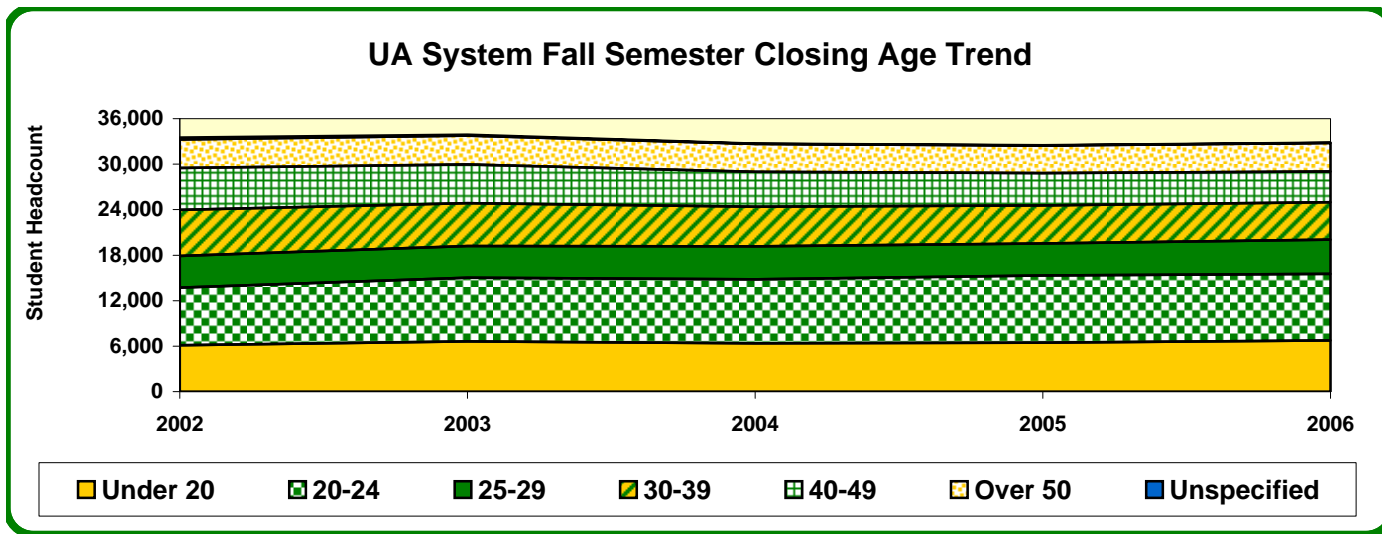
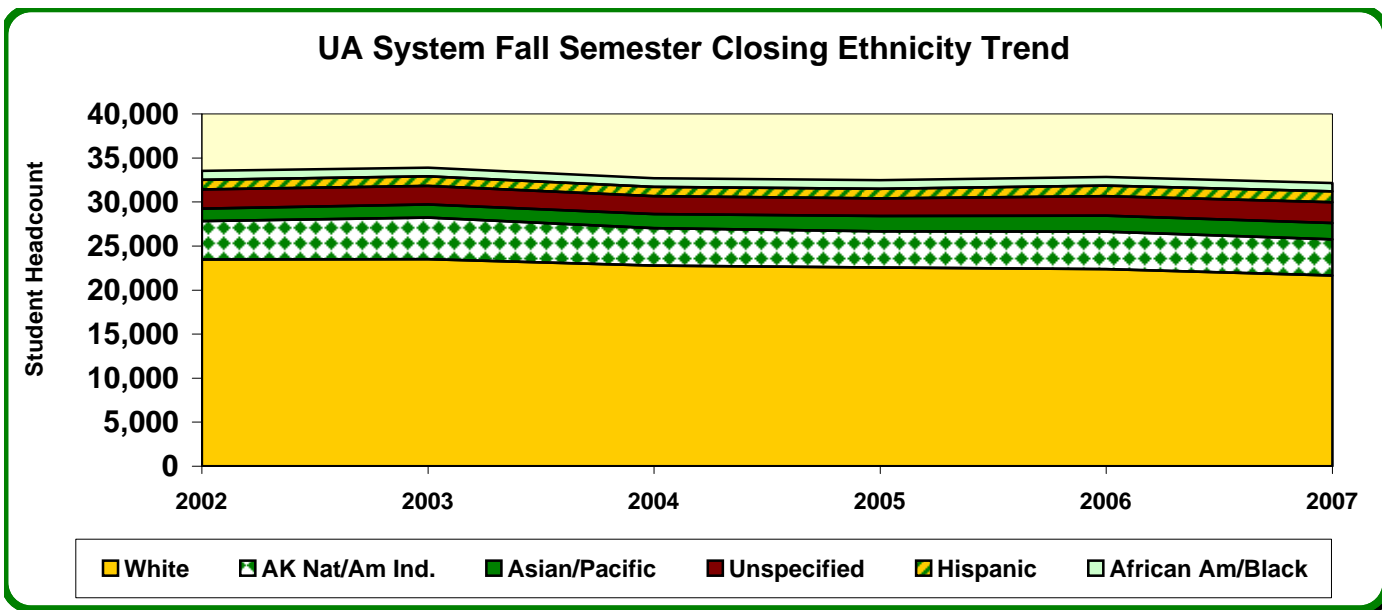
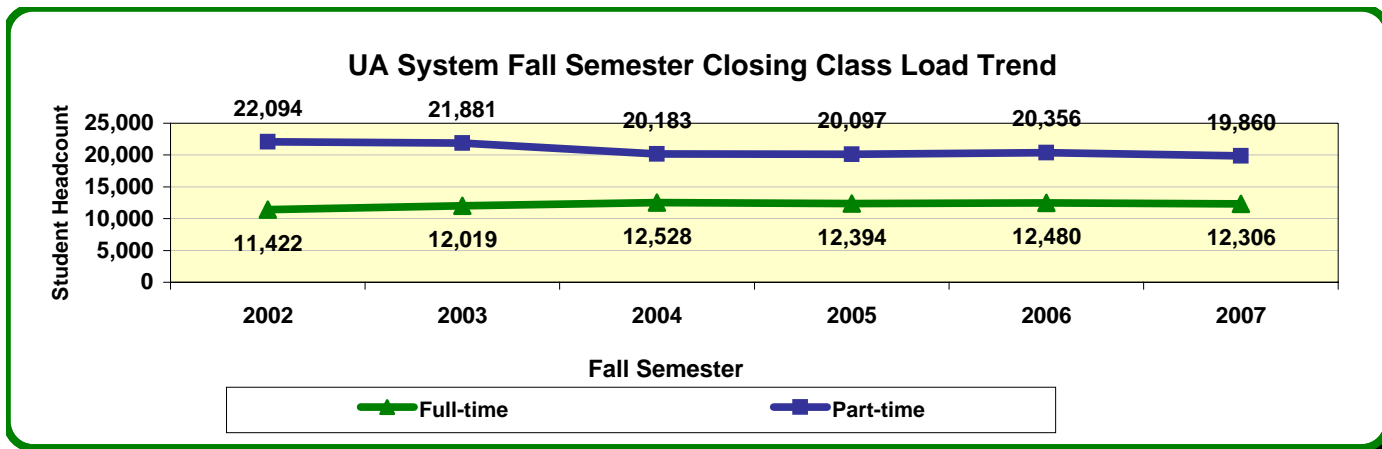

**Fall Semester Closing**



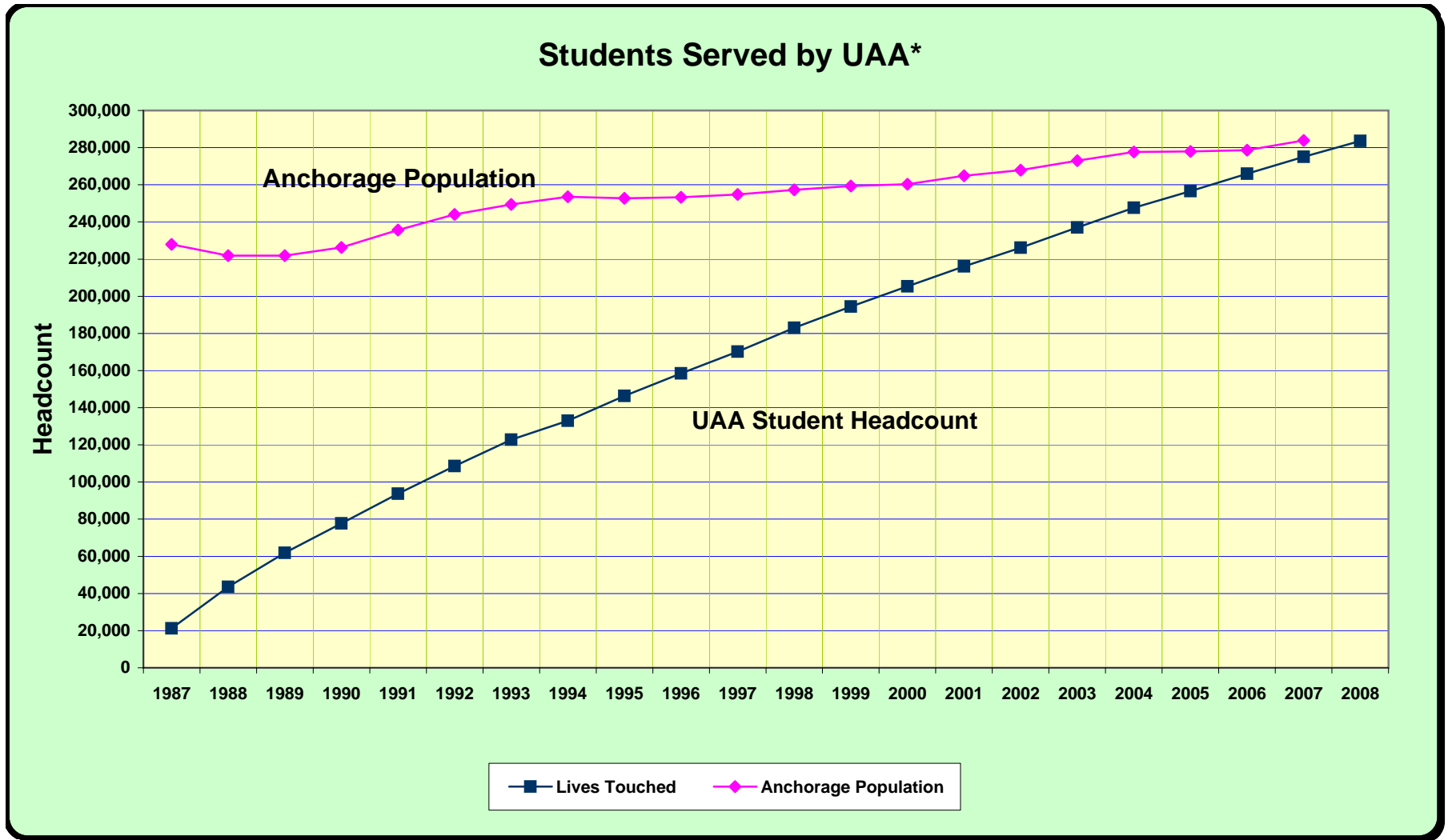

**All Campuses Fall Semester Student Credit Headcount by Age Group**

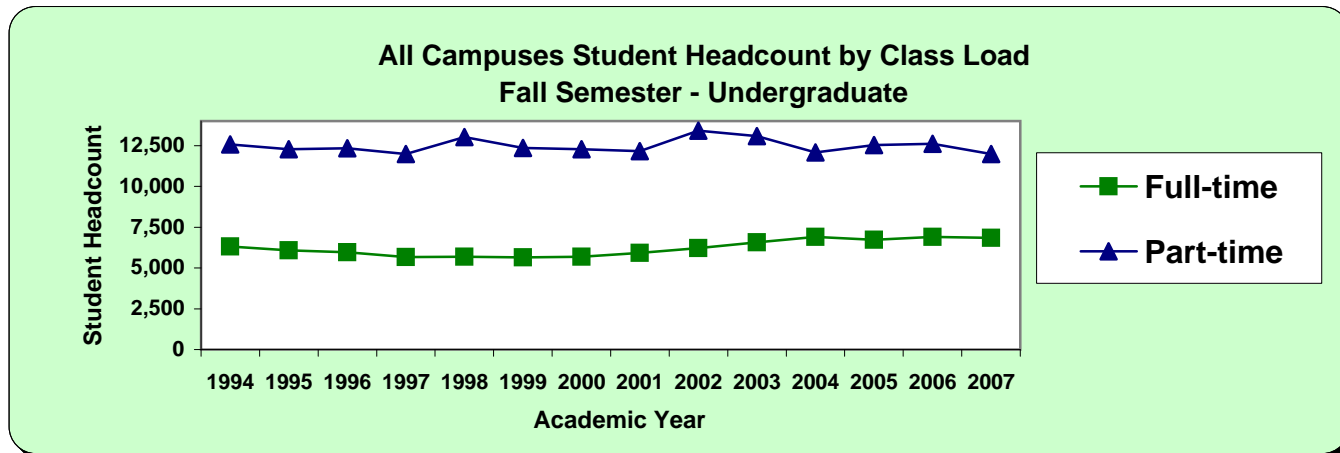

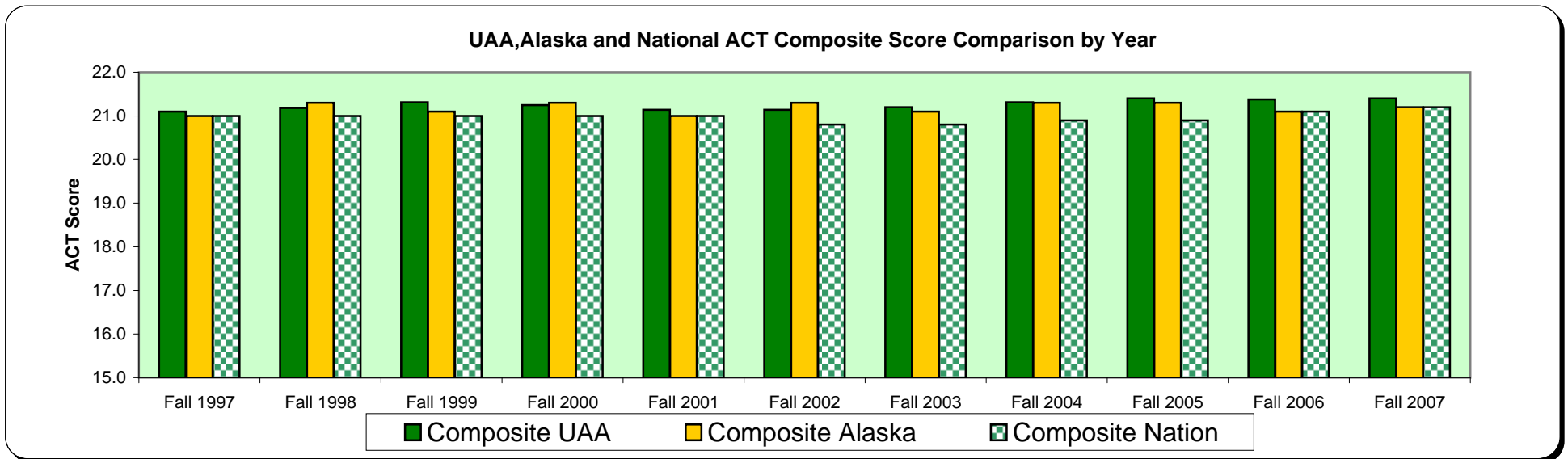
