(All Campuses)

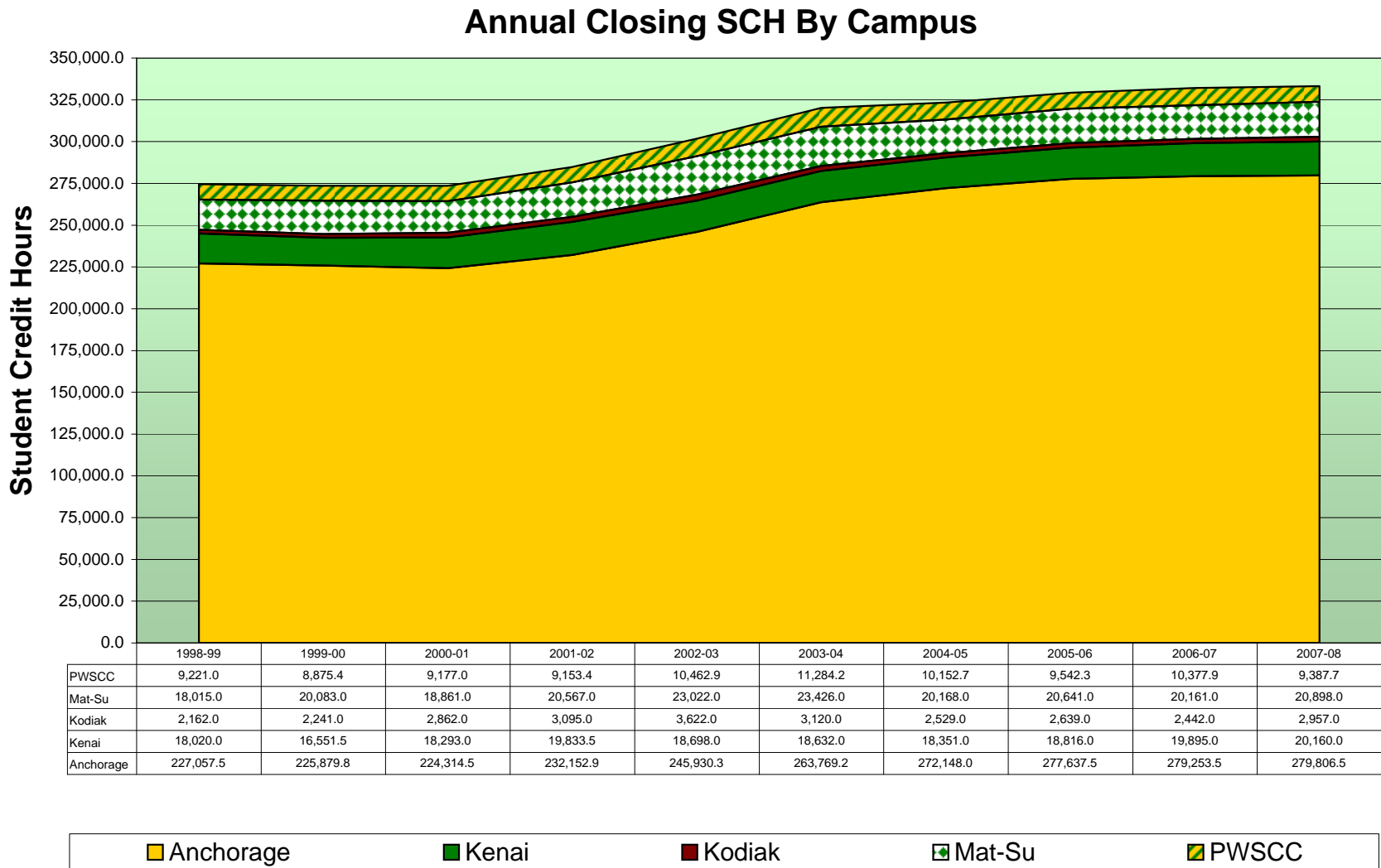

University of Alaska Anchorage-All Campuses

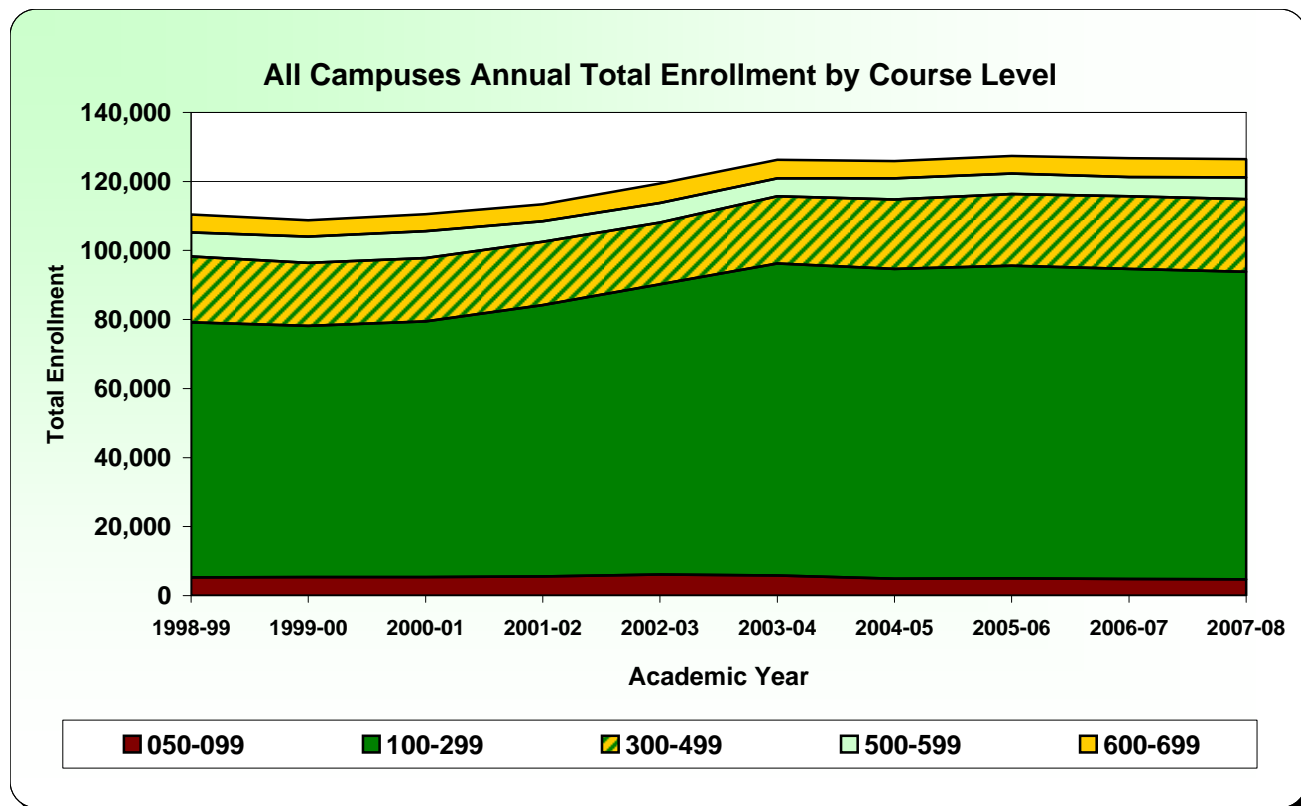
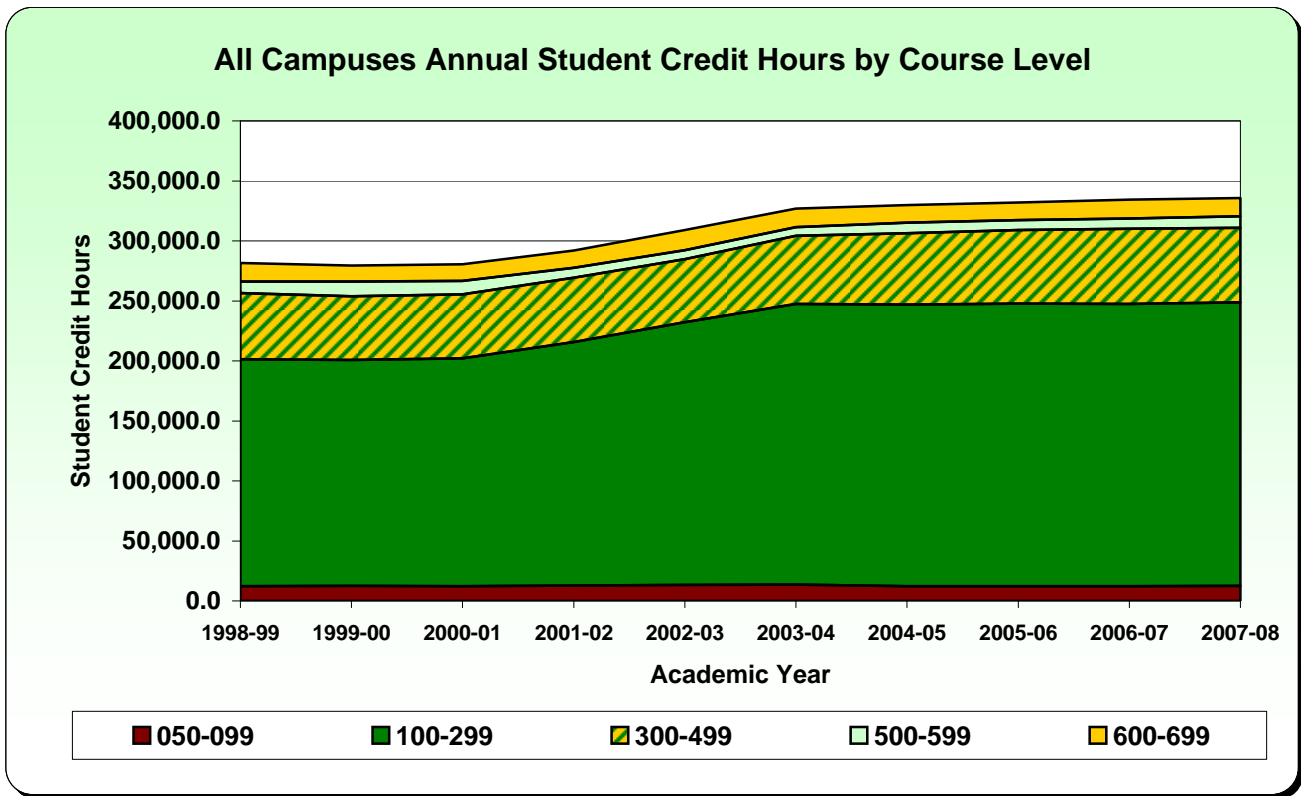

(All Campuses)

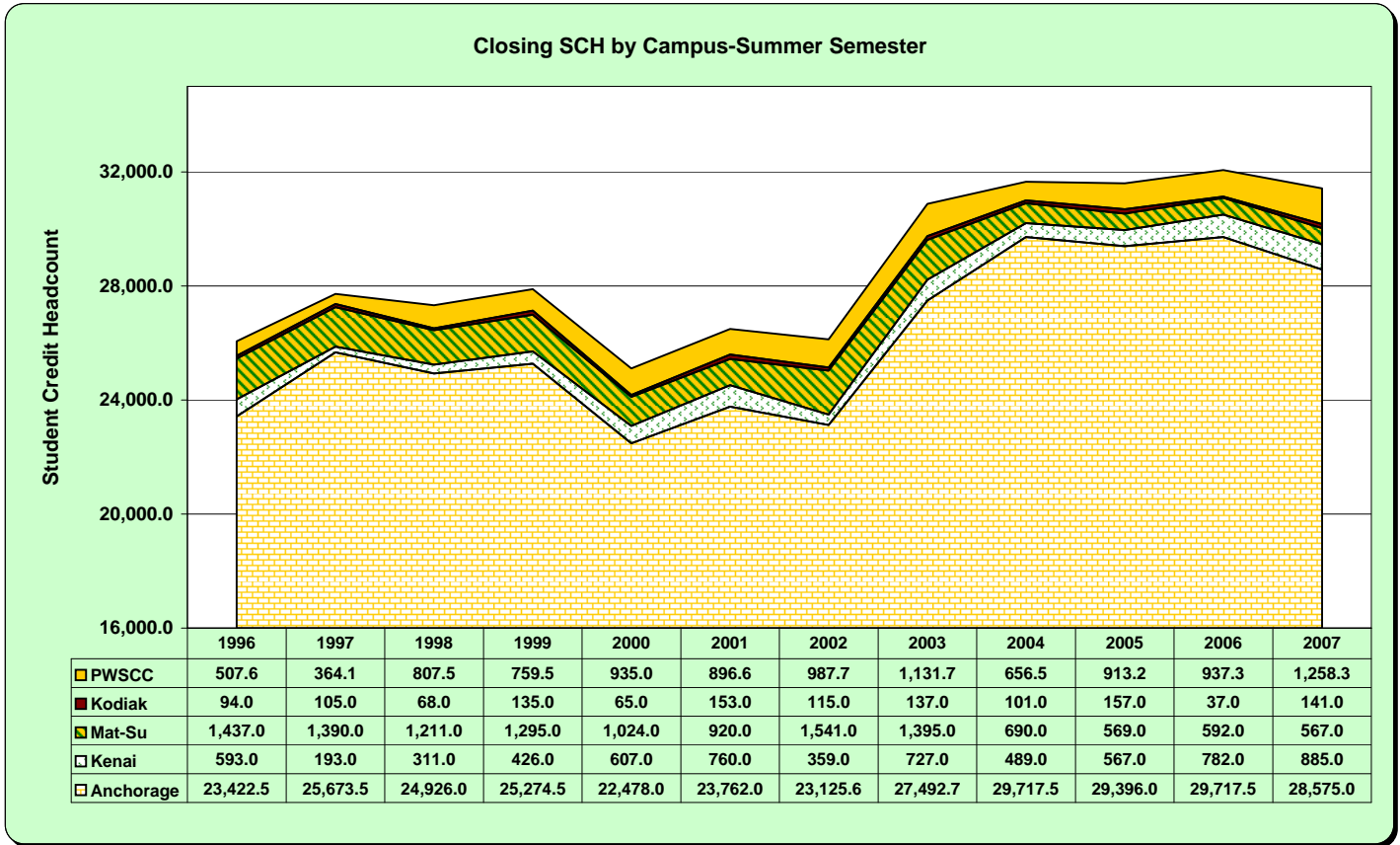


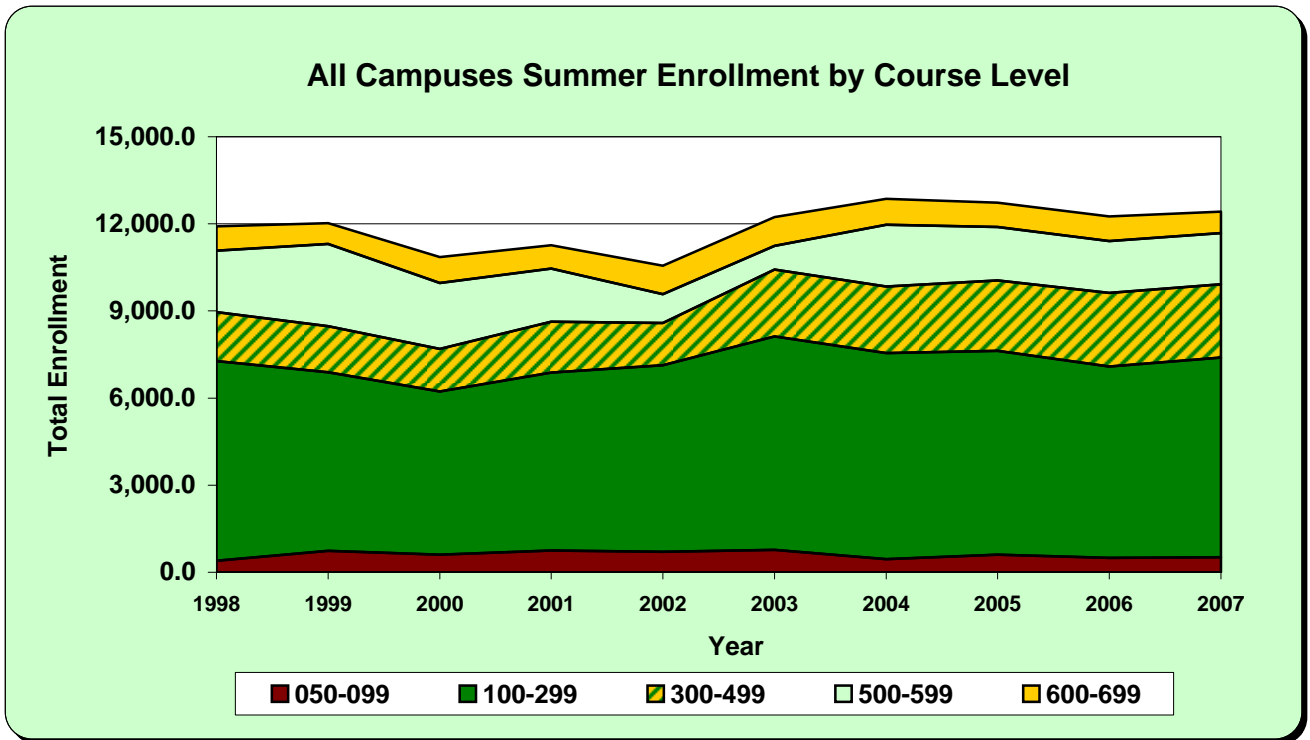
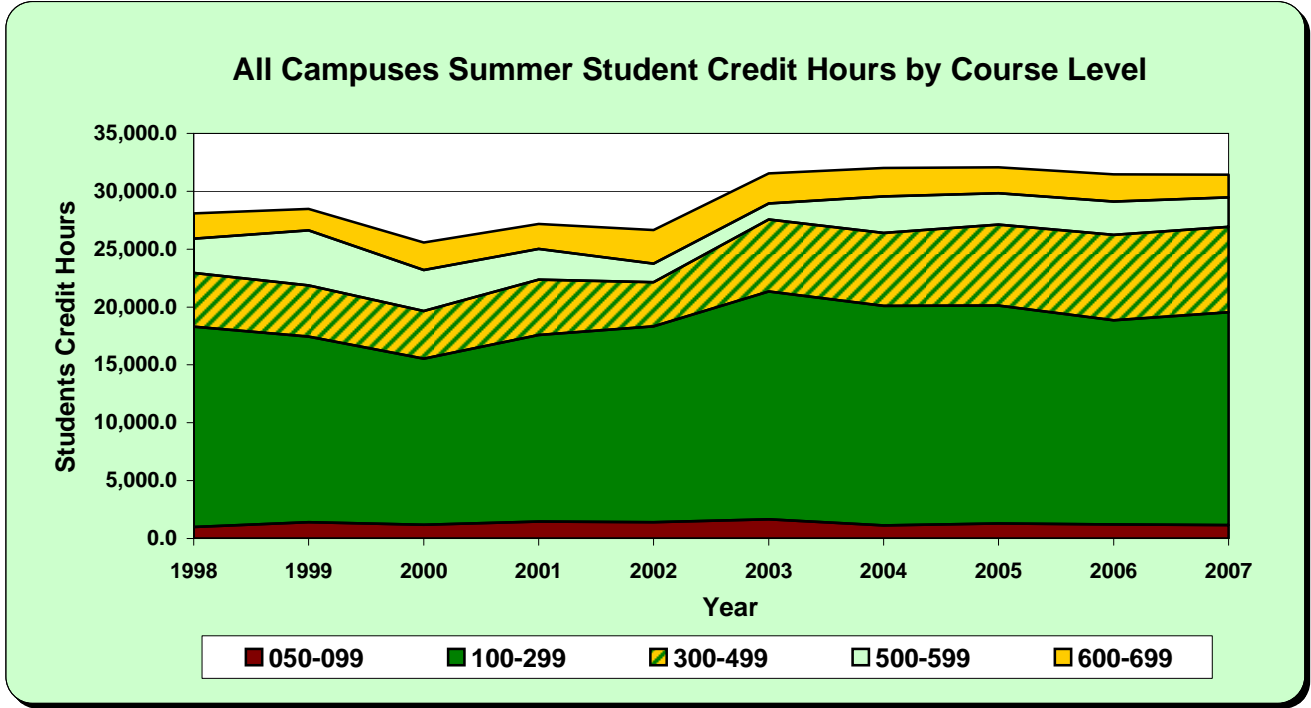

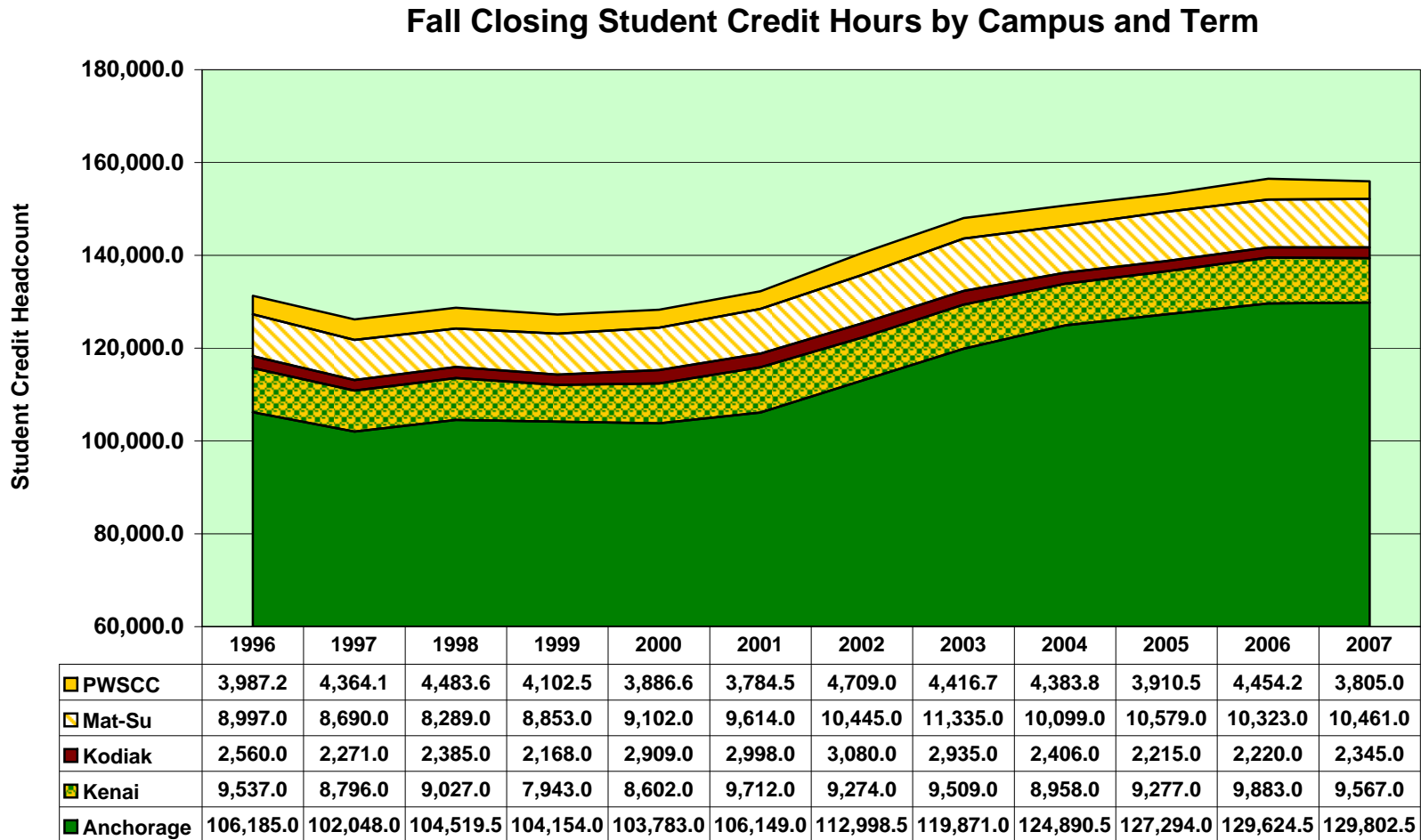

University of Alaska Anchorage-All Campuses

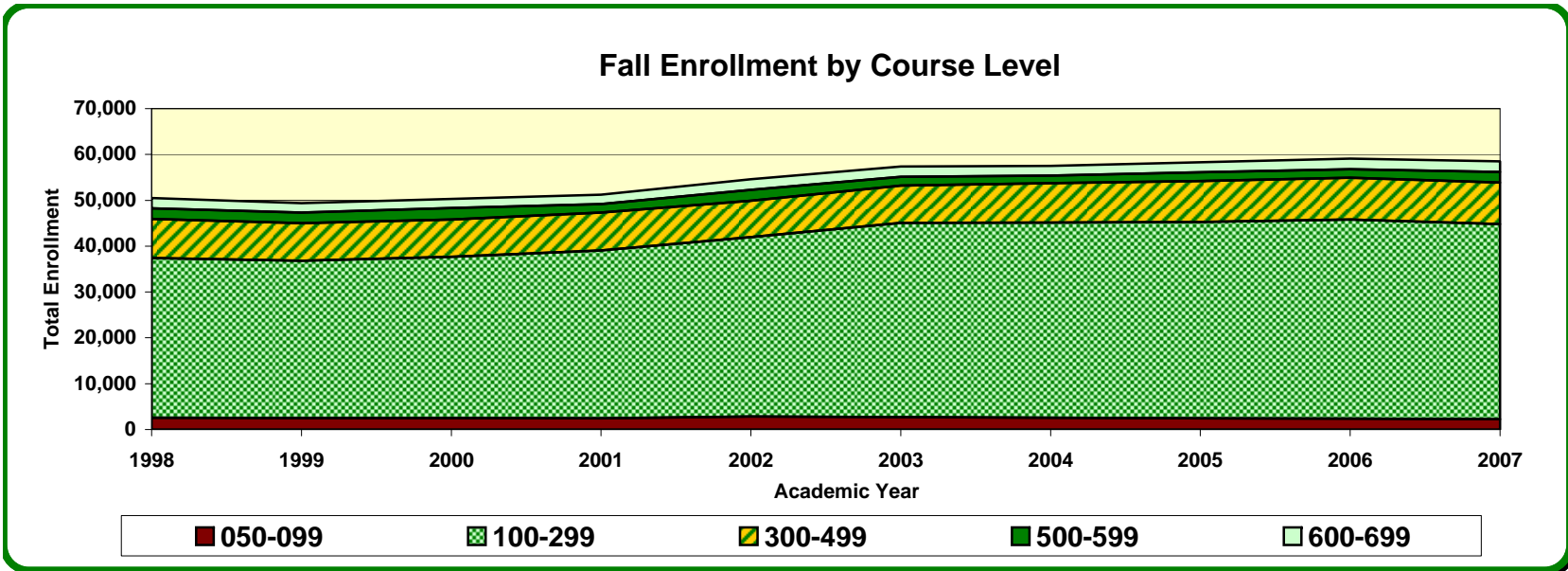
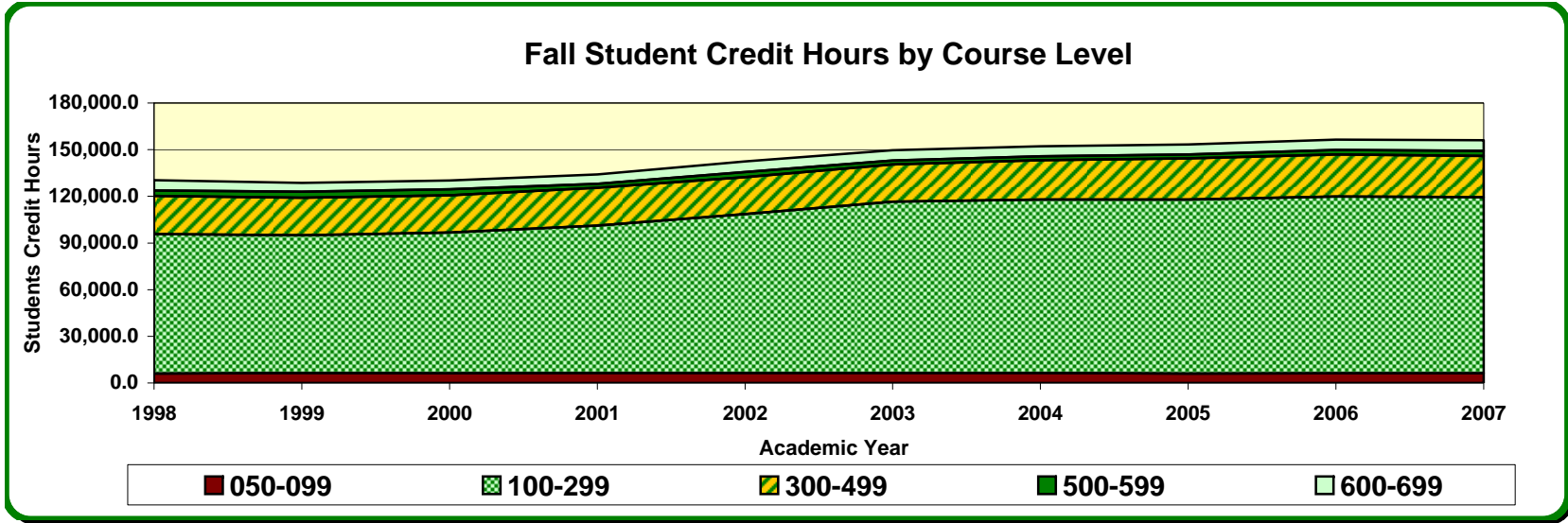

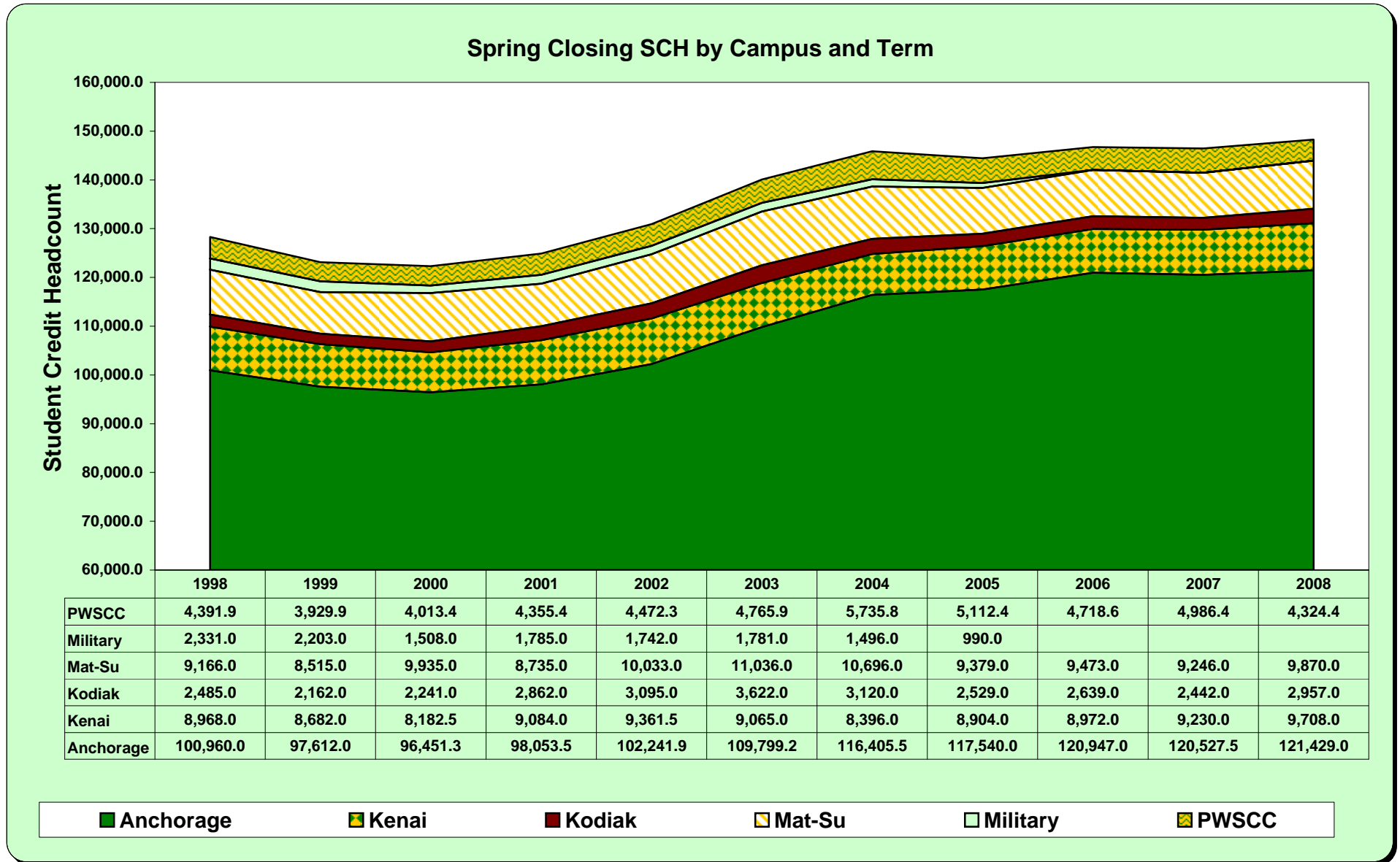

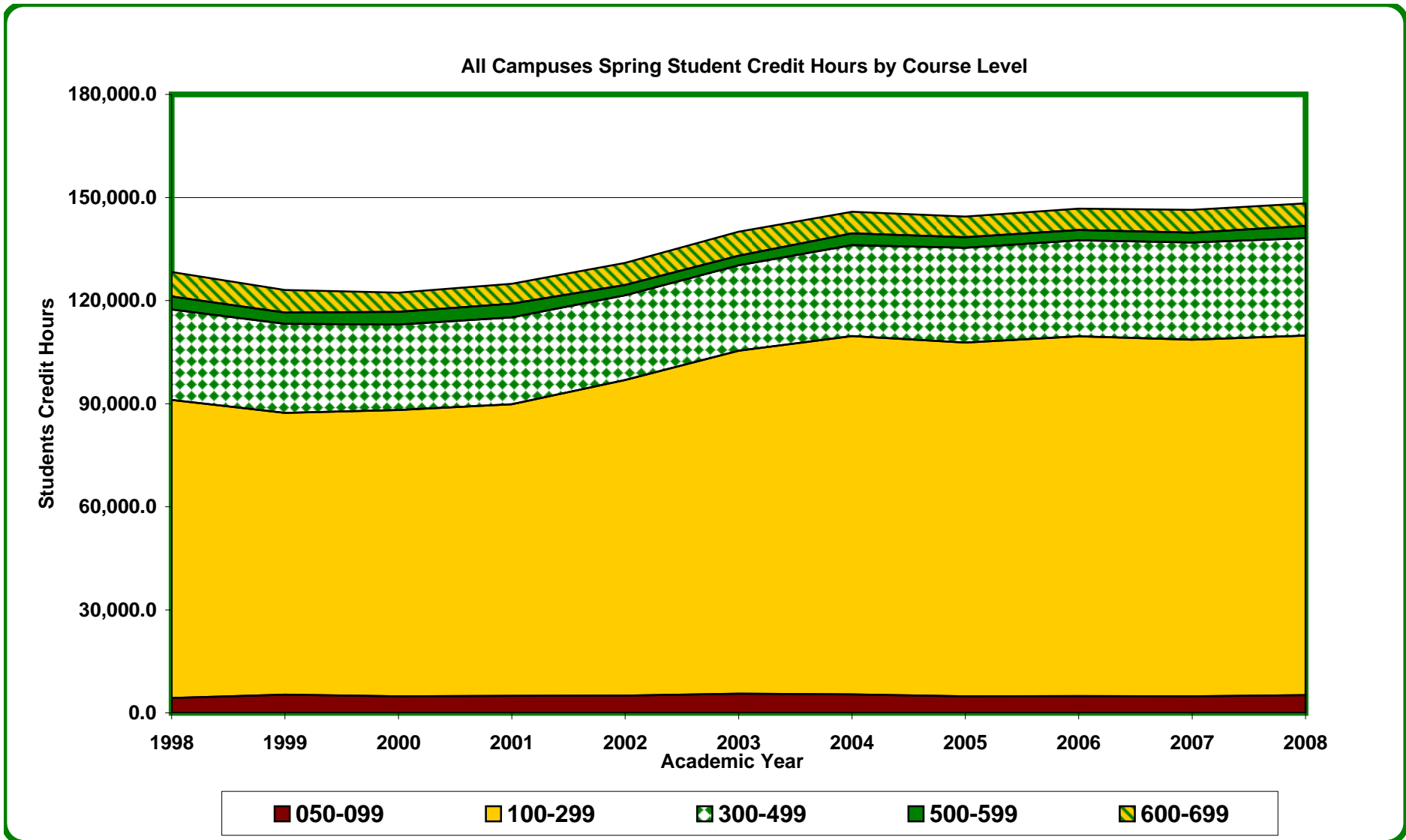

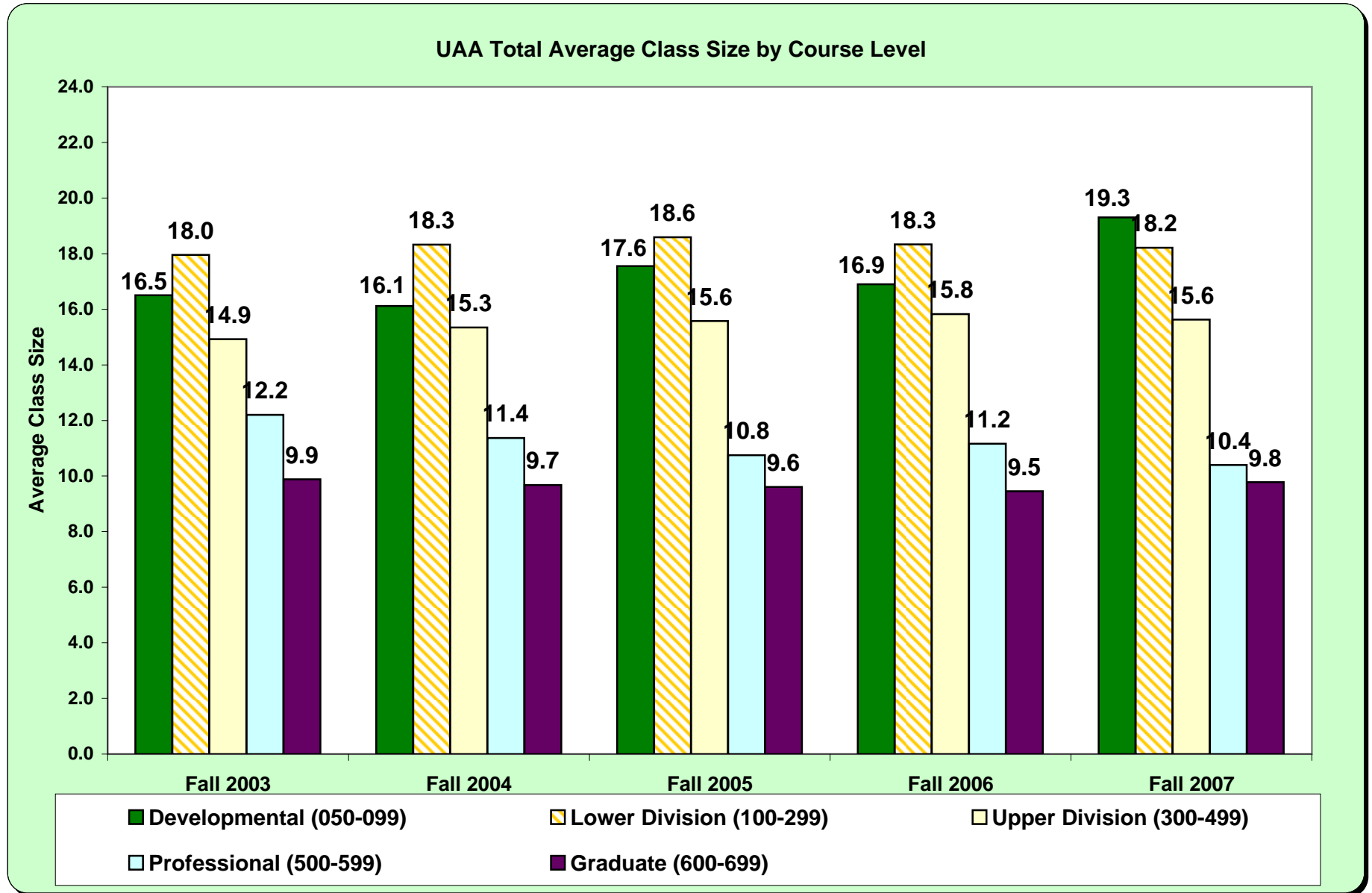

All Campuses Fall 2007 % of Total Sections by Instruction Type

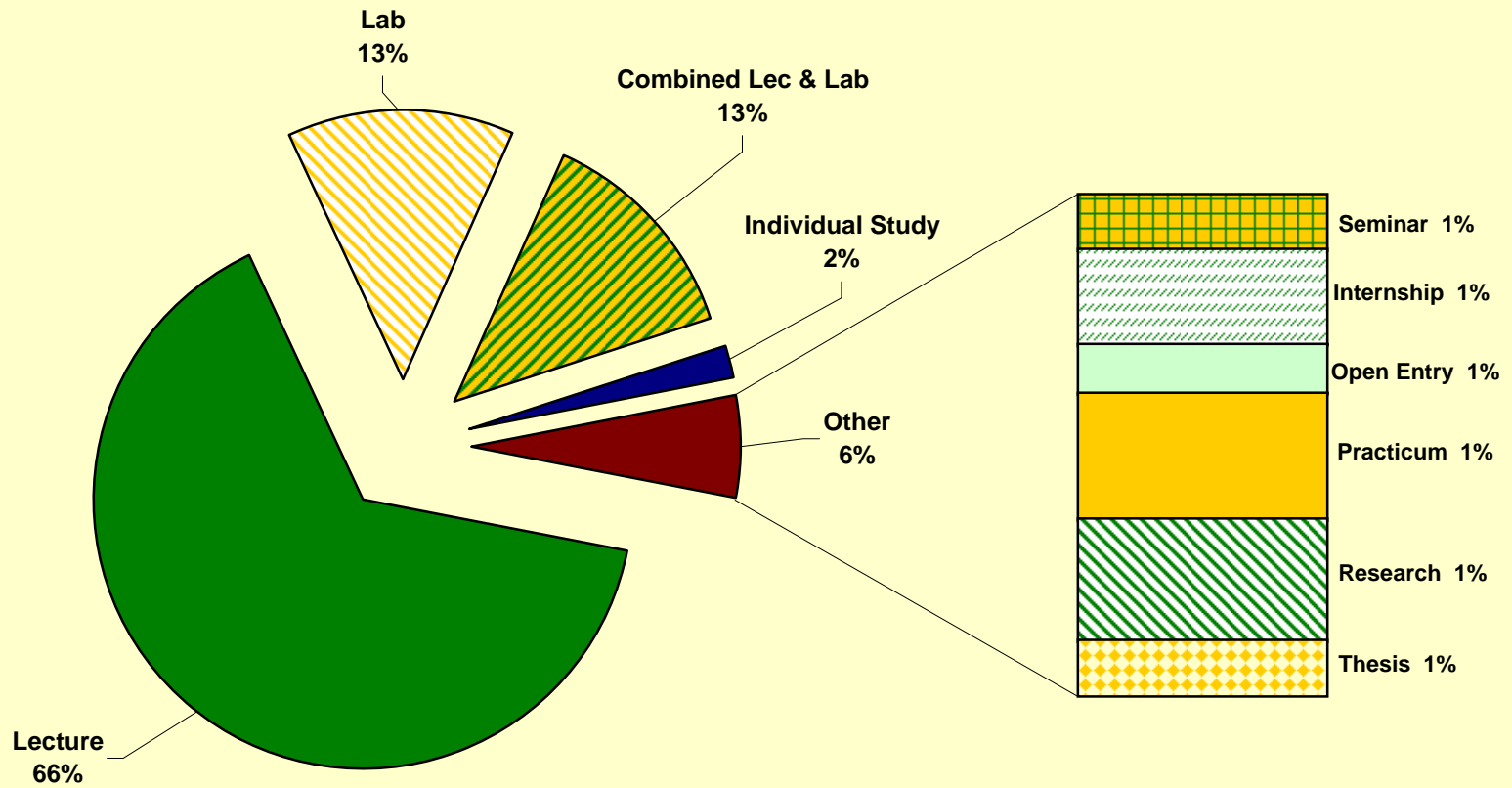

University of Alaska Anchorage

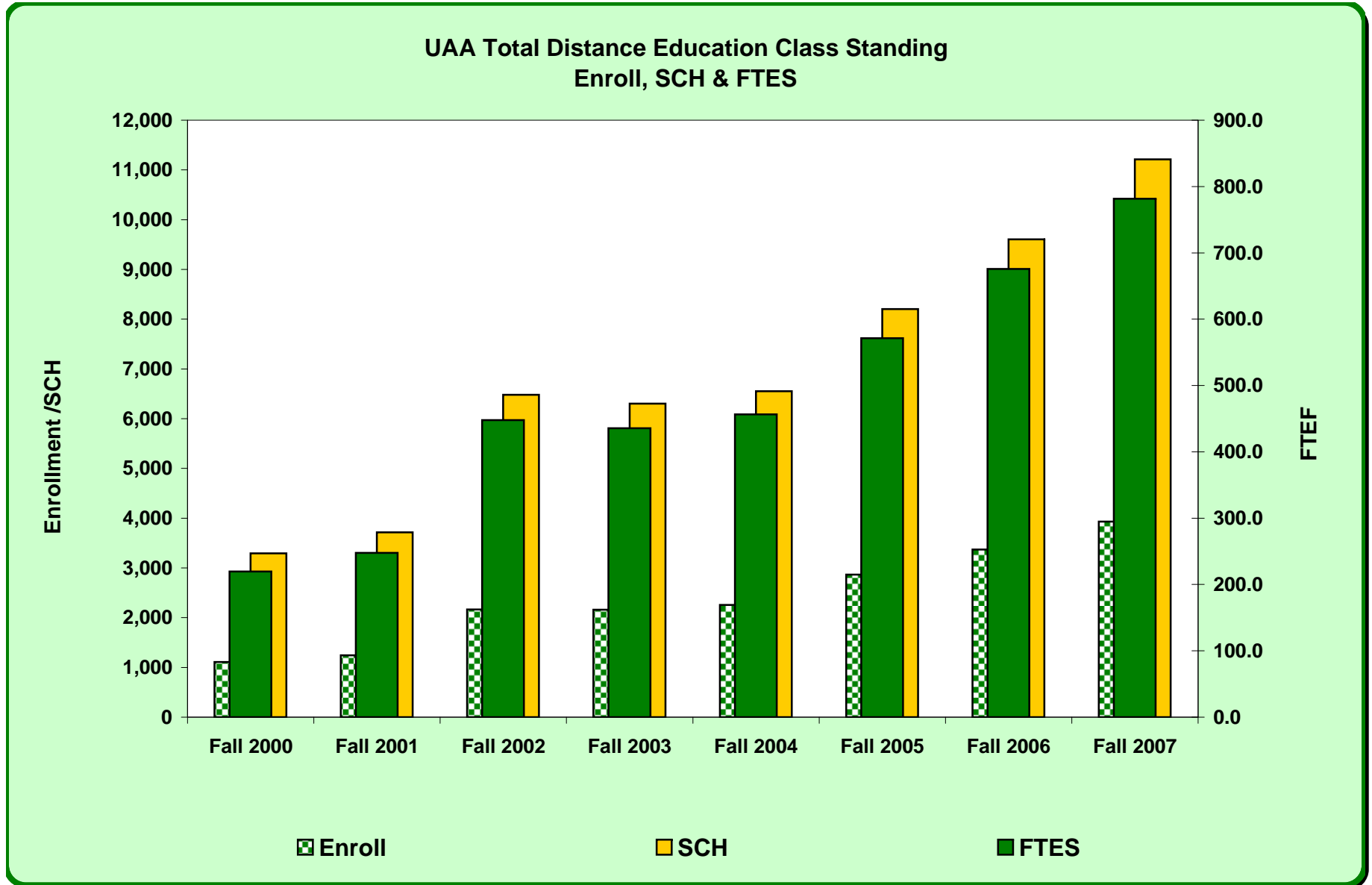

UAA Total Awards Granted by Type

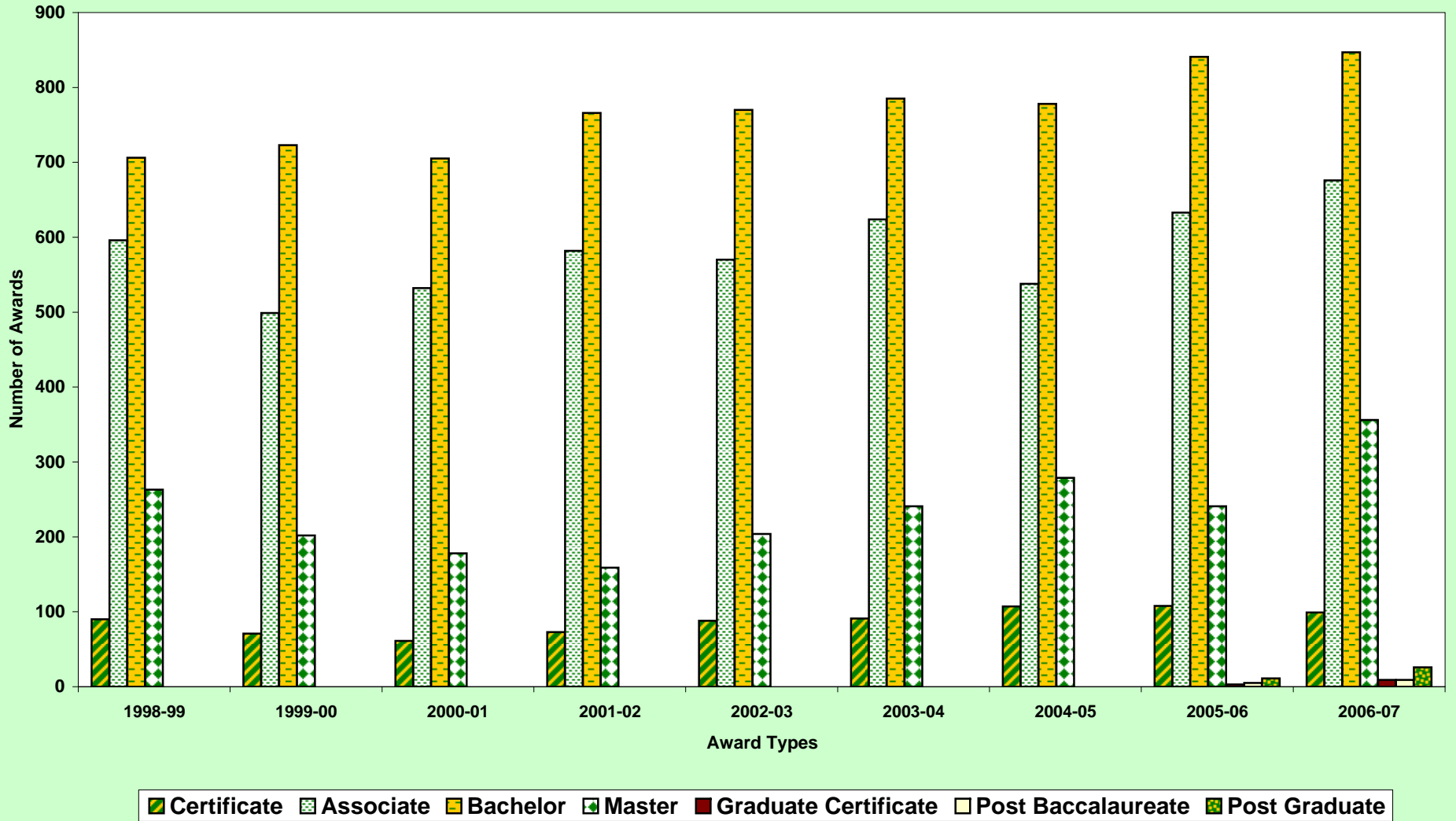
