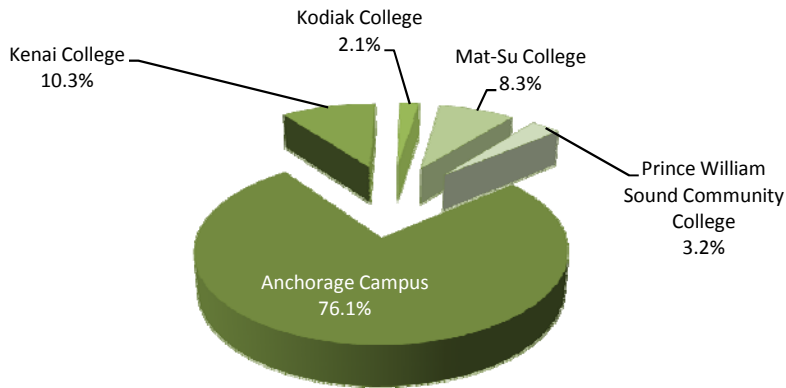

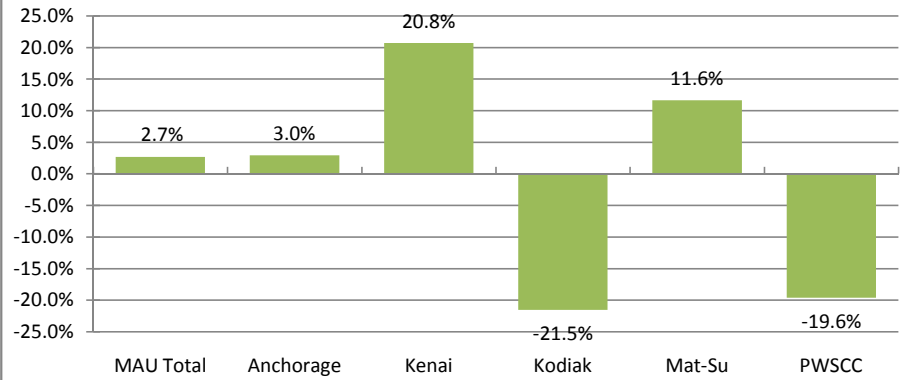
Credit Headcount by Campus

Fall 2009 Opening



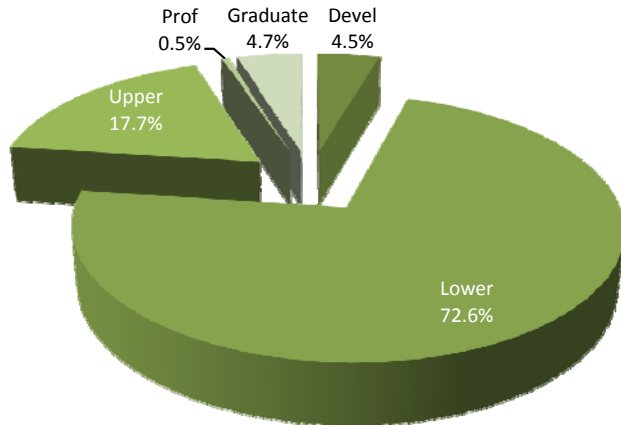
% Change in Credit Headcount

Opening Fall 2008 to Fall 2009



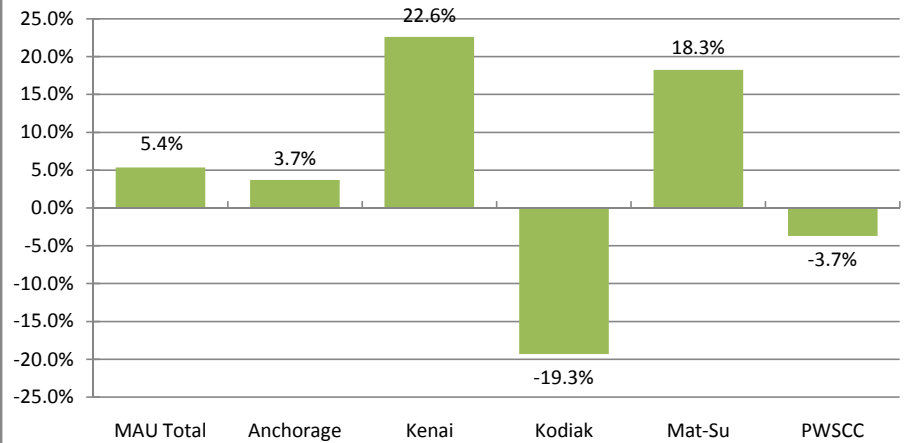
UAA Student Credit Hours by Course Level

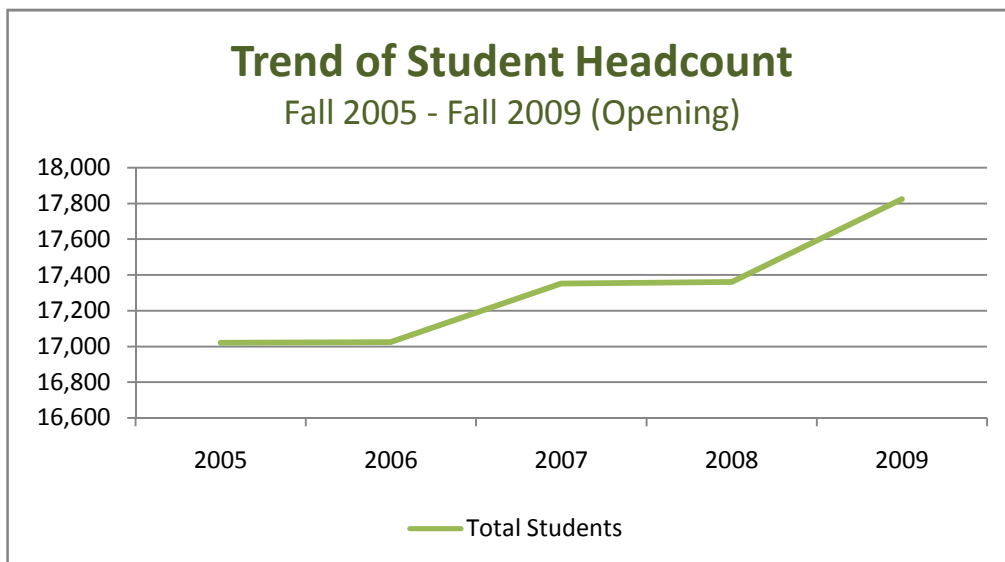

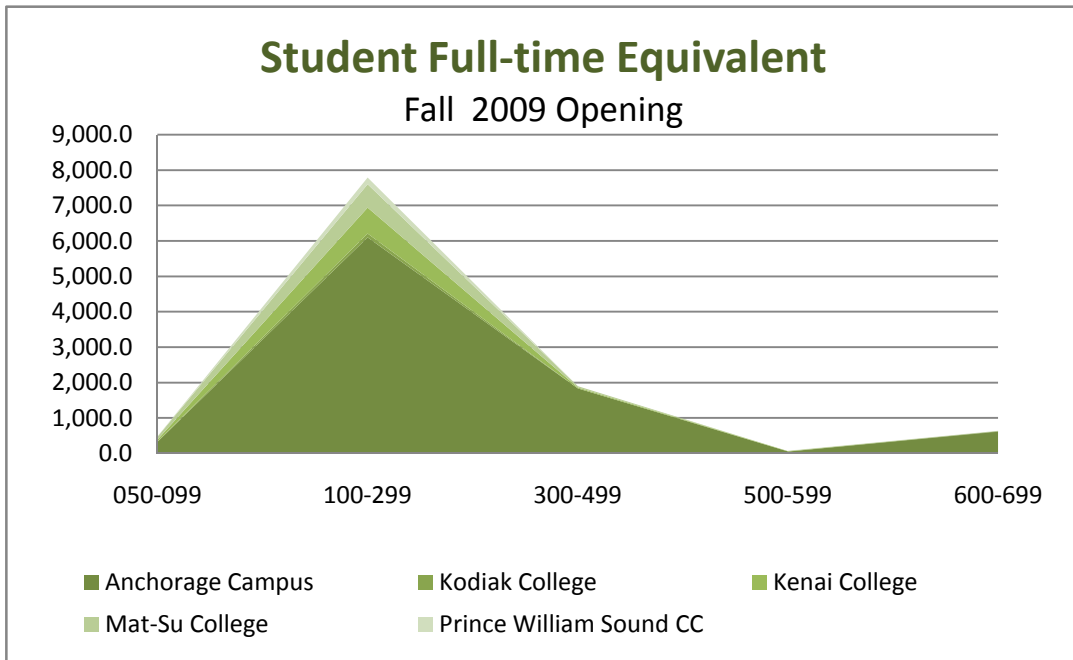
