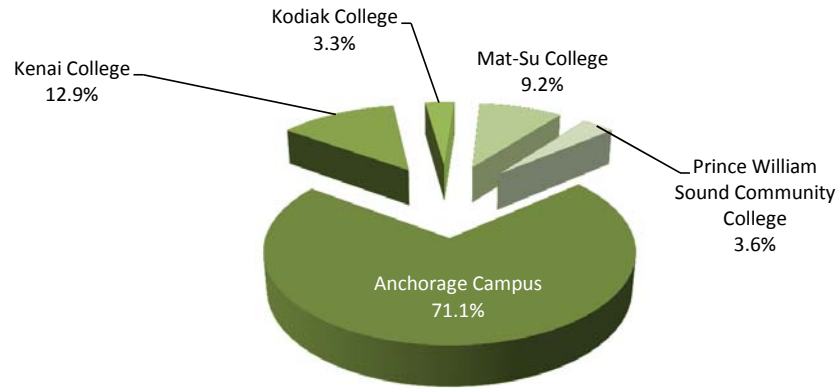

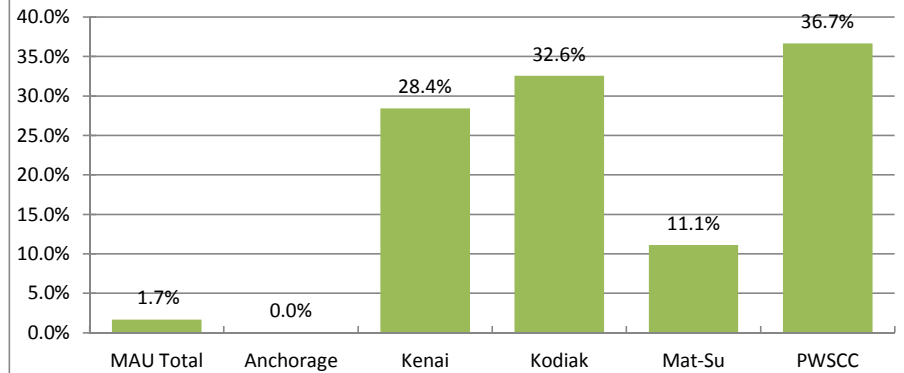
### Credit Headcount by Campus

Fall 2011 Opening



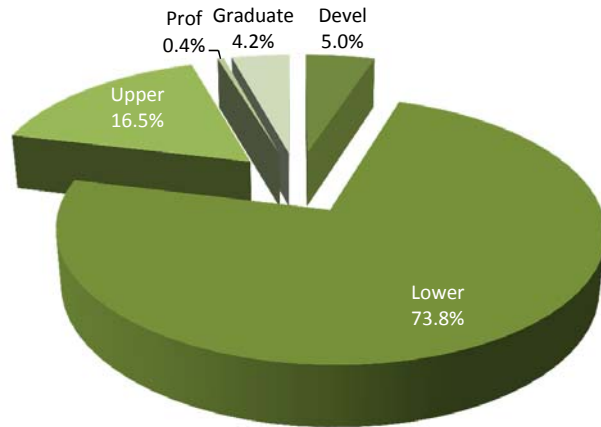
### % Change in Credit Headcount

Opening Fall 2010 to Fall 2011



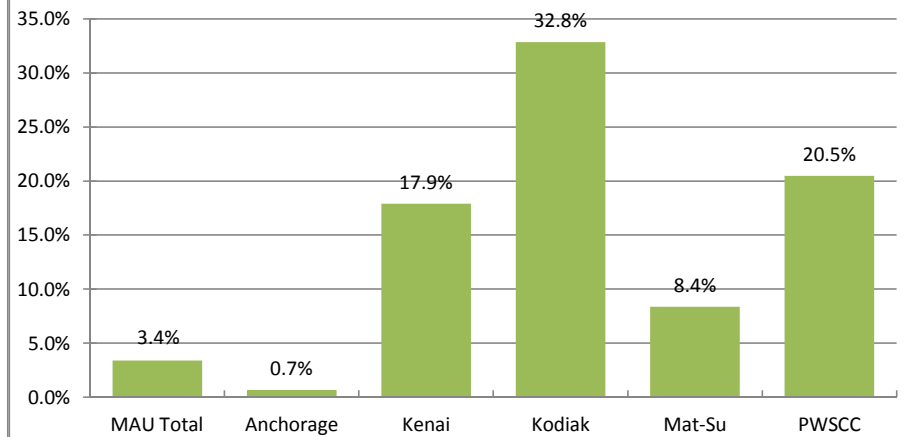
### UAA Student Credit Hours by Course Level

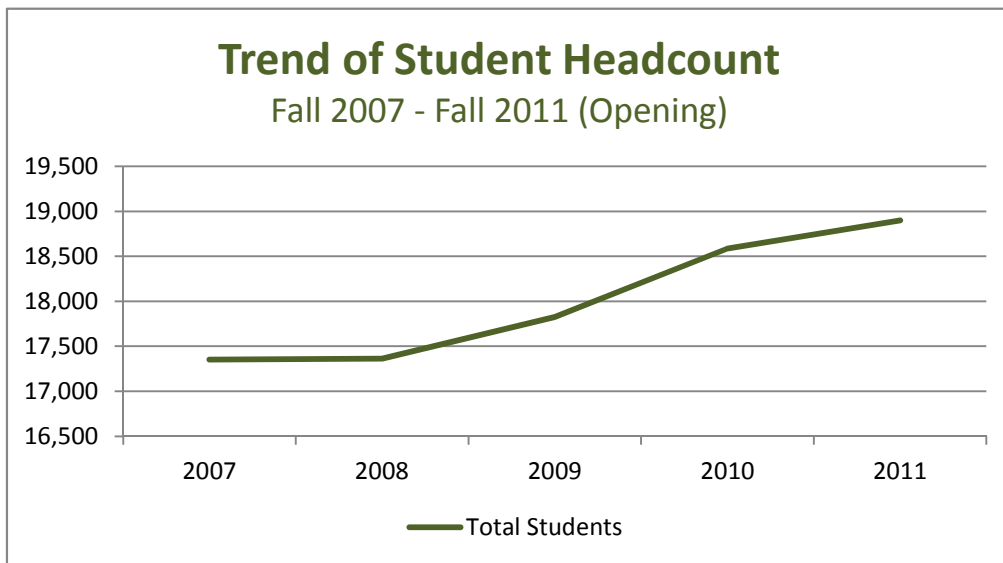

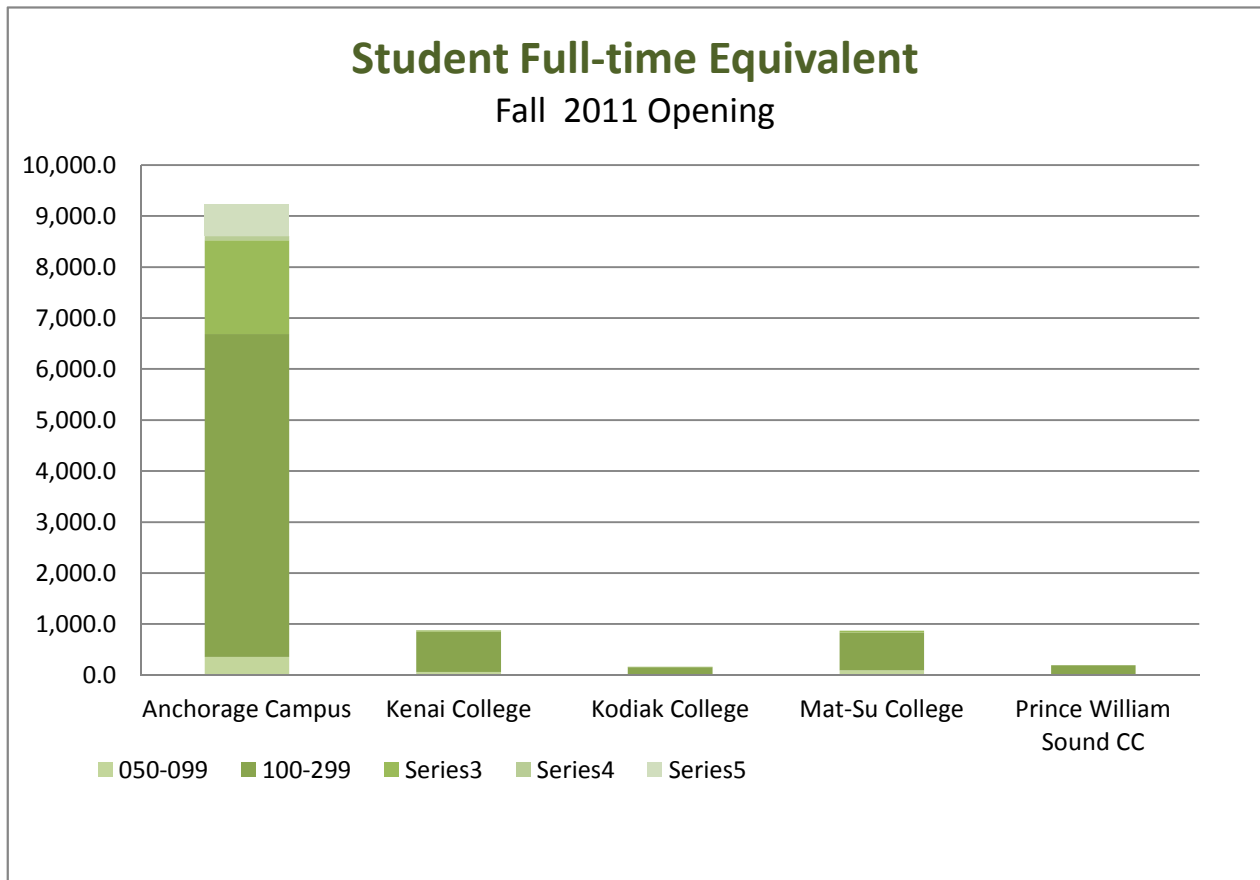
