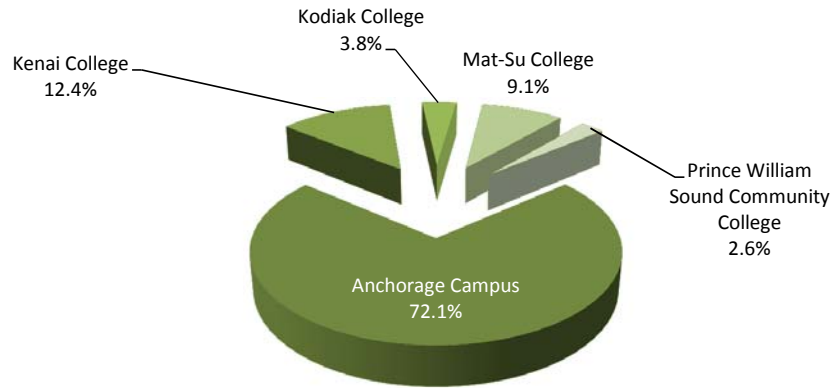

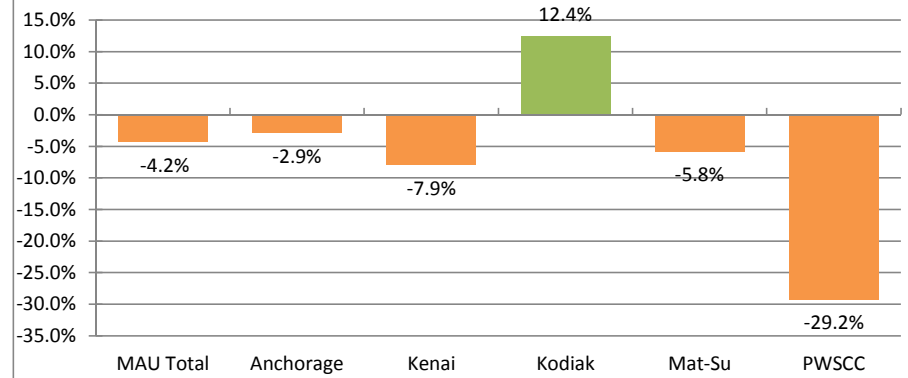
### Credit Headcount by Campus

Fall 2012 Opening



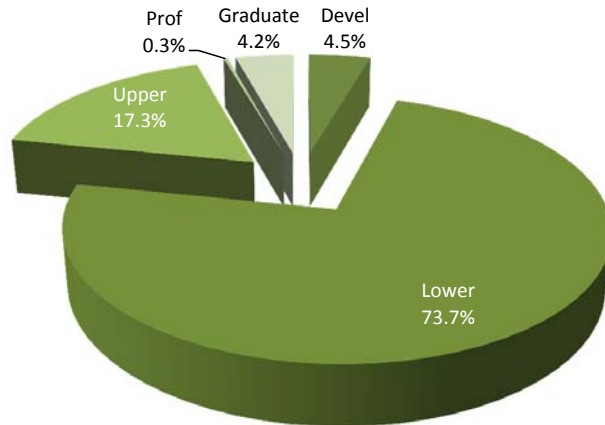
### % Change in Credit Headcount

Opening Fall 2011 to Fall 2012



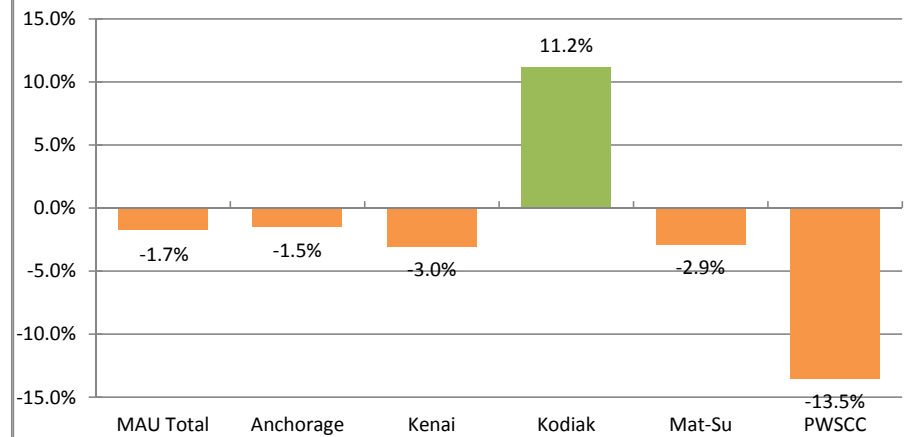
### UAA Student Credit Hours by Course Level

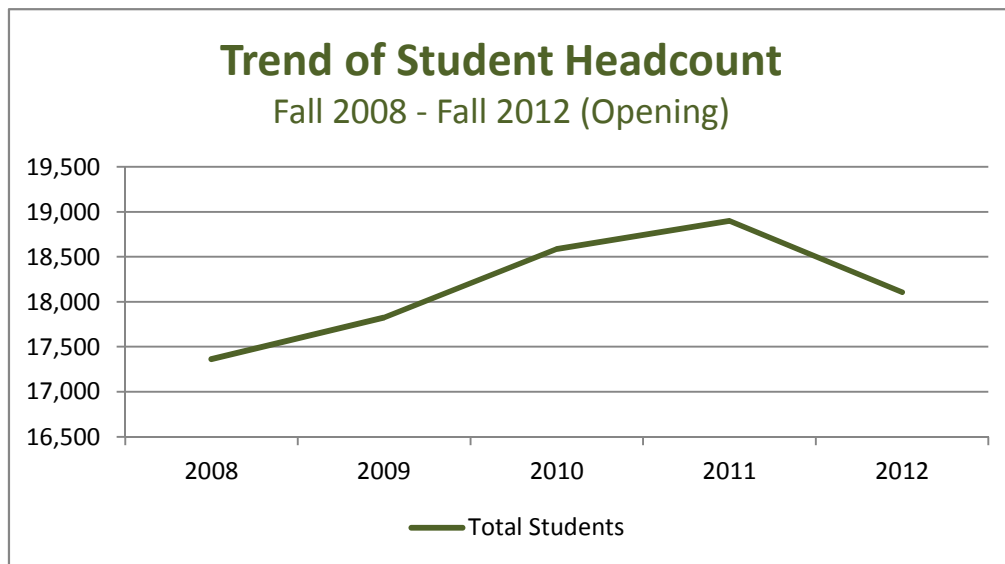

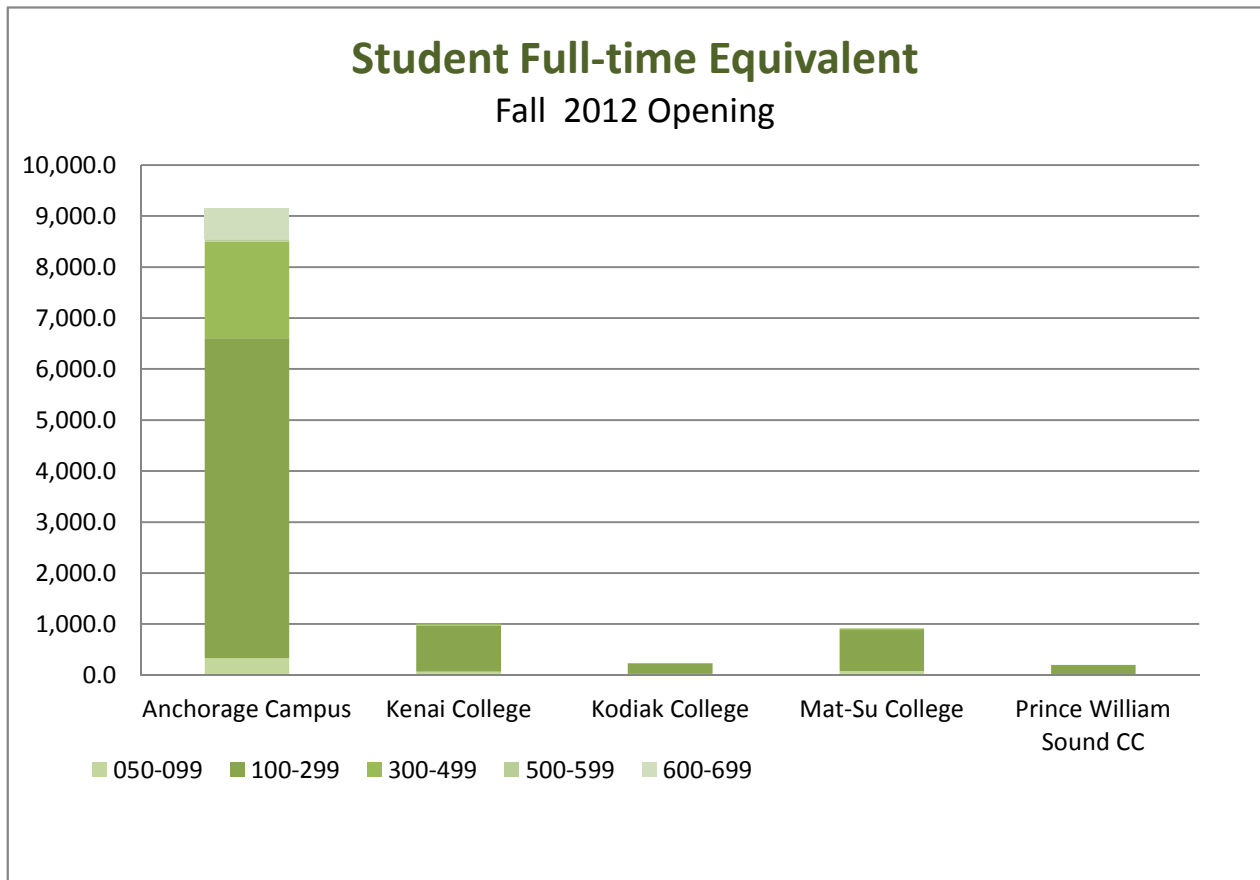
