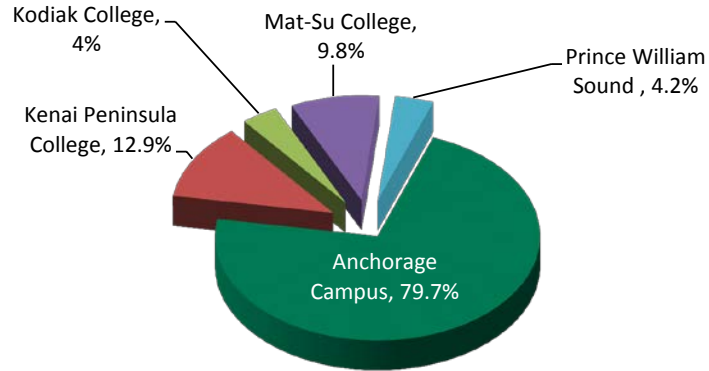

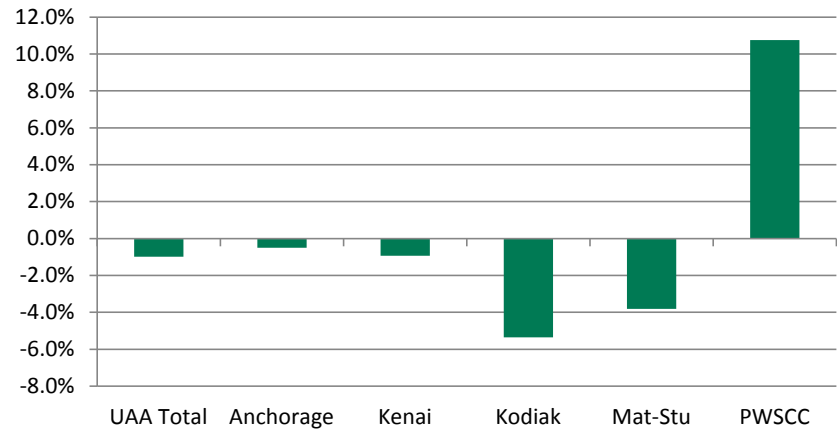

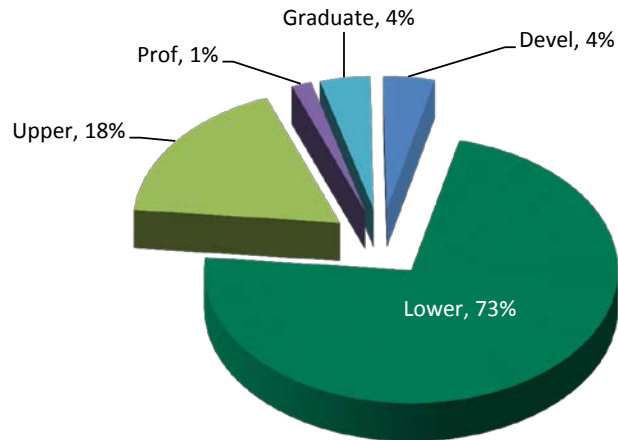
**% of Total Credit Headcount by Campus
Fall 2013 Closing**



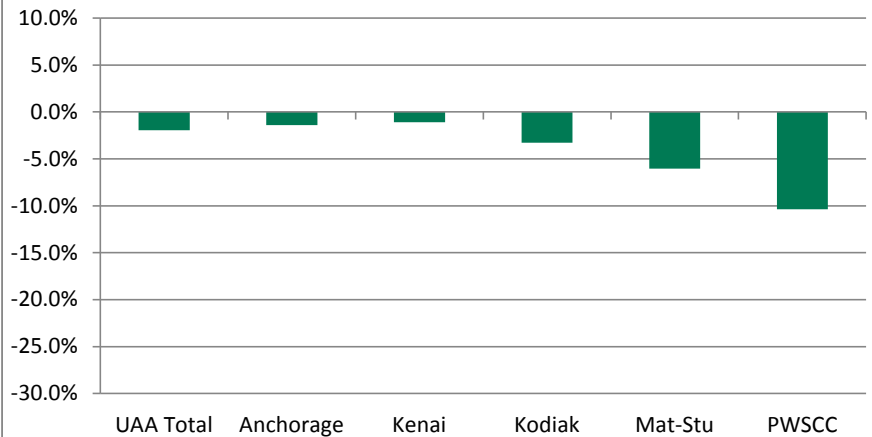
**% Change in Credit Headcount
