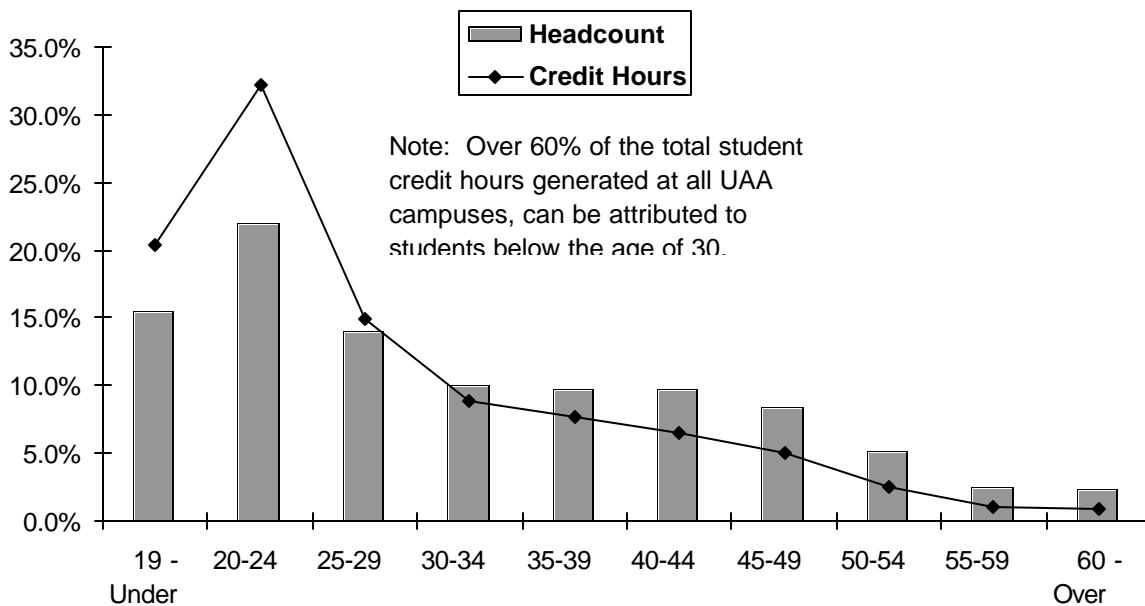

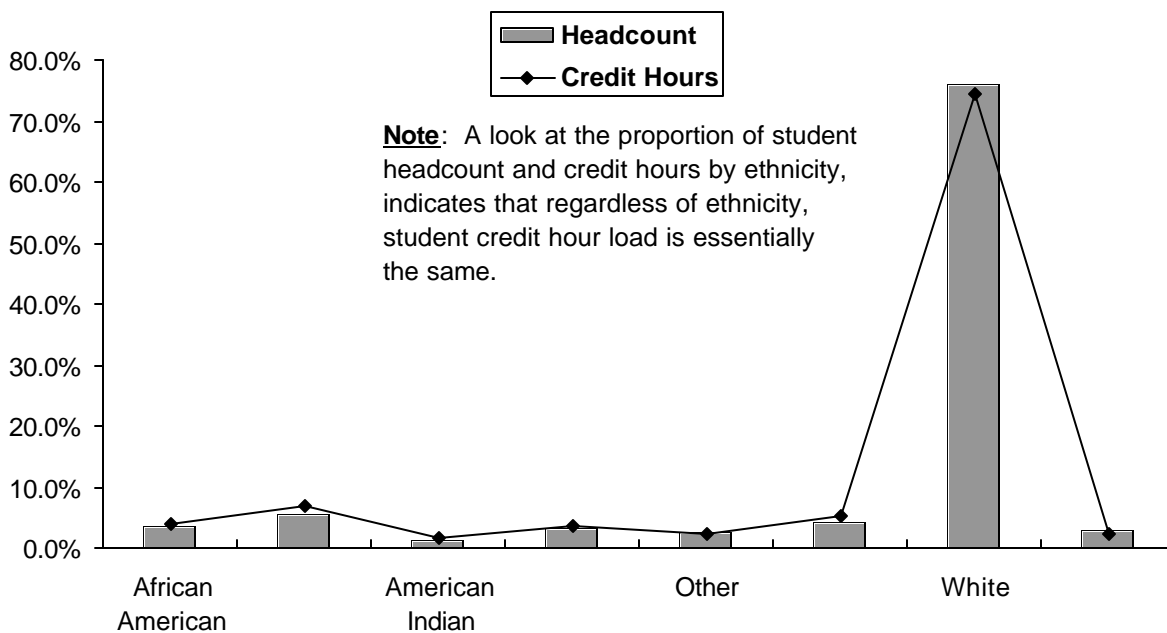

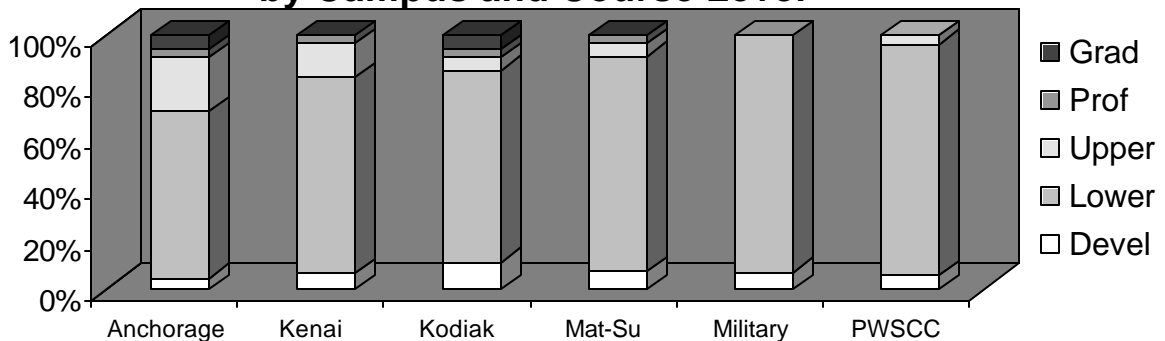

UAA STUDENT HEADCOUNT AND CREDIT HOUR TREND

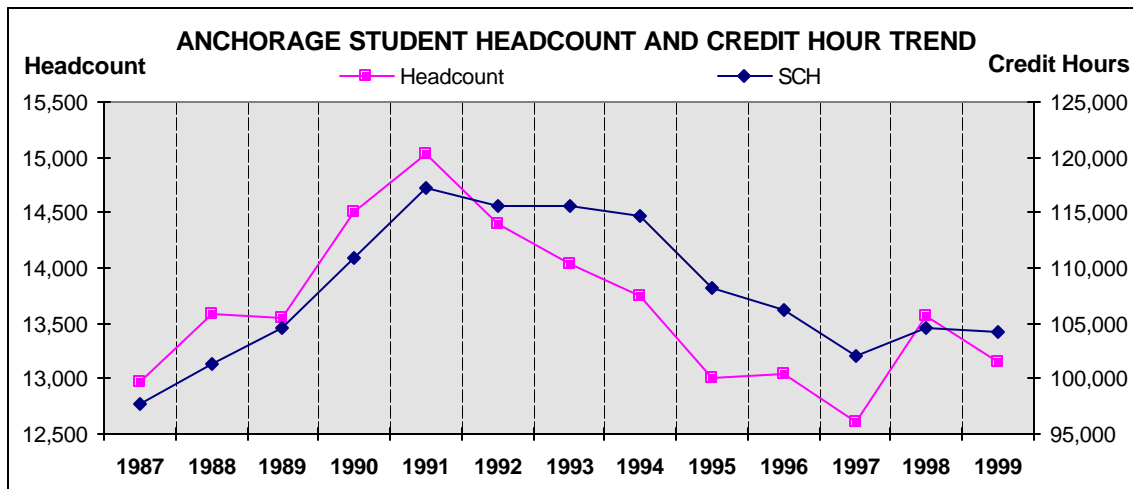
