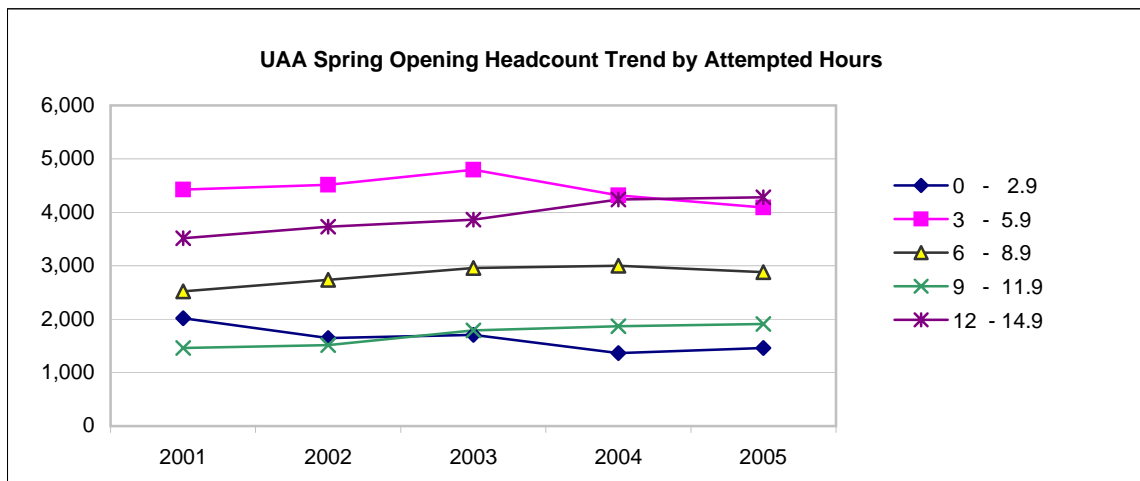

Student admitted with an admit code of "FT" (first-time admitted), and having a student type of "F" (first-time enrolling), or a student type of "C" (continuing enrollment)--for those continuing to Spring from Summer. The current semester is the first time the student has ever attended an institution of higher education. Except, the student could have been first-time in Summer semester and continued into Fall, and still be a first-time freshman. The current definition does not include students who could be first-time freshmen if they are current high school graduates, even though they may have taken courses for credit previously. A process for identifying these students has begun and future reports should include this sub-group as well.
