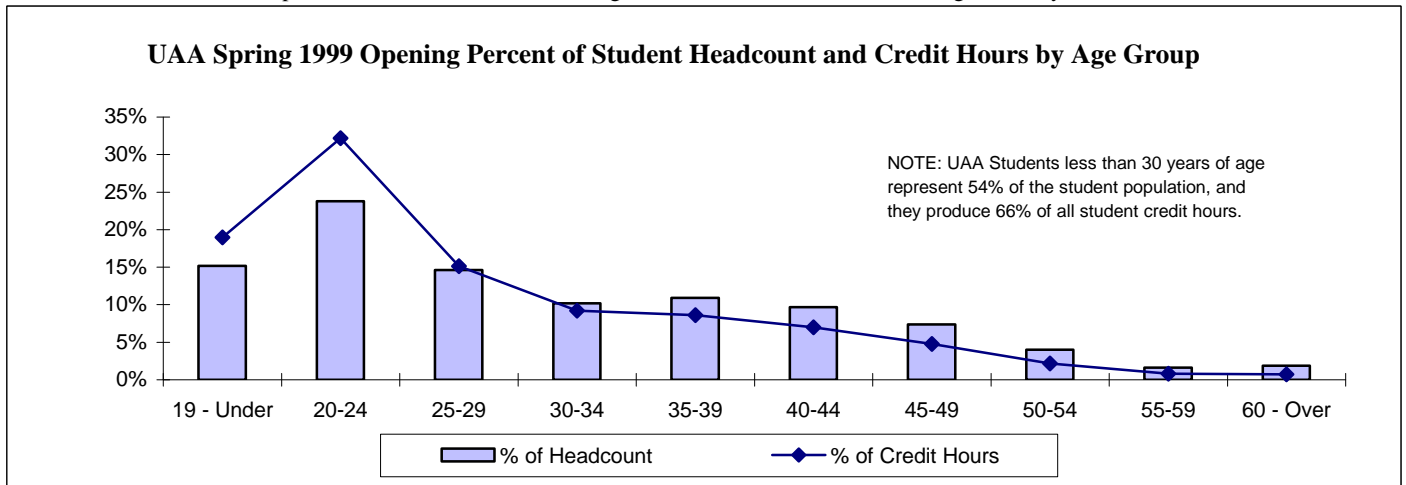

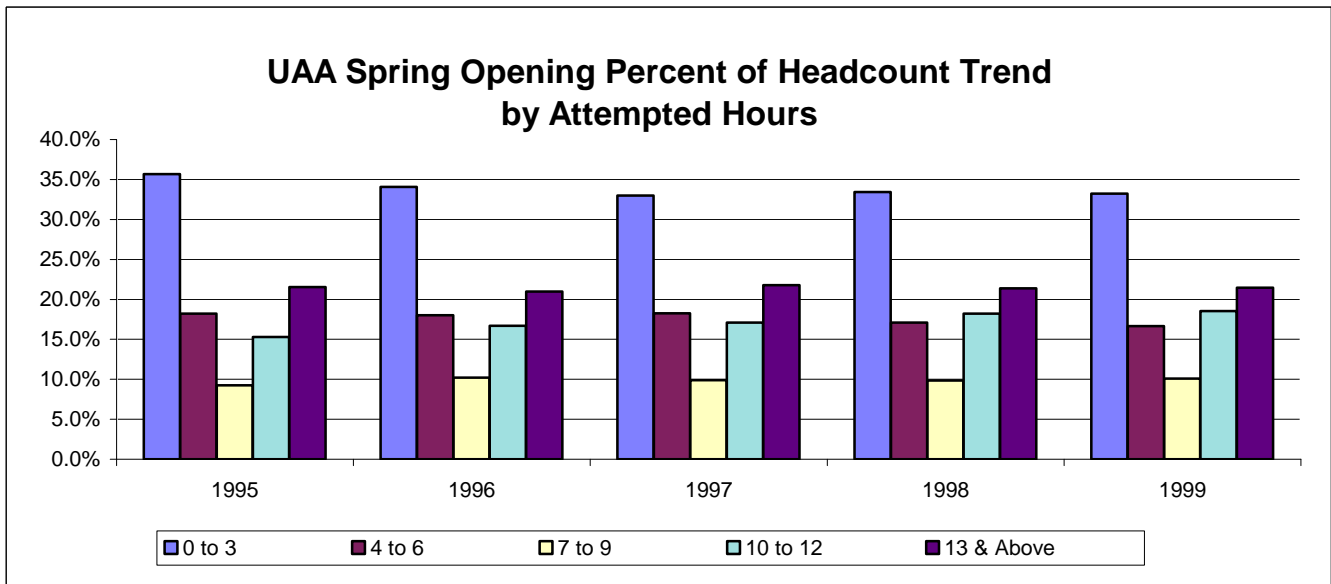

Anchorage Campus Headcount Trend by Student Characteristic

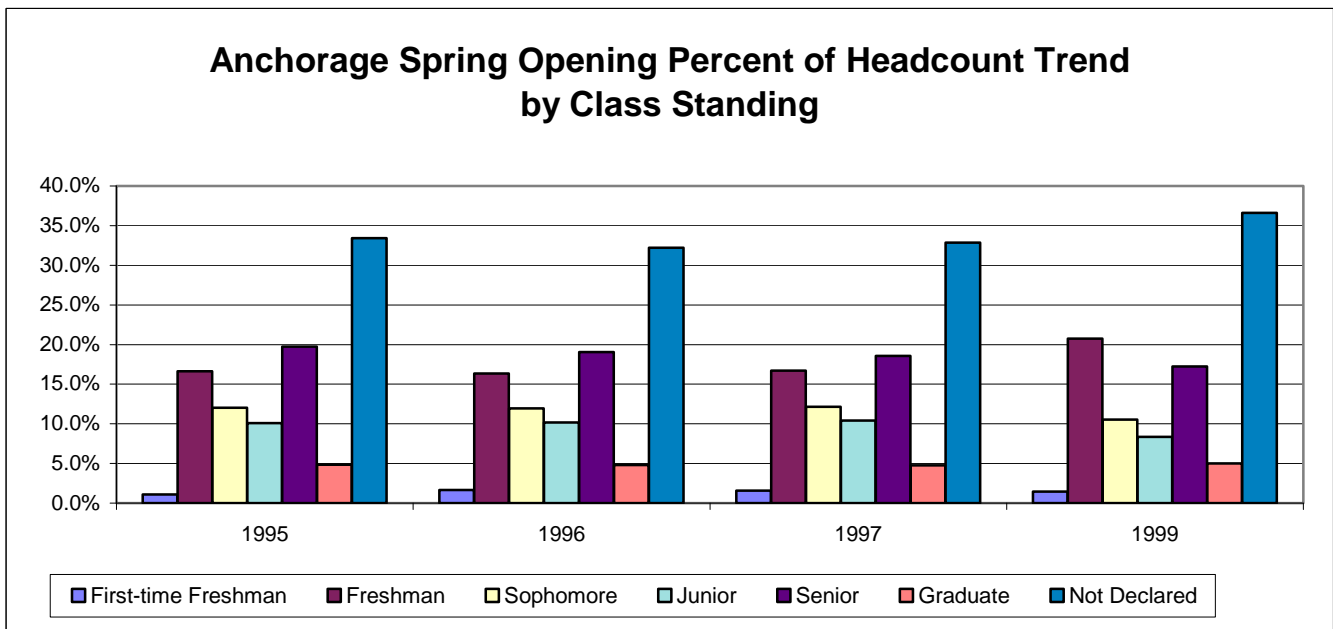

Anchorage Spring 1999 Opening Primary Majors by College

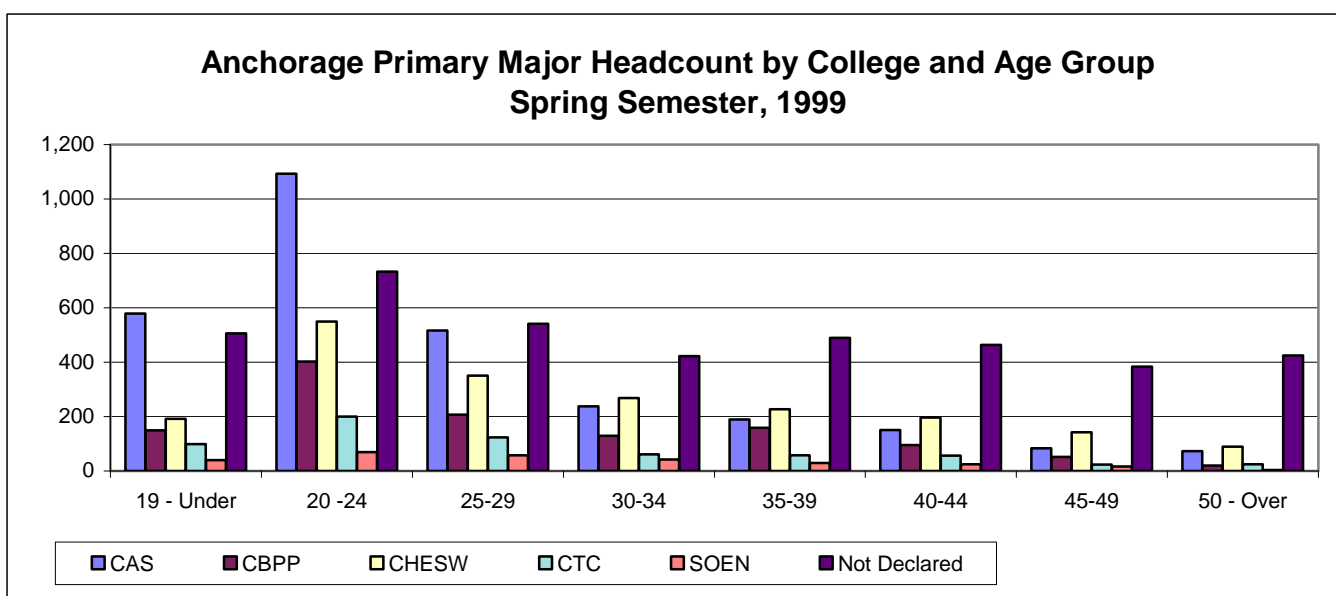
