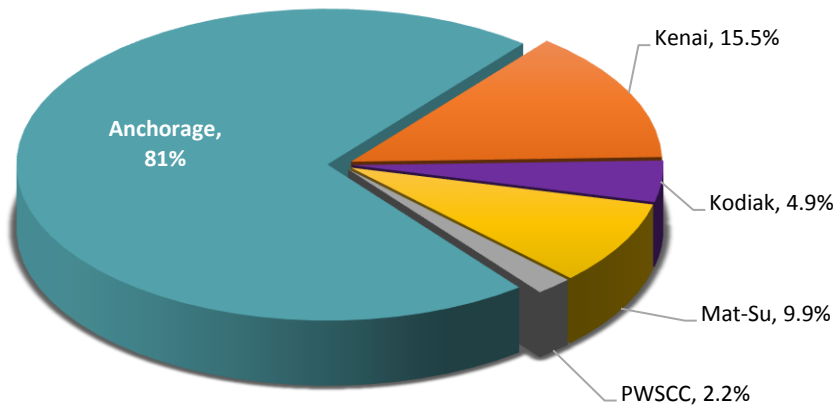

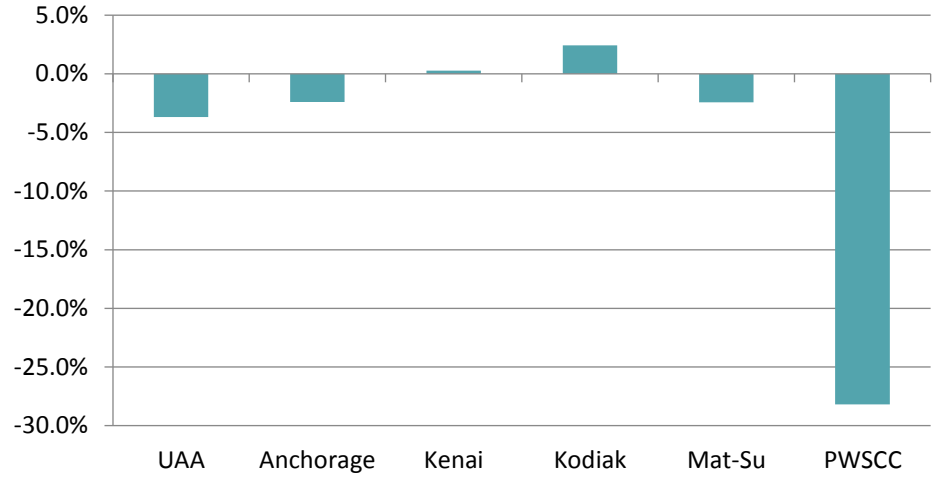

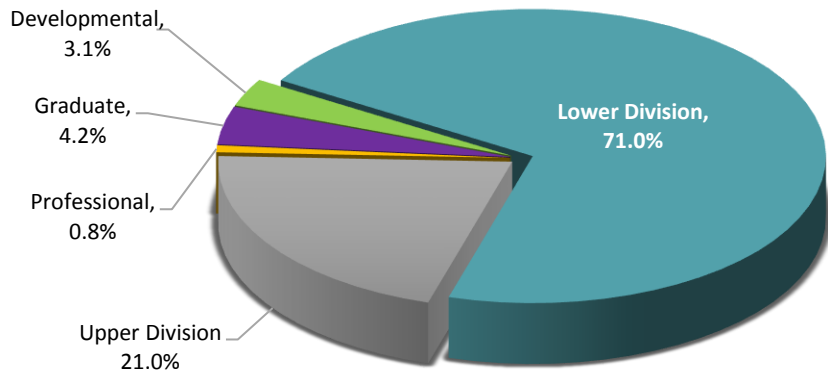

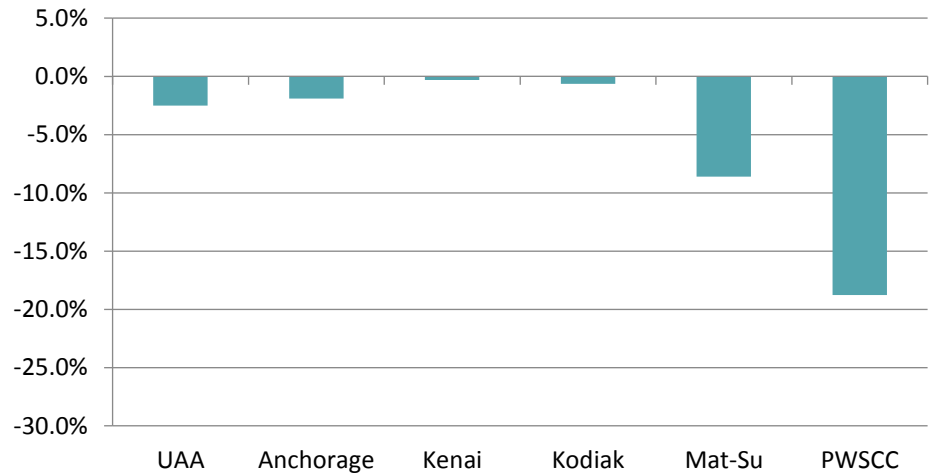
**% Change in Credit Headcount
